And the said Whitfield Harrel having this day appeared in  
open Court, and taken said oath and together with said  
security signed sealed and delivered said bond. said letters  
of Guardianship to said Whitfield Harrel are now granted  
and ordered to be issued and recorded according to the  
Statute. It is further ordered by the Court that Newton  
Wilson Administrator of the Estate of William Wilson dec<sup>d</sup>.  
settle the Guardianship accounts of said decedent Guardianship  
of said John G. Hall at the next term of this Court.
