Christian Buriall 2<sup>nd</sup> that all  
my lawful & just debts be paid  
3<sup>rd</sup> that the rest of my property  
real & personal be disposed of in  
the following manner viz

I give and bequeath to my  
Beloved wife Darcas one negro  
girl named Elliza two beds &  
furniture and all the rest of the  
property she brought when I  
married her also her share of  
money that is coming from the  
estate of William Gladden descent  
and three hundred Dollars to  
be paid by my executors

It is my will that the rest

of my property real and personal  
be sold and equally divided  
between my four children, viz  
Mansel, Louisa Merinda, Nathaniel  
Barber & Sarah Lucca, Lastly I  
constitute nominate and appoint  
Thomas Hall, Daniel Hall my  
executors of this last will &  
testament & hereby pronounce &  
Deliver this my last will &  
testament in witness whereof I  
have hereunto set my hand & seal  
the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 1830
