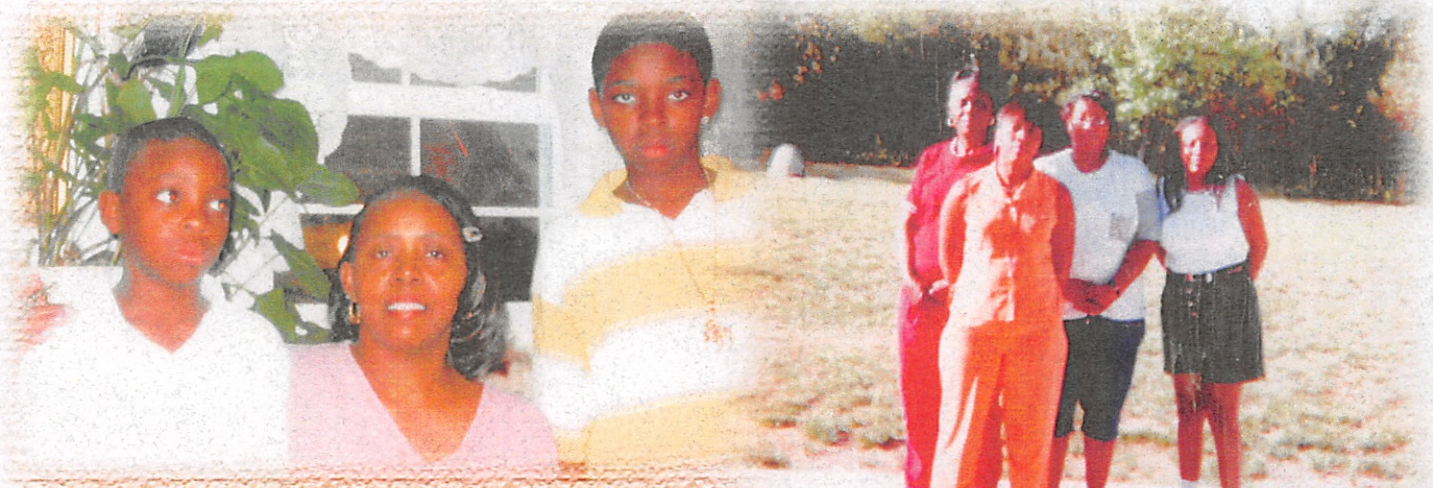

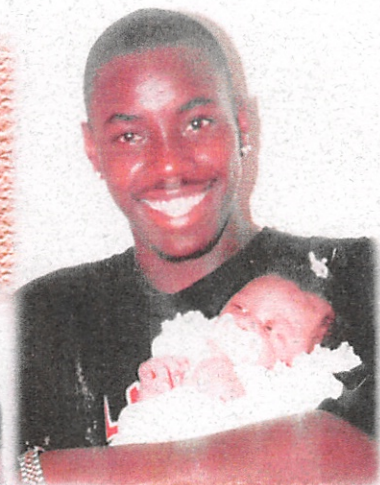
“**Debbie**” was formerly married to the late James Davis and Randolph Hall. She was preceded in death by her brother, Angelo Noel Halsey.

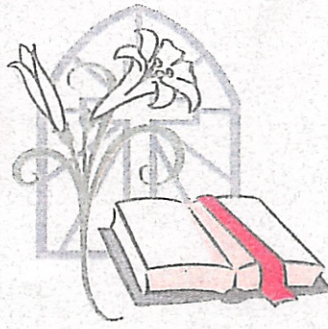












“My Work Is Done”
