He would be the son of Reuben and Sarah Burge Harrison of Longtown. However, I cannot find information as to who Kirkland's first wife is. All family trees that I come across on Ancestry only mention his second wife, Margaret, who was too young to have been my ancestor's mother. Is there any information on Kirkland that you have in your archives?

In Fairfield County Equity Court Bill 1837 #2
Kirkland Harrison married Harriet Ellison D/O of William Ellison on Mar. 18, 1828
Kirkland & Harriet separated on June 18, 1835 and she wanted alimony
Kirkland moved to Selma, Dallas County, Alabama in March 1834
This bill did not mention any children although they had been married 7 years.
