



 ally granted to Ann McDowell and by John Kinne sold and con-  
 veyed to James Marr by deed bearing date the twenty eighth day of  
 October Anno Domini 1803 for one hundred and thirty five acres and by  
 Henry Moore Sheriff of Fairfield District sold and conveyed to the  
 said Ruben Harrison by deed bearing date the fourth day of Febru-  
 ary Anno Domini 1805 for one hundred and thirty five acres of Land  
 (more or less) situated in the District of Fairfield aforesaid on the
