Hello. I am researching. My Harrison line. My 2nd grandfather David Harrison, was born in South Carolina, he went by George Harris, or Dave Harris as times, but his name was David Harrison. He appears in Greenwood, South Carolina later on, and he married my 2nd great grandmother, Jannie Perrion. I have his birth as listed from 1868, to 1892. He is listed as mulatto. Fairfield, SC is two counties over from Greenwood, and I assume he is not from that county at all, and I whole heartily believe he is from Fairfield. Their are two mulatto Henry Harrison's, that lived Fairfield, SC, then one Henry married a Carolyn, and one married a Eliza Jefferson. I can provide more detail information as well.

Hollingsworth Harrison, son, age 10, born Jan 1890, South Carolina, single,
Annie M. Harrison, daughter, age 4, born May 1896, South Carolina, single,
John F. Harrison, son, age 2, born Mar 1898, South Carolina, single,
Census says 14 children, 10 living, this would mean 5 are out on their own by 1900

1940 Census for Phoenix Township, Greenwood County (part of old Edgefield County), South Carolina has:

David Harrison, age 48, 1892 (if had birthday) / 1891 (if not),
which does not match 1887 in WWI record below, born in South Carolina,
Wife Jannie Harrison, age 45, 1895 (if had birthday) / 1896 (if not), born in South Carolina,
Edmond Harrison, son, age 5 months, probably born in Greenwood County, South Carolina,
Eugene Harper, lodger, age 10, young to be on own, probably somehow related, born in Georgia,
Henry and Mattie Gildsmith (in my opinion, wrote mith, then went back and added 's') living in same house,
This couple must be friends or somehow related also.

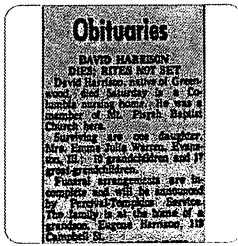
Dave Harrison, living in McCormick (part of old Edgefield County), South Carolina,
was born August 19, 1887 (5 years off), in Edgefield, South Carolina,
employed by Jesse Perrin, farming in McCormick County, South Carolina,
Jesse Perrin most likely related to his wife Jannie Perrin.
