Thanks so much for getting back to me. My sister Renée from Georgia will likely be joining me and I will also ask my cousin Leonard if he's interested in coming also. Unfortunately my uncle Cephus has been ill so he will not be able to attend and I don't think my aunt Janet will be able to come either. I will certainly share any new information we can uncover with Other family members.

As far as what I am looking for.

1) I am trying to get any information on William K Sitzler.  
( I had previously thought his name was Sutz)  
He shows up in the 1930 census as a 63-year-old man living in Township 9 Fairfield South Carolina He is my grandfather. I have been unsuccessful in finding anything beyond that. He seems to disappear.  
I was told that he may have been originally from Chase City Virginia.

2) I was able to get a copy of the newspaper that had the account of the shooting of my grandmother Janie Harrison but I would still like to get more information about whatever happened to the person killed her and if there's any more information about that particular crime.
