Homan who enlisted in Company Proctor Regiment 7th C Battalion Proctor Captain Proctor at Proctor on the 1st day of April 1862 and served in that command until the 26th day of April 1865. He was discharged from the service at Proctor on the 26th day of April 1865 and was at that time a member of Company Proctor Regiment 7th C Battalion Proctor Captain Proctor. I have never remarried, or having remarried, my second husband whose name was J. D. Homan died on the 1st day of April 1912 and my income does not exceed \$100.00. I am 70 years of age. I reside at Proctor in Fairfield County, S. C., and have lived there since the 1st day of April 1866.

I have been on the pension roll of South Carolina since 1866. I am not on the pension roll or an applicant for pension in any other County of South Carolina, or any other State, nor am I on the pension roll nor an applicant for pension from the United States government.
