by my son John Harrison have sold & delivered, & by these presents do sell & deliver to the said
John Harrison a certain yellow girl named Drusilla now about twenty one years of age
to have & to hold the said girl Drusilla to the said John Harrison his heirs & assigns forever
And I do hereby warrant & forever defend the said girl Drusilla to the said John Harrison
from my self & my heirs, & all other persons claiming or to claim her. Witness my
