 sell unto her the said Francis B. Brevard, her heirs & assigns forever, the follow-
 ing Negroes **Vige Melley** a negro woman about forty years old, **Wily** her son
 about thirteen years old, & her son **Wiot** about four years old, which Negroes
 I do hereby warrant & defend to her the said Francis B. Brevard her heirs
 executors administrators & assigns, from me my heirs executors administra-
 tors & assigns forever - In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand
 & affixed my seal this 1st day of November 1834 - Witness **John Smart**
