vs.

William Haigood-Will dated September 28, 1821-Will on Frame 131-died shortly after
Nancy Haigood-widow-later married John D. Wells in February 1823
Martha Haigood-daughter
Maria Haigood-daughter
Elizabeth Haigood-daughter
Lewis Edward Haigood-son
Pamela Haigood-daughter
William Martin Haigood-son-died shortly after father
Mary Caroline Haigood-daughter-will be 21 in July 1838

Buckner Haigood was a brother of William Haigood.

Frame 154 – 1833 #10 – Bill for Injunction and Relief – Filed February 8, 1831

James Morris and John Duett

vs.

Robert G. Bagley and John Miller

Jane Miller-died in January 1831-Will on Frame 174
John Miller-son

Frame 177 – 1833 #11 – Bill for Accounts – August 14, 1832

Mary Payne by her next friend

vs.

Thomas Hines

Jenny Payne-(commonly called Jane Winn)-married Andrew Miller
Mary Payne-daughter-(or called Mary Hines)

Thomas Hines was to take care of Mary, had moved to Tennessee.

Frame 189 – 1833 #12 – Bill for Partition and Relief – Filed June 19, 1932

Margaret Hartin, Mary Ann Hartin

vs.

James Hartin, Wm. G. Hartin, Margaret M. Hartin and John K. Hartin

Jacob Hartin-Will dated December 14, 1826 on Frame 194-died shortly after
Margaret Hartin-widow
James Hartin-son-27 in 1832
Mary Ann Hartin-daughter-25 in 1832-married Thomas Harbison
William Gamble Hartin-son-15 on May last, 1832
Sarah Jane Hartin-daughter-18 on February last-1832
Margaret McCreight Hartin-daughter-16 in 1832-married Eli A. Williams
John Kell Hartin-son-15 December last-1831

Margaret and her children moved to Gibson County, Indiana
