Benjamin enlisted as Private in Company I, Alabama 29th Regiment. Records indicate Benjamin became a POW at Blakely, AL on 9Apr1865. He was mustered out of 2nd Regiment, Alabama Reserve, 63rd Regiment Infantry as a Private upon CSA surrender. Benjamin did NOT return to Greene County after the war - family assumed that he died somewhere along the way. Author located one reference (of unknown credibility) which stated that Benjamin survived and was married in 1871 in Mobile, AL. Author has been unable to locate any additional information related to Benjamin Henderson or "Mary Kimball"
