FOREWORD

Volume III (of 5 volumes) is a compilation of vital statistics for more than 300 families who are direct descendants of David D Henderson (1806-1895) and Vianna Nix (1807-1885). This book is specifically intended to help Henderson family researchers get started with their own genealogical research by identifying most of their ancestors and relatives they will be dealing with. One effective way to get started would be to complete 'filling in the blanks' for any individual of whom you have relative information. Henderson family information was compiled from a variety of sources including ancestry.com, find-a-grave.com, Mormon database, plus a variety of other online query sites. Literally hundreds of researchers have contributed to the completeness of this material. Author particularly wishes to thank several Henderson family researchers who granted him 'guest privileges' to their family tree on ancestry.com such that he could view information of living individuals. Without such access, it would have been impractical for author to identify the large number of younger Henderson families. Hopefully, this series of Henderson family reference books will encourage other Henderson descendants to learn more about their hard-working grandparents who were early pioneers in Alabama and Mississippi.

One caveat: There can be no assurance that any specific vital statistic in this book is either complete or accurate. For certain, there are some descendants not listed because author was unable to locate any online information regarding them - especially younger family members. For any error or omission the author apologizes and solicits your help in improving the book's accuracy and completeness. After all, family members are usually the most reliable source of information regarding their relatives. Author has learned (the hard way) that all genealogical information should be taken with that proverbial 'grain of salt'. There are frequent errors and inconsistencies in the information - it is up to the reader to analyze the information presented and compare it with other reliable sources - e.g. knowledgeable family member.

David Henderson and Vianna Nix emigrated to Greene County, Alabama in the 1820s and were married in Dec1835 in Greene County. David (and his brother Samuel) each purchased an 80-acre tract of land on 1Oct1835 located about ten (10) miles southwest of Eutaw, AL. David and Vianna lived there for less than five (5) years before purchasing a new 80-acre homestead located a short distance southwest of Bethel Baptist Church near Ralph, AL. David's family lived near Bethel Church until the late 1860s when the family moved to Clay County, MS.

This volume (Volume III of V) is organized to maximally assist the individual researcher with descendants of David and Vianna Henderson. As such, the reader should keep the following in mind:

1. Author read somewhere that the Henderson surname was the 13th most popular surname in America during the early 1800s. By 1820, author's research indicates there was likely to be at least one Henderson family in every county in America. The earliest Henderson death in Greene County of which author is aware occurred in 1826 - apparently, he was not one of our 'Alabama Hendersons'. Further, extended families (e.g., our Alabama Hendersons) tended to cluster as

neighbors and multiple families emigrated together as they moved westward in the 1800s and early 1900s. Another common practice was to name their children using the same names (e.g., William). Result is that modern researchers are faced with the task of differentiating between multiple first cousins named 'William Henderson' who might have lived in Greene County in the 1840s. In order to cope with this situation, the author adopted practice of identifying an individual by his/her full legal name plus birth and death year (e.g. William Franklin Henderson (1811-1890)). Even that differentiation has proven inadequate in a few cases - in those cases, author had to use actual date of birth or date of death to differentiate between individuals. Worse, author has learned (the hard way) that he MUST also associate an individual with other family members in order to ensure that he has the correct 'William Henderson' - frequently there are multiple Henderson individuals with same name, living in the same area, and have birth/death dates which are in the same year.

2. The book is organized similar to a family tree with David and Vianna Henderson as its starting point (i.e., Paragraph 3.0) and each family unit includes its relationship with this couple. The significant difference with author's approach is that each 'node' in the family tree includes three generations (i.e., children, parents, and both sets of grandparents) of family members. By looking at vital statistics (on a single page) for all three generations simultaneously the researcher can easily perform his/her own 'sanity check' regarding completeness and accuracy of the information. P.S., If you have not learned this lesson by now; all information found on genealogical sites (e.g., ancestry.com) and even official census rolls should be taken with that proverbial 'grain of salt' because of the likelihood of errors.

3. Author's career was spent as a systems engineer responsible for design of complex electronic systems. Typically, we were faced with ensuring that a large number of design products were both consistent and timely as we approached a milestone design review. Author became skilled at taking one last overall look (we informally called this review a 'sanity check') at all of our design products considered as a whole. Author performs a similar 'sanity check' on genealogical data by considering all of the vital statistics for three consecutive generations of the family at the same time. All of the names and dates must be consistent - any inconsistency highlights need for further research. This book is organized around such 3-generational family units to enable the reader to perform his/her own version of a 'sanity check'. Author achieved a significant improvement in readability by dedicating (at least) one page to each family unit - unfortunately, the result is a huge book.

4. A reference book such as this one can never be complete (or 100% accurate) - author will even admit to likelihood that he introduced a few transcription errors. There is always further information (e.g., residence) which could be learned about your parents and grandparents. Also, there will be continuing births, weddings/divorces, and deaths along the way. Author specifically designed this book such that individual reader can update and maintain his/her own version of Henderson family tree as his/her family situation changes. The book is available in digital form (using standard MS software) such that you can easily make needed modifications or additions to your family's node(s). You can also easily print one or more pages and substitute them in the

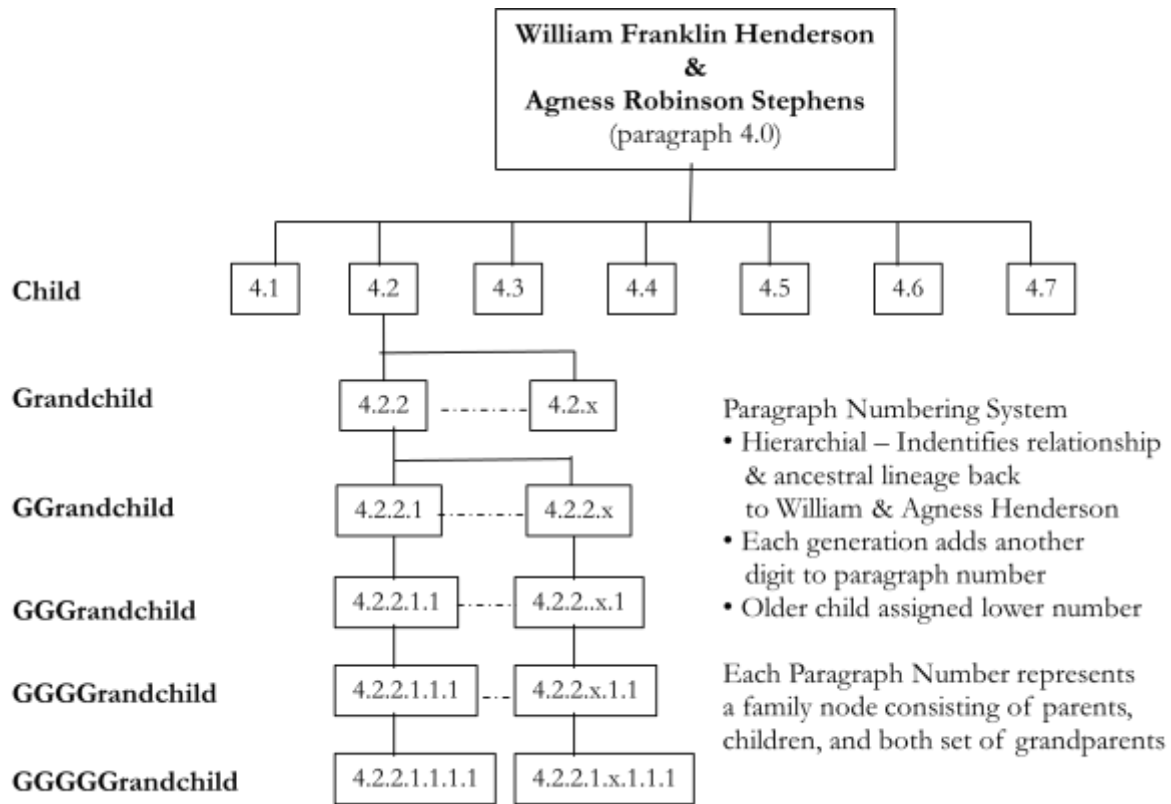
hardcopy version of this book. In this manner, you can customize your own personal copy of the Henderson family tree.

5. Several families (including, Henderson, Stephens, Wardlaw/Wardlow, and Logan) lived as neighbors near Abbeville, SC prior to 1820. Members of each of these families emigrated to Greene County, AL in the 1820s - where they again settled as neighbors. Researching Henderson family genealogy often uncovers a previously unrecognized relationship among members of these families.

Paragraph Numbering System

Author has identified over 300 direct descendants of David and Vianna Henderson. Author estimates there are an average of nine individuals (i.e., 4 grandparents, 2 parents, plus 3 children) associated with each direct descendant - he arbitrarily assigned the name "family node" to this grouping of family members. In order to show relationships among this many people, the author chose to arrange the "family nodes" in a hierarchal fashion as illustrated below. **All paragraph numbers were assigned based on hierarchal relationship of the direct Henderson descendant (i.e., Child).**

Note: One implication of this hierarchal arrangement is that name of any one individual (e.g. your name) will appear ONLY in one 'branch' (or perhaps 'twig') of the Henderson family tree. This reliance on "family nodes" means that one's name can appear as a grandparent, a parent, or a child only within that individual's close family unit. Tracing lineage of an individual will be as simple as reviewing a few paragraph numbers per the following illustration.



Note: This same hierarchal numbering system applies to each sibling's family tree as follows:

- a) Paragraphs 2.x applies to descendants of Samuel Taylor Henderson
- b) Paragraph 3.x applies to descendants of David D Henderson
- c) Paragraph 4.x applies to descendants of William Franklin Henderson
- d) Paragraph 5.x applies to descendants of Cynthia Henderson

Interpretation of Family Node Information

Each Henderson family node is documented using the format shown below. At least one page is dedicated to each family node as illustrated by this excerpt from Volume IV.

Evidence: Later Alabama census rolls indicate that families of Samuel, David, and Cynthia could not read or write which would tend to confirm family's poverty.</p> <p>2) William Franklin Henderson agreed to 7-year indenture contract - probably w/ Benjamin Stephens - in late 1824. He was to receive 80 acres of land in Greene County - which William purchased in Jan1832.</p> <p>3) David and Samuel Henderson agreed to 7-year indentured contract - probably w/ Benjamin Stephens - in Sep 1828. 	Given the family ties to Bethel Baptist Church, author believes that the Widow Henderson was buried in the original Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery. Her tombstone would have disintegrated within a few decades because of acidity of the soil in that location.

Note: Several Henderson-related families became members of Bethel Baptist Church prior to 1840. Author suspects, but cannot prove without alleged book which listed early church members, that they were also Charter Members involved in establishing Bethel Baptist Church in the 1830s. With exception of David and Vianna Nix, the following **grandparents of Ann Ella Henderson Collier** are buried in the two Bethel Baptist Church Cemeteries. Author's research suggests that Bethel Baptist Church and its cemetery were relocated to their current location atop Bethel Hill about 1880. The original 3-acre site (i.e., church and cemetery) was located about 150 yards 'down the hill' toward Ralph, AL - the church property straddled the 'superhighway' (i.e., road graded wide enough to support wagon traffic) between Tuscaloosa and Eutaw in the 1830s.. The site was abandoned after 1880 and is heavily wooded. Further, its soil is acidic so that most of its tombstones would have disintegrated within a few decades.

- 1) **Benjamin Waller Stephens** (-1850) and **Margaret Only Wardlaw** (-1874)
- both are buried in Old Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery

- 2) **Widow Henderson** (-1845)
- 1830 and 1840 census suggests that Mrs Henderson was living with her son David D Henderson - David was listed as "Head of Household" by both 1830 and 1840 census. Presumably, the Widow Henderson was living with David's family when they relocated to be near Bethel Baptist Church in the late 1830s - where she died in 1845.
- Widow Henderson was buried in Old Bethel Church Cemetery in 1845.

- 3) **William Franklin Henderson** (-1890) and **Agness Robinson Stephens** (-1873)
- Agness buried in Old Bethel Church Cemetery in 1873; tombstone moved after 1890
- William buried in Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery in 1890

- 4) **James Benjamin Stephens** (-1925) and **Josephine Drummond** (-1937)
- James and Josephine were buried in Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery

- 5) **James Benjamin Stephens** (-1865) and **Lydia Maria Briggs** (-1912)

Author's research suggests that David Henderson emigrated from near Abbeville, SC to Greene County, AL in 1827. David (as well as his mother, brother Samuel, and sister Cynthia) were likely part of the same caravan which brought newlyweds Benjamin Waller Stephens and Margaret Only Wardlaw from Abbeville, SC to Greene County, AL in 1827. Further, author's research indicates that David (and his brother Samuel) agreed to a 7-year indentured contract (probably) with Benjamin Waller Stephens in Sep1828. David (also Samuel) purchased 80 acres of land (at \$1.25 per acre) on 1Oct1835 through the land office at Demopolis. Location was Township 21N, Range2E, Section 6 - which is located about 10 miles southwest of Eutaw, AL.

Each Henderson family researcher has seemed to have a different opinion of how to spell first name of 'Vianna Nix'. Author has seen it spelled Levina, Vina, Viana, and Vianna - the census usually spelled it Vina but that is no assurance of the correct spelling. Author chose "Vianna" because that is the spelling listed on her marriage certificate.

The 1870 census indicates David Henderson's family lived in Township 15 of Chickasaw County, MS while the 1880 census lists his address as Beat 4, Clay County, MS. Author suspects - but has not verified - that change of address was result of redrawing of county boundaries rather than a physical move.

John was a veteran of the Civil War.

According to the 1860 Census, J E Henderson-age 23 (this could be John Edward Henderson) was living with and working as an "Apprentice" to R D & W A Leavell of Pleasant Ridge, AL. As per Volume IV of this reference series, the eldest daughter of William Franklin & Agness Henderson married a member of the Leavell family. Pleasant Ridge is less than ten miles from the Snoddy Community where William & Agness Henderson raised their family.

William died of wounds received during the Civil War. He enlisted at Clifton, AL on 24Sep1862 as a member of 35th Alabama Infantry Regiment and assigned to Forrest's Scouts, CSA. He was captured on 25Nov1863 at the battle of Missionary Ridge, TN and arrived at the notorious Rock Island (Illinois) Prison Camp on 10Dec1863. William was not exchanged until 25Feb1865 - he died in Oct1866.

Caroline was granddaughter of William C Wardlaw (1762-1840) and Lydia Heard (1770-1812). Ann Ella Henderson Collier is a GGGGranddaughter of William and Lydia Wardlaw.

William C Wardlaw (will dated Feb1840 in Greene County) willed \$500 each to Caroline and her sister Margaret. The two sisters were orphaned in 1840 and were raised by Benjamin Waller Stephens (1797-1850) and (aunt) Margaret Only Wardlaw (1794-1874). Ann Ella Henderson Collier is a GGGGranddaughter of Benjamin and Margaret Stephens. Further, Ann is also a GGGGranddaughter of Benjamin Waller Stephens and the (as yet) unidentified mother of Agness Robinson Stephens (1818-1873). Per Volume IV, Agness was the wife of William Franklin Henderson (1811-1890).

Lydia Wardlaw (1812-1840) was a granddaughter of William C "Chunky Bill" Wardlaw (1762-1840) and Lydia Heard (1770-1840?). Lydia's parents were Lydia Wardlaw (1812-1840) and Theophilus B Murphy (1800-1840). Allegedly, Theophilus and his wife Lydia 'left for Texas' and were never heard from again - author suggests this scenario is not credible. Author's research suggests that William, Lydia, and Theophilus died of a common illness (e.g. epidemic) in the summer of 1840 and are buried in the alleged 'Wardlaw Family Cemetery'. The original Wardlaw homestead was located about four (4) miles NE of Eutaw, AL and about one mile west of the Black Warrior River. Author has walked through some of the original homestead but was unable to identify any family cemetery.

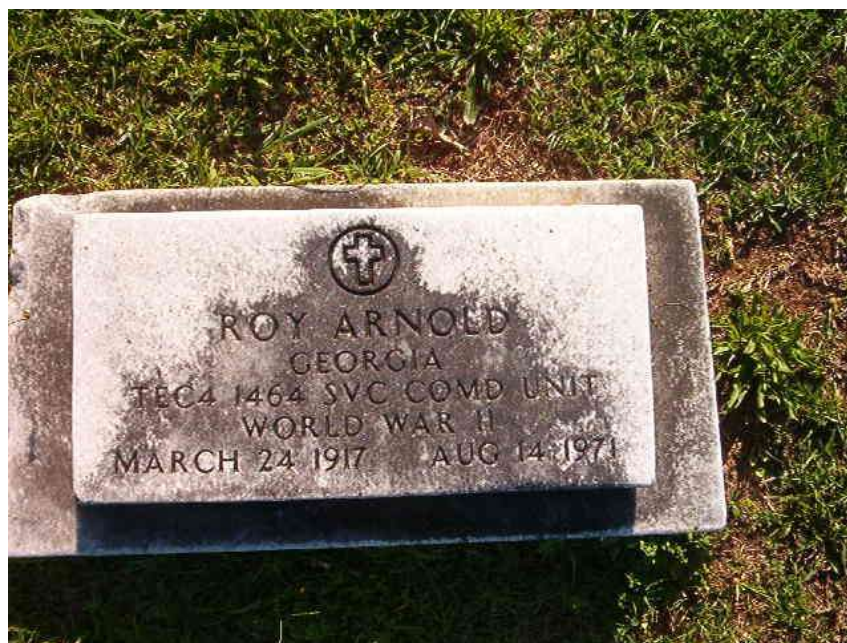

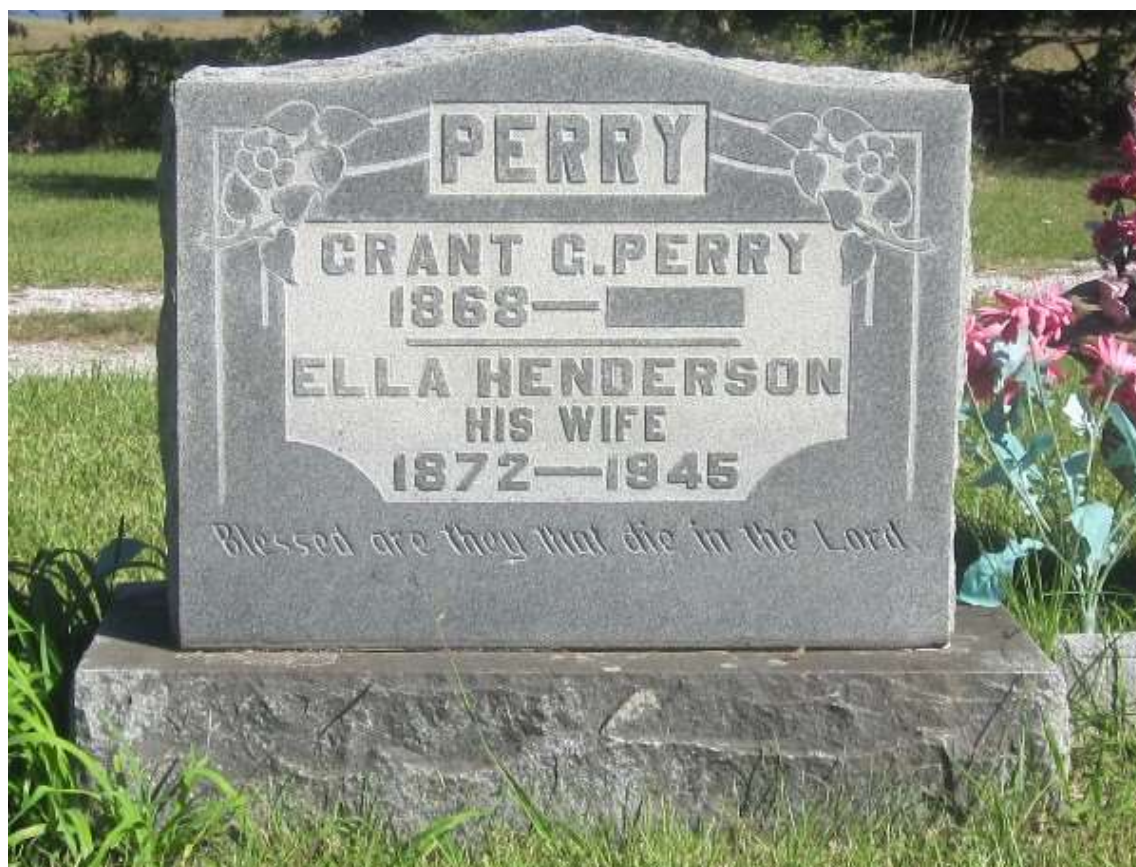

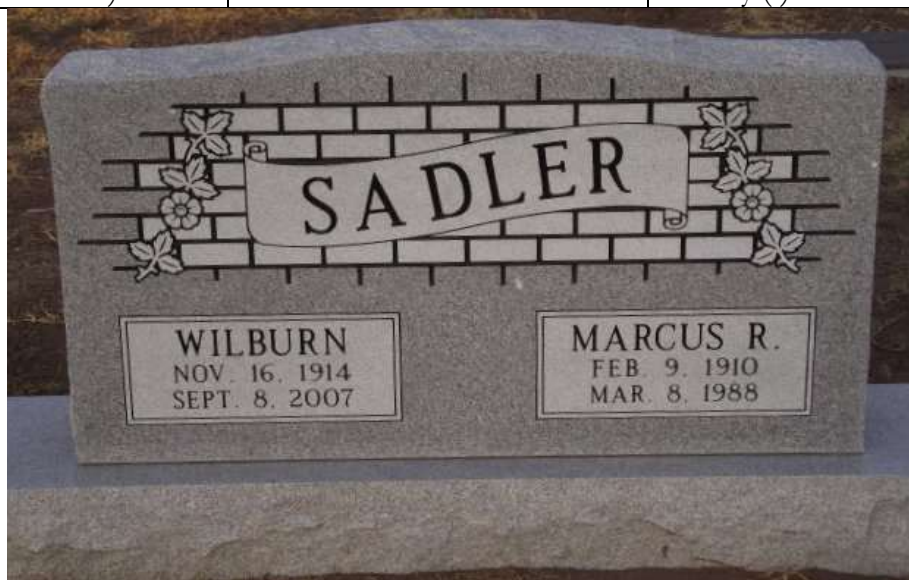
