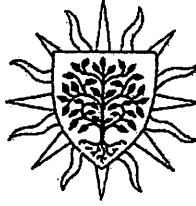

Your request is getting priority as a member and is now number #2 of the 20 remaining request.

Thanks for your patience with us; you should hear from us real soon.

Apparently good news, the word must be out about us (see FYI below). However, we are still supplied by a volunteer staff, with fewer and lesser hours over the holidays.

As FYI: we use to get on average about 3 request per month, this past year our average was 20 request per month, 19 last month;

our walk-in visitors is up from January 2014, 110, this past year our average was 139 walk-ins per month, 158 last month;

out of state visitors is up from January 2014, 2, this past year our average was 14 out of state visitors per month, 11 last month.

For our records would you please share any information you have updated on your family lines. The information will be filed and made available in our family files.

This will aide to expedite future request for research and assist walk-in researchers.

We did not find anything for Hentz's in Fairfield County, what we did find is from Newberry County, so it looks like that is where they lived.

We did not find any hints for the parents of Henry Hentz. H. M. Hentz appears in the 1850 Census in Newberry County. We did find a reference to an obit for a Henry M. Hentz, it says that he died on June 8, 1852, in Newberry from consumption at the age of 34.

We found a will for Enoch Lake in Newberry County dated January 21, 1844, he sites his wife Elizabeth and sons J. J.; E. J.; Simon; Jabez and daughters Martha Sheppard; Mary A. T. Lyles; Hester H. Lyles and Elizabeth R. Lake-she was unmarried when he wrote his will.

This is all we were able to find.
