George make slaves of themselves and others. He lost three brothers in a battle, which no doubt caused him much grief and sorrow. That he loved his children is proven by his leaving a large tract of good land and moving to a small poor one, for their benefit. His body resposes in Washington County, Georgia.

Note: This Mr. Ford, married Jane Atwood Hicklin, some years after he wrote this sketch, however, he had taught school in Chester County all of his life and had access to family Bibles and to the burying grounds, so his account is fairly accurate, and would be valuable, if he had set down all the dates.

X Zachariah Hicklin, son of William and Sarah Isbel Hicklin, was born Jan. 10th, 1774 - died March 1st, 1850. Sarah Cloud, wife of Zachariah Hicklin, was born March 8th, 1784 - died August 26th, 1846. She was a daughter of James Cloud, whose wife (Jane McKeown) was a daughter of Alexander McKeown.

X Zachariah Hicklin's and Sarah Cloud Hicklin's children were: Jane, Jason, Hugh, Elizabeth and James.

Note: This record was taken in 1870, from Hugh, the son of Zachariah and his family record.

He and #1 Malissa Atwood McCreary, were married July 12, 1843 by Rev. William Banks.
