WOODWARD DATA OF CHESTER COUNTY S.C.

I went to Chester County Court House and worked all the data there on Woodward...I also checked in the U.S.

Congressional Directory...What I got in the Directory comes next:

WILLIAM WOODWARD of Chester County S.C., who was born in Fairfield County S.C., took his seat in the 14th Congress on 4 March 1815 and served until 3rd March 1817...He did not offer for re-election..No Further data.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL Sr: This was Reverend Woodward, my 4th great grandfather and youngest child of Thomas (Regulator) Woodward & 1st wife, Jemima Collins...There is a problem here as it states he was born in Fairfield County...and in the 1880 Census, his son Joseph A. Woodward, # 157-b, (in Talledaga Ala) also said he was born in S.C....YET SEVERAL SOURCES (including his half-brother Thomas Simpson Woodward in his book "Reminiscences", states he was born in Fairfax Co., Virginia, which I think to be true.

157-b CONGRESSIONAL DIRECTORY

JOSEPH ADDISON WOODWARD (son of above # 157) was born in Fairfield County S.C. 11 April 1806 and died in Talladega, Alabama 3 Aug. 1885...He was a graduate of the University of S.C. and was admitted to the Bar...He was a member of the State of S.C. General Assembly and ran for the U.S. Congress and was elected for the 28th thru the 32nd terms, serving from 4 March 1844 thru 3 March 1853. He declined to run for a 6th term and retired to Talledaga, Alabama where he had purchased a plantation.

This is the 611 acres of land that the heirs of William Woodward sold. THE ABOVE SEEMS TO BE REV. WILLIAM WOODWARD BEFORE HE DIED. R. Hill.

Mrs. Johnson, no library here in Columbia has a full set of the DAR LINEAGE BOOKS...Mrs. Hugh Hoffman write you that a Miss Sarah Woodward, of Memphis, Tenn. joined the D.A.R. thru JAMES WOODWARD, the brother of George Woodward...If you can locate this DAR Lineage Book, your problem will be solved...I employed a genealogist in Washington to check some DAR records in Washington D.C. and her report is following this section.

162 REPLY TO MRS. JOHN WINTERS JULIAN

a. In reply to a letter of Mrs. Julia, she asked me to check # 147 for WILLIAM WOODWARD....This William Woodward is too old to be the father of ELLEN WOODWARD JOHNSON....It is possible that he may be a grandfather...Mrs. Julian, your ancestor is WILLIAM WOODWARD # 127 and had a wife LIVICA WOODWARD # 127-a...He is not the William Woodward son of William in # 158-a.

163 REPLY TO MRS. BOGGESS

Mrs. Boggess I fear that you have not read any more carefully the Woodward ms. than you had when I saw you in Columbia the last time...I hardly know how to reply to your questions when you so little understand what I have already done.

164 TO ALL OF YOU

I wish that you each one would be PERFECTLY FRANK to tell me whether you understand any of the work I have sent to you or not. I do not believe that you do...I try to make it clear and I use cross references to make it clearer and more plain...One reason that I feel that you do not have enough genealogical training to thoroughly understand this ms.(based) on the questions you write me...When you do not understand an item, sit down and write me to explain what it means.

a. One of you wrote me for the address of the other two for she wanted to write to them...I referred her to the frontispiece with all the addresses.

b. This problem is difficult for me...So far I have not found the line for either of you...I have the names of the sons and daughters of a certain WOODWARD but to find his first name has been a cruel game of hide & seek...I now know he is not in Chester County...We can eliminate CHESTER CO...There is more work still in Fairfield Co...next Kershaw Co...then Newberry,,Sumter...Barnwell...It is expensive to go and search and not find anything.

WOODWARD DATA REPORT FROM D.A.R.

165 OLD GRAVEYARD....See # 155

A REPLY TO EACH ONE OF YOU...NONE of you seem to know just what I have intended to type in # 155...The Old Woodward Cemetery IS NOT in Newberry County at all... You leave Winnsboro over the Newberry Road...travel out that road for 7 miles to the Lebanon Presbyterian Church (In Fairfield Co.) and here you turn northwest toward Chester County line and over a hard surface road and travel this road a few miles to a farm house, where you turn into a dirt road and travel a couple of miles to a Negro house (ALL IN FAIRFIELD CO.) and inquire for the old cemetery....This cemetery may be the KEY but it may prove to be of no value...See # 121-c and others

of this family where money was spent for tombstones...IF THIS old cemetery is where those tombstones were erected, then this is your family graveyard...I have no car to travel there and a taxi-cab is too expensive and then perhaps not find it to be your family after all.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL Sr: This year (1987) I inquired of this cemetery to Mrs. Mary Boulware, a genealogist in Fairfield Co., and she knew of it and it was (by her) referred to as the "RICHARD WOODWARD CEMETERY." She sent the following data from this cemetery:

Located off Highway 34 on the Douglas Road (now paved) on property of H. E. Douglas...

There were about 12 to 14 more graves unmarked.

The following in William Estes' Bible, published 1816. It was in possession of Mrs. Susan Estes Crosby (1952).

RICHARD WOODWARD & MILLY ESTES, his wife, married March 3rd in the year of our Lord 1836.

MILLY CURTIS ESTES was born in the year of our LORD 1809 on September 12th.

RICHARD WOODWARD deceast 15th February 1848.

Milly Estes Woodward, his wife, deceast August 8th 1836.

Despite the fact that the cemetery is known as the RICHARD WOODWARD CEMETERY, Mrs. Boulware made no mention of his grave BUT it seems obvious that he would be buried here.

a. MRS. BOGGES

You state that you sent the pictures to your nephew, Mr. A.W. Simmons of Greensboro, N.C. and that Mr. Simmons told one of his salesmen in Winnsboro area to go check to see if a GEORGE WOODWARD was buried there where the Misses Lyle took the pictures...SEE & READ # 120 AND YOU WILL SEE THAT I WENT TO THAT GRAVEYARD AND COPIED ALL....Your nephew put his

salesman to a useless task since I had already copied all in this graveyard where the pictures were made.

Mrs. Louis A. Geupel, 4416 North Henderson Rd., Arlington, Va. is an excellent genealogist...I had her to check some Woodward DAR memberships in Washington...Here is her reply...She did not check all.

THIS IS NOT THE THOMAS WOODWARD, The REGULATOR..See # 26.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL Sr: Andrea was correct...this was not the Thomas Woodward, who was with the Rangers in S.C. in the Revolution...and the statement made that he was captured in Germantown, Pa...makes me wonder what and whom this is all about. IT IS NOT THE REGULATOR! THIS SOUNDS MORE LIKE CIVIL WAR TIME????

THOMAS WOODWARD...His ESTATE FILE # 75-2679....We already have his will in # 42...A large Inventory and made by these men: Thomas Neal, David Rogers, Isaac LeNoir & Wood Furman J.P. This places this man down in what is now Sumter County.. I may be able to find data on him down there....He had a son, SIMON WOODWARD, who was a soldier in the Revolution.

Nothing more in this file than the will # 41...An inventory of his estate was made by: Charles Robinson, Jonathan Duren, Alexander Fleming. This man resided along the Fairfield County line of Kershaw Co.

WILLIAM WOODWARD....His estate was Admst. 1st day of April 1784 by his widow, Mrs. ELIZABETH WOODWARD...Her bond was signed by Samuel Simmons...The citation was read on the 13th of March 1784 at his home in Camden District, Fairfield Co. was where he resided but then a part of Camden District...John Hampton J.P.....This Inventory was made by: Thomas Harbirt (see # 147), Samuel Simmons, John Brent, Alexander Brent & James Howard..NO LIST OF HEIR...In fact nothing more remains in the file...The widow, Elizabeth Woodward had several small children and one a baby in arms...The ESTATE was carried to the new county seat in Winnsboro in 1785 as noted in this file.

This WILLIAM WOODWARD had married a Woodward...She was Miss ELIZABETH WOODWARD and a daughter of Thomas Woodward, the Regulator....Note her as his daughter in # 114 and then single.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL SR: MR. ANDREA IS WRONG ABOUT THIS ELIZABETH WOODWARD BEING THE DAUGHTER OF THE REGULATOR AS LISTED IN ITEM # 114! HE WAS RIGHT IN HIS ORIGINAL STATEMENT MADE IN ITEM # 114 ABOUT THAT ELIZABETH WOODWARD BEING THE UNMARRIED DAUGHTER OF THE REGULATOR AND LATER SHE DID MARRY MCMORRIES. ...BUT IN THIS ITEM...I BELIEVE HE IS MIXED UP WITH SOME OTHER ELIZABETH WOODWARD...THE ELIZABETH WAS LISTED AS A "SPINSTER" IN # 114, BUT LATER MARRIED MCMORRIES...IF SHE WAS A SPINSTER THEN SHE HAD NEVER MARRIED UP TILL THAT TIME, BUT. LATER THEN MARRIED MCMORRIES ...HOW COULD SHE BE A WOODWARD AT THE TIME SHE MARRIED THE ABOVE WILLIAM WOODWARD??? I AM CONVINCED THAT ANDREA HAS GOTTEN HER MIXED UP WITH ANOTHER!

Do you suppose that this WILLIAM & ELIZABETH WOODWARD could have been the parents of the group in # 170? If so, you have a Revolutionary line already here thru THOMAS WOODWARD, The Regulator, but thru a daughter and not thru a son...In Winnsboro, we may be able to check further on this man.

175 LAND DEEDS IN KERSHAW CO. S.C.

Charles Woodward 1806 to Hobbs Bradley.

No other land deeds show in Camden..In fact no Woodwards ever resided (Until after 1850) in Kershaw Co., S.C. of which Camden is the county seat...Camden was the county seat of old CAMDEN DISTRICT which included several counties up until 1785.

THIS IS NOT THE THOMAS WOODWARD OF FAIRFIELD COUNTY S.C. for
Thomas Woodward, The Regulator, was dead before this will was
signed. However this man owned lands in Fairfield, Kershaw
and Sumter as well as Richland Counties, all in S.C.

Thomas Simpson Woodward stated in the book that Quote: "At
the close of the French-Indian War he (The Regulator & his
grandfather) was ordered to S.C., LEAVING HIS CHILDREN in

Virginia to S.C. without his first wife (Jemima Collins) and

He was son of Rev. William Woodward, physician, Baptist Minister, Member of Congress.

He was a grandson of the Regulator, Thomas Woodward, a member of the Provincial Congress (SC) 1776.

The Rev. William Woodward born 1792 moved from Chester Co., SC in 1820 where he farmed and was a member of the S.C. Legislature...He later removed to Georgia and in 1834 removed to Sumter Co., Ala. and settled in that area of the county, which was later cut to form Choctaw Co., Ala.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL Sr: The compiler of this information has become very much confused with this Woodward family and that of Rev. William Woodward, son of Thomas (Regulator) Woodward. First of all Rev. William Woodward was a physician, Baptist Minister and member of Congress BUT he never moved out of South Carolina...Also he was married to Nancy Barrett...He never was married to Sarah Goree. Also there was no child named Henry Woodward in the family of Rev. William Woodward (my 4th great grand father)..Rev William Woodward died in Chester County on 23 July 1820. Someone is very much confused by connecting this person to the REV. WILLIAM WOODWARD.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL: NOT SO! The listed father was the SON of Captain John Woodward and his wife Esther McDonald. Captain John Woodward was the grandfather of JOHN JEFFERSON WOODWARD.

12 May 1779.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL Sr: Thomas was the great grandfather to John Jefferson Woodward, not the grandfather.

Thomas Woodward came from England with two brothers, who settled one in Pennsylvania and one in Maryland...Thomas came to S.C. and was a leader of the Regulators and was commissioned as a Captain on 18 June 1776 in S.C. Troops and was in 1776 a member of the Congress of the Province of South Carolina...Captain Thomas Woodward was captured by the British and taken to Charleston S.C. but later made his escape and returned to his company and was killed later by the Tories on 12 May 1779.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL Sr: Again Mr. Owen has his facts confused and perhaps he has confused the Regulator with another Thomas Woodward that lived in the same area of S.C.....The Regulator was born and raised in Fairfax Co. Virginia, the son of John Woodward & Mary Simpson...He did not come to S.C. until ca. 1763 after his 1st wife died in Va. The story of the three brothers coming to American seems to be true...they were sons of a wealthy London Merchant, William Woodward...BUT research in England (by myself and a paid genealogist in England, who did research for me, shows that the William Woodward, wealthy merchant in England, and who all three sons settled first in Maryland, have no connection to Thomas (Regulator) Woodward.

Col. John Jefferson Woodward was a lawyer and a planter...He was educated at Mt. Zion Institute at Winnsboro, S.C. and was later graduated from Columbia College (today's University of S.C.). ca. 1827.

He was admitted to the S.C. Bar in 1828 and engaged in planting...In 1837 he removed to Alabama and settled on a plantation in Talledaga County.

In 1845 he sold his plantation and began the practice of law in Talledaga and was also editor of the "Watchtower," a Democratic Newspaper....In 1847 he was elected to the Alabama State Legislature....In January 1849 he was elected as a Circuit Judge of Alabama.

During the Civil War he entered the service of the Confederate States of America as a Captain of the Davis Blues in the Tenth Alabama Regiment...He was made a Major soon after he arrived in Virginia and was later promoted to Colonel, which commission he held at his death on the Virginia Battlefield.

He was married in May 1830 in Winnsboro to Miss Rebecca Mary Pearson, a daughter of Phillip Edward Pearson & Rachel Lavinia Younge. Mr. Pearson was a lawyer in Winnsboro and his wife was a daughter of an Irishman, who was a Presbyterian

minister and President of Mt. Zion Institute...(name not given).

John Jefferson Woodward was a Methodist and a Mason and a Democrat.
