- F Marian Collins Woodward 4/, born 29th September 1789 in today's Fairfield Co., S.C., died 9th June 1855 in Fairfield County, S.C., married in 1810 to Major Thomas Lyles (Liles).
- 8 M William Thomas Woodward 4/, born 7th April 1792 in Fairfield Co., S.C., died 15th August 1842 in Fairfield County, S.C., married three times, 1st to Jane Starke; 2nd to Harriet Smart and 3rd to a widow Henry.
- M Osmund Woodward 4/, born 17th September 1795 in Fairfield Co., S.C., died 15th August 1863 in Fairfield County, S.C., married twice, 1st to Martha Williamson, sister to the above wife of older brother John, 2nd marriage to Eliza R. Peay.

Note: Craven County, S.C. was organzied in 1682, abolished in 1768 & the area was redistributed into what became known as CAMDEN DISTRICT.

Fairfield District (County) was organized from Camden District on the 12th of March 1785. Became known as County in 1865.
