1. RALPH HILL, d. 1663, from England to Plymouth, Mass. ante 1638, selectman at Woburn, 1649, an original grantee of Billerica, Mass. 1653, married twice.
2. CAPT. RALPH HILL, (d.1695) soldier King Phillips's War, dep. Gen. Ct., m. 1660 Martha, dau. of Roger Toothaker, from England, 1635.
3. CAPT. SAMUEL HILL, (1672-1755), m. Deborah -(d. 1748).
4. SAMUEL HILL, (1716-1798), soldier French-Indian War and Revolution, married Sarah, dau. of Capt. Ebenezer Cutler (desc. James Cutler).
5. REV. EBENEZER HILL, (1766-1854), A.B. Harvard, 1786, minister, Mason, N.H., 64 years, Rep. N.H. Legislature, m. 2nd 1795, Rebecca (Bancroft) Howard, dau. of Lt. Col. Ebenezer Bancroft, officer French-Indian War and American Revolution.
6. REV. JOSEPH BANCROFT HILL, (1719-1864), A. B., Harvard, 1821, lawyer, later colleague of his father as minister at Mason, N.H., m. 1845 Harriet Brown (desc. Hope and Jonathan Brown, both Soldiers of American Revolution).
7. CHARLES EBENEZER HILL, (1848-1917), A.B., Darmouth, (1871?) Prof. of History, U.S.N.A., 1871-75, lawyer, Baltimore, m. 1875 Kate Watts Clayton (1849-1907).
8. JOHN PHILLIP HILL, b. Annapolis, Md. 1879, m. 1913 Suzanne Howell Carroll, only child of John Howell Carroll, and 4th great granddaughter of Charles Carroll of Carrolton, the "signer" and first U.S. Senator from Md.
9. JOHN HILL, (1642-1685) from England to Boston, 1640, later settled at Dover, N.H., m. 1656, Elizabeth Strong.
10. JOSEPH HILL, (1658-1713) m. Susanna Beedle.
11. SAMUEL HILL, (1690-1775), m. Hannah Allen.
12. ISSAC HILL, (1724-1807), m. Lydia Roberts.
13. ISSAC HILL, (1759-1814), m. Juliana, dau. of Capt. Jacob Reeder, master armorer Cont. Army (and g. dau. of Nathaniel Jayne, Soldier of American Revolution).

14. REV. DANIEL TREMBLY HILL, (1807-1887) m. Lydia Ann Thompson (1809-1854).
15. DAVID JAYNE HILL, b. Plainfield N.J., 1850: m. 1874 Anna Liddell (1852-1880); dau. of Walter James Forbes Liddell, Erie, Pa.
16. THOMAS HILL, (1771-1828) from England, 1791, settled at New Brunswick, N.J., Judge Court of Common Pleas, m. Henrietta Barker.
17. THOMAS HILL, D.D., LL. D. (1818-1891) A.B., Harvard, 1843, 21st President of Harvard College, 1862-1868, m. 1st Anne Foster, dau. of Josiah Bellows.
18. HENRY BARKER HILL, (1849-1903) A.B., Harvard, 1869, Prof. of Chemistry and Dir. Chemistry Lab. of Harvard U., member Nat. Acad. Sciences, etc. m. 1871 Ellen Grace Shepard (b. 1849).
19. EDWARD BURLINGAME HILL, b. Cambridge, Mass., 1872, m. 1900 Mary Alison Bixby, b. Boston, Mass., 1878, dau. of Dr. George Holmes Bixby of Boston.
20. PETER HILL, from England in the "Huntress" 1632-33, settled on Saco River, present site of Biddeford, Me.; member of Assembly of Lygonia, 1648, asst. of same. (?)
21. JOHN HILL, (1666-1713) ensign and 1st Lt. King William's War, Capt. 1693-1700, m. 1694 Mary (b. 1676), dau. of Maj. Charles Frost.
22. CAPT. ELISHA HILL, (1710-1764) m. 1736 Mary (1718-1785), dau. of Elisha Plaisted.
23. ELISHA HILL, (1743-1798), m. 2nd, 1773 Elizabeth (Marshall) Clark (1744-1822), dau. John Marshall.
24. ELISHA HILL, (1776-1850), m. 1803, Lucy (1782-1850), dau. of Ebenezer Ricker (and 2nd great granddaughter of Major and Judge John Hill, brother of Elisha Hill).
25. MARSHALL HILL, (1809-1867) m. 1835. Harriet Smallwood (1814-1889), dau. of James Field Lincoln.
26. ROGER HILL, (1635-1702), came with father, admitted freeman, 1653, prudentialman, 1660, m. Sarah Croos, dau. of John Cross.
27. EBENEZER HILL, (1679-1758), selectman, town treasurer, he and wife were Indian Prisoner in Canada for 3 years, m. Abbie Snell.
28. JEREMIAH HILL, (1724-1779) m. Mary (Langdon) Storer.

29. MARK LANGDON HILL, (1772-1842).
30. REV. JAMES JEREMIAH HILL, (1815-1870) one of the famous "Iowa Band" of Missionaries, m. Sarah Elizabeth Hyde. (1823-1852).
31. JAMES LANGDON HILL, b. Garnavillo, Ia., 1848, m. 1878, Lucy Brown Dunham.
32. REV. ROBERT HILL, m. Sarah Stuart.
33. WILLIAM HILL, (1751-1826), m. Alethea Carmer (b. 1767).
34. WILLIAM HILL, (1804-1851), m. Jane Clarkson (1802-1874).
35. CLEMENT HILL, (1670-1743), from England to Maryland, 1693, Deputy Surveyor General for the Western Shore, Md., m. Anne Darnall, dau. of Col. Henry Darnall.
36. CLEMENT HILL, (1707-1782), m. Mary Digges, dau. of Charles Digges.
37. CLEMENT HILL, (1743-1807), LT., in American Revolution, m. Eleanor Brent, dau. of William Brent (desc. Gov. Giles Brent of Md.), 2nd m., Eleanor Carroll (sister of Archbishop John Carroll). NOTE: # 36 probably son of #35 & #37 probably son of # 36. I believe I have this documented among my records but cannot find it right off hand.
38. CHARLES HILL, m. 2nd Susanna Claggett, dau. of Joseph White Claggett (desc. of Capt Thomas Claggett).
39. CHARLES C. HILL, m. Emith Roseville Snowden (desc. of Capt. Richard Snowden).
40. COL. WILLIAM HILL, from Scotland or Ireland to Pennsylvania, then to Hill's Iron Works in York County South Carolina ca. 1745, Col. Sumter's Legion in American Revolution, m. Jane McCall.
41. SOLOMON HILL, m. Nancy Cabeen.
42. DANIEL HARVEY HILL, LL. D. (1821-1889) U.S.M.A. (WEST POINT) 1842, served thru Mexican War, Lt. General C.S.A., Pres. of Ark. University, 1877-1884, m. 1862 Isabella Sophia Morrison (1825-1904).
43. DANIEL HARVEY HILL, b. Davidson College, N.C., 1859, m. 1885 to Pauline White, dau. of Dr. Samuel S. White, surgeon U.S.A., of Milledgeville, Ga.
44. COL. HUMPHERY HILL, from England to Hillsborough, King and Queen County, Virginia in 1721.

45. WILLIAM MAURY HILL, (1848-1918), banker, Richmond, Va. m. Frances Cadwallader Harrison (1850-1916).

46. JULIEN HARRISON HILL, b. Richmond, Va. 1877; m. 1903 Lucy Kearny, dau. of Gen. John Watts Kearny.

47. HENRY HILL, (ca. 1670-1719-20), appears of record of Nansemond County Virginia in 1701; m. Mary (Hinton?).

48. ABRAHAM HILL, (b. 1697-98-WILL DATED 1760), Chowan County, N.C. m. Judith --?

49. HENRY HILL, (ca. 1730-1804), Wilkes Co., Ga; m. Sarah Cotten.

50. ABRAM HILL, (1778-1852), Wilkes Co., Ga; m. Clarissa Calloway (1790-1855).

51. DR. HENRY WILLIS HILL, (1827-1904), graduated from N.Y.C. University 1848, planter in Wilkes Co., Ga.; surgeon C.S.A.; m. 1855 Ann Temperance Hall (1835-1857).

52. JAMES ABRAM HILL, (1856-1922), physician, planter; m. 1885 Sarah Elizabeth Woodroof (b. 1856).

53. ZACCHEUS HILL, (d. 1776), He came from North of Ireland at 12 years with four brothers to Boston, ca. 1720; m. 1735 Mary Squier.

54. SQUIER HILL, (1747-1826), Capt. in American Revolution, and donated 4,000 pounds sterling for American cause; m. 1770 Dorothy Walker (1749-1834).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Reference to the above listing, it is my belief that our Moses Hill (also Leonard Hill) of Fairfield County S.C. is some how related to this family line. Mr. Leonardo Andrea in his famous genealogical collection stated that he felt Moses Hill and Leonard Hill were brothers, their mother was Mary Hill and that they were from Conn. He passed this information to a friend and genealogist (Mr. Harold DeLorme of Columbia S.C.) who stated such in the magazine "Alabama Records." ;
