SOUTH CAROLINA) Agreeable to the request of GEORGE WASHINGTON HILL, I have this day surveyed a tract of land for him and MATTHEW WEIR and find it to contain 69 and 3/4 acres, it being a part of a grant to JOHN MARTIN and also a part of a grant to JNO. (JOHN) GEORISON as above represented situate in Fairfield District, on the road leading from Chester Court House to Buck Head and on a branch of Little River, waters of Broad River, having such form and shapes, buttings and boundings as the above platt represents.
