Henry Hill of Frederick, Maryland
circa 1695-1773

Robert Hill of Charles County, Maryland died in 1697. His wife, Mary was left with "a good many poor children". According to items found at the Hall of Records in Annapolis, Maryland, Mary Hill died soon after her husband leaving many Hill orphans. This information is found in Inventories and Accounts, Liber 18, folio 242 and Liber 18, folio 78. I believe that our Henry Hill, my fifth great-grandfather was one of these orphans.

Henry Hill named one of his sons Henry Truman Hill. The early Truman family was located in Charles County, Maryland—North by East of present day Bryantown. The naming of his son and the names of his associates show Henry Hill having a Southern Maryland origin. He was located along the border of south Prince George County and Northern Charles County in the 1700's.

Further evidence of his location can be found in the Prince George Testamentary Proceedings Index for 1736-484 which shows a Sarah Glaze bringing the will of her husband, John from Charles County. She is the executrix of the will and sureties for her bond are Richard Wilson and Henry Hill of Charles County. The Glaze farm was located in the same area as the Truman family of Charles County.

A later generation Henry Truman owned a 243 acre farm named, "Buttinton" which straddled the Charles and Prince George County lines. Some other "poor" Hills that I find in this area are a Thomas who

died in 1732 and a John Hill who had to petition the court for help in 1736-38. I believe that both of these are part of the family of the afore mentioned Robert Hill and brothers of Henry Hill.

The more prominent Hill families during this period of Maryland history are two. The Hill family associated with the West River Quakers in Anne Arundel County is one of them. In this family the name Henry is used many times. The family is well documented and "our" Henry of Frederick, Maryland is not a member. The other well documented Hill family is the Clement Hill group. This family was closely associated with the famous Carroll family of Maryland. These were Roman Catholic families and the Hills used the name Henry often. Again, "our" Henry of Frederick, Maryland cannot be included in this family. There is no sign or record of he or any of his children being Catholic.

Since there is no record in Maryland of Henry Hill of Frederick County either buying or selling land or receiving residue of willed property - real or personal - before he shows up on his leased farm on Carrollton Manor in 1744, I am convinced he is the son of old Robert Hill of Charles County. Henry Hill named his first son, Robert, after his father.

In the early 1700's all the western part of present day Maryland was Prince George County. Henry Truman of southern Prince George County and Charles County bought land along the Catoctin Mountain as early as 1742.

Frederick County was formed from this part of Prince George County in 1748. Prince George County land record BB #1 (1743-46) p. 185-86 dated March 25, 1744 shows a lease of one hundred acres of Carrollton Manor from Charles Carroll, Esq. of Annapolis, Maryland to Henry Hill for 17½ years. This is the first documented evidence of Henry Hill, the patriarch of our family.

To get an idea of the location of Carrollton Manor one would drive "New Design Road" from Frederick down to the Potomac River. This would be the backbone of old Carrollton Manor. I believe Henry Hill's 100 acres was in the vicinity of present day Buckeystown, Maryland.

A note on the lease dates in those days. Until 1752 March 25th was considered the first day of the year. This date was of the Feast of Annunciation or "Lady Day". It was also near the first day of Spring and considered the first day of the year for leasing purposes. Usually rents were payable then and at Michaelmas, the 29th of September, considered the first day of fall.

Henry Hill left a will in 1773 in Frederick, Maryland. Since no wife is named I presume she pre-deceased him. The will mentions six sons and three daughters. I believe that the sons are listed in order according to age: Robert, Joseph, Henry Truman, Phillip, Thomas, John. The girls are Elizabeth, Catherine, and Ann.

This is the first Hill will listed in Frederick County (Maryland Provincial Wills 39:84) Henry Hill signed his will with a mark, indicating illiteracy. The will directs sons Robert and Joseph to divide his personal estate among the nine children. His 50 acres Park Hall farm was bequeathed to his son, John.

In reconstructing this Hill family I've come to the conclusion that earlier Hill researchers and genealogists have missed a generation. They seem to have treated the grandsons of Henry as his sons. I have found correspondence dated in the 1940's and 1950's that could have contributed to this misconception but see no need to document this at the present time.

The Frederick County March Term 1759 shows Henry Hill petitioning the court for relief, stating that he is incapable of getting his living being "upwards of sixty years of age." The court awarded him 800 lbs. of tobacco. His rent would have been coming due at this time - March. This item would put his birth circa 1695. At 60+ years of age he was still a poor man but this is the only time I have been able to find the family asking for public assistance.

Henry Hill's older boys were born in the 1720's with John, the youngest, born in 1735. Robert, Joseph, Henry Truman,

Phillip, and possibly Thomas, were young married men starting their own families by 1744 when Henry leased his farm. I say this for the following reasons: The Calendar of Maryland State Papers - The Black Books p. 227 Item 1582 shows Henry Truman Hill and Joseph Hill signing a petition with other Prince George County residents who are living above the Monocacy River. The petition is for an appointment for the office of a Justice and was signed 1745-6 before Frederick County was formed. Henry Truman Hill and Joseph Hill would have to be at least 21 years old to sign this petition. This places their birthdates in the early 1720's. In the Maryland Historical Society at Baltimore there is an account book of Charles Carroll of Annapolis, Maryland. This book gives some record of the early Hils on Carrollton Manor. The book which they have is part of the Carroll Collection and is for 1754-84. Mrs. Elinor S. Darcy, Assistant Editor of The Papers of Charles Carroll of Carrollton has indicated to me that the first account book has never been found. It would have covered the years of the early 1700's - 1754.

The following is from Charles Carroll's account books from Carrollton Manor:

Joseph Hill did not lease from Mr. Carroll
but just to the west of Carrollton Manor and on
the east side of Catoctin mountain between
present day Point of Rocks, Maryland, and Frederick,
Joseph bought his 87 acre "Mountain Branch" farm
on Dec. 9, 1749. He must have married money
for he's the only one of Henry's sons to
own land early. On June 7, 1758 Joseph bought

"Lashmuts Folly." On April 29, 1769 he bought "Ralph's Field." On October 23, 1779 Joseph Hill bought "Mountain Glade" and other farms. All of these tracts are adjacent and in 1796 he re-surveyed all the parcels of land into one and named it "Mountain Fields". This survey is on file in the survey book of Frederick County, Maryland. "Mountain Fields" is a total of 300 acres. I will mention more of "Mountain Glade" later as it is relevant to this story.

The only record of Thomas Hill that I've been able to locate was an item in the Maryland State Papers - The Black Book, page 180, item 1244 in which a Mrs. Nichols, a William Nichols, Thomas Hill, and William Ellston petitioned Governor Horatio Sharpe to pardon or reprieve two slaves sentenced to death. (William Nichols was a witness to the will of Joseph Peach. William Ellston was a witness to the will of William Peach, Jr. I mention this as I will have more to say about it later.)

John Hill who was nine years old when Henry rented his farm in 1744 seems to stay with his father until Henry Hill's death in 1773.

The early court records of Frederick County indicate some early problems for this family, but after the mid 1750's only the usual debt cases are found. These several cases concern mainly Henry's grandsons

and have been helpful in reconstructing
the family.

In the November Court 1751, James Burgess and his wife, Alice vs Joseph Hill "in a plea wherefore with force and arms he the said Joseph Hill upon her the said Alice at the county aforesaid an assault did make and her the said Alice did beat wound and scantly treat so that of her life it was despaired and other harms to her did to the great damage of them the said James and Alice and against our peace, etc." A jury was impaneled who found for the plaintiff's awarding James and Alice Burgess a judgement against Hill for ten shillings and 1,293 lbs of tobacco for their costs.

Frederick County Court Judgements, 1748-65:

William Hayward of Anne Arundel Co., Maryland, removed up back in the woods, from thence down to Monocacy, he being there in debt to a certain Joseph Hill of Monocacy and had not the money to pay him. When he came up the country last July (1748) [bound girl Mary Thacker] was sold a servant [by Hayward] to the said Hill for three years to pay the debt. [Mary Thacker] now about fourteen years of age petitions [the Court for liberty] Court ordered a summons issued returnable to the next County Court for the said Joseph Hill to answer the complaint (March Court 1748). In the June court 1749, Mary Thacker, age fourteen the 25th of October, next, is by the Court here bound to Joseph Hill 'til she arrives to the age of 16. The said Joseph Hill promises to learn her to read distinctly in the Bible and to give her at the expiration of her time of servitude a gown and petticoat made of linsey woolsey, a pair of shoes and stockings, an apron of white

linen, two white hats and two shifts - one of brown and the other of white linen."

At the March Court 1751-2 Elizabeth Hill of lower part of Monocacy Hundred is presented by the grand jury for having a baseborn child. I feel this is Henry's Elizabeth. She would be in her early twenties. This is the only mention of any of Henry's daughters.

The Sons of Henry Hill²⁾

³⁾ Robert Hill circa 1720-1796

Robert is the oldest son, listed first in old Henry's will and according to Charles Carroll's account books rented his own land on Carrollton Manor earlier than any of his brothers - Possibly soon after his father, Henry rented his farm in 1744 - around 1746-47. I believe Robert was named for his grandfather. I also believe that he married a Rachel Robey of Charles County, Maryland, and had the following sons, among others:

Robert, Benjamin, Henry Robey Hill (The Robey family is concentrated in Charles County, Maryland)

Reasons for above deductions: It is obvious from Henry Hill's will that Robert is in the area in 1773 to administer his estate. In the 1790 Frederick County census Robert is living in a cluster of hills with Henry Robey Hill, Benjamin Hill, and Robert Hill. I think Robert Hill introduces the name Benjamin into this line of Hills which is carried on to the present time. Robert's son Benjamin married Sara Scaggs in 1778. The following items are from the register of the Evangelical Lutheran

Church of Frederick, Maryland. (This is in a period of history when the Anglican priests had been run out of town because of the Revolutionary War. and the Lutheran church is the only one available for marriage, baptism, etc.)

Benjamin Hill and his wife Sara baptized their son, Robert on November 24, 1782. The sponsor was Robert Hill, Benjamin's father.

Benjamin and Sara baptized Phoebe on August 31, 1784, John on Sept 2, 1786.

Robert Hill was the only Hill in Frederick County who had an administrative account settled before 1800. Robert Hill, son of Henry, died in 1796 and his son Robert settled his account. Robert never bought or sold land in Frederick County and probably died on a rented farm in Carrollton.

³¹
Joseph Hill circa 1723 - 1798 son of Henry Hill

Joseph died in Mason County, Kentucky leaving a will which was recorded in Mason County, Kentucky as well as Frederick, Maryland. As I mentioned earlier I feel that Joseph married into some money before buying "Mountain Branch" in 1749.

The earlier court case involving Mr. Hayward indicates that Joseph was in the upper Anne Arundel County in 1746 or 1747 and could have married a woman from that area. He had one daughter, Ruth, which might be a clue to his wife's name. Again the collection of Maryland State Papers - The Black Books - p. 86, item 568 shows Joseph Hill signing a petition to Governor Ogle. This was just before Joseph bought land in lower Frederick County. Future

researchers may want to check the names on this petition more closely to see if there is a Ruth — in a will. I feel there might be.

The 1798 will of Joseph Hill names the following children:

Henry to whom he leaves £10 (pounds) Maryland currency. Joseph Hill Jr.'s children are left a share. Ruth, who married Richard Ankrom, Jr. and moved to Washington County, Pennsylvania was left a share. Nathan who was living on the farm in Mason County, Kentucky gets the farm after paying the other heirs a shared \$400⁰⁰. Thomas also gets a share of Joseph, Sr's estate. (I have not found when Joseph, Sr. actually bought the Kentucky farm, "on the waters of Mill Creek a branch of the north fork part of a peremtion called Simmerels containing 150 acres").

Thomas who was living in Frederick Co handled the Maryland part of his father's settlement and Nathan handled the Kentucky part. Both are named executors in the Frederick County will G.M. 3-274. Thomas Hill filed his father's final account and the Kentucky settlement was included. The account, R.B. 2-(189-1811)-101 was passed by the Orphan's Court for Frederick County on November 14, 1809.

Before Joseph, Sr left for Mason County, Kentucky he sold all of his land holdings in Frederick, Maryland (Deed W.R. 16-354)(W.R. 16-356). As a result, at his death he owned the Kentucky farm and cash and bonds from the Maryland sales. In checking the Frederick County Court Dockets Joseph Hill, Jr.'s name appears often in the late 1770's and 80's. Suddenly in 1794 his name disappears when his wife, Margaret takes over the collection of debts. It is right here where

I think past researchers of the Hill family have made a mistake. The Henry Hill who bought the 30 acre "Mountain Glade" farm on January 12, 1773 (Deed P-597-8) from William McCarty was Henry, the son of Joseph, Sr. McCarty (spelled various ways) bought this land 2-27-1755 and it was adjacent to "Ralph's Fields" which Joseph Sr. bought in 1769 as previously mentioned and "Mountain Glade" was part of his resurvey in 1796. Henry, son of Joseph, Sr. would have been born circa 1746 and would be getting married in the 1760's in Frederick County to Alice Ridgley. Henry paid £36 (pounds) for the 30 acre "Mountain Glade". When he sold this tract to his father, Joseph, Sr. on October 23-1779 he received £400 (pounds). This in effect was Henry's inheritance which was why he received only \$10.0-0 in Joseph's will while the other heirs received approximately £400-0-0 each. Upon the sale of "Mountain Glade" Henry and Alice moved to Newberry County, South Carolina. Frederick County Deed Book WR 10 :465-6 dated September 27, 1791 Henry and Alice Hill of Newberry County, South Carolina signed a quit claim deed selling their shares in the estate of Kestal Ridgley to Richard Ridgley. Kestal is Alice Ridgley Hill's father and Richard her brother.

Some past Hill researchers have confused the above Henry Hill with his Uncle, Henry Truman Hill who was in South Carolina eight years or so before Henry and Alice Ridgley Hill got down there. As we'll see later one reason they went to Newberry, South Carolina was because Henry had uncles and cousins already there.

Joseph Hill, Jr born circa early 1750's -

Joseph, Jr., the second son of Joseph Hill married Margaret Row on September 16, 1778. It is obvious from the Court Dockets of Frederick County, Maryland that Joseph, Jr stayed in the area and since his father, Joseph mentions his son's widow, Margaret and her children in his will Joseph, Jr. must have died before 1798. The Frederick County Court Dockets, March term - 1780 Case # 135 shows a Joseph Hill, Jr vs Samuel Thomas. The Court Dockets all through the 1780's have items on Joseph, Junior. It isn't until 1794 that Margaret, his wife, starts acting as the plaintiff in debt cases. I feel that Joseph, Jr. died c. 1793.

We know from the Carroll account books that Joseph Hill, Jr assumed a lease of a Mr. Case in 1777 or 8 and that the last renewal of this lease ran from 1778-84. The will of Joseph, Sr did not mention the names of the children of son Joseph and his wife Margaret. Frederick County Final Account RB 1 - (1806-1809)-202 of Christian Hill administrator of the will of "Margaret Hill late of Frederick County, deceased" shows the following children as receiving shares.

Elizabeth Fisher, Christian Hill, Lewis Hill, Ruth Jenkins. I feel these are the children of Joseph Hill, Jr.

Nathan Hill born circa 1756

Nathan Hill was the 3rd son of Joseph, Sr. He was the son who inherited the 150 acre Mason County, Kentucky farm. I feel that he was living on the farm in 1798 when his father left Frederick County, Maryland and went to live with Nathan in Kentucky. In speaking on the phone with the Mason County Historical Museum at Maysville, Kentucky I find that Nathan Hill and his family can be fairly well documented by future researchers.

The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick, Maryland shows a Nathan and Barbara Hill baptizing a son, Joseph on August 29, 1783. The same church records show a Nathan marrying a Drusilla Davis on September 17, 1786. This latter was witnessed by Joseph Hill, Levi Davis, and Robert Hill. I don't know if this is the same Nathan. Further research in Kentucky might possibly answer this.

Thomas Hill - born 1759

Thomas was the 4th son of Joseph, Sr. He married Sarah Howard on April 16, 1783. She was the daughter of Cornelius Howard of Frederick County. Cornelius' estate accounts of October 20, 1791 GM 2:214, 219 lists Joseph Hill as a debtor. I don't know if this is Joseph Sr. or Jr. Thomas, along with Nathan, is named Joseph Sr's executor. Thomas Hill with wife Sarah finally settle in Miami County, Ohio.

He is buried in the Pleasant Hill Cemetery. He died in Miami County in 1821. Will Book #1 shows he had a son, John born in 1783 who fought in the war of 1812. Another son, Nathan was born 3-15-1788 near Ellicott's Mills, Maryland. He died in Miami County, Ohio on 1-15-62 and was buried 6-29.

- Other children are: Barbara, born 6-21-1814 d. 8-15-1862 - buried at Pleasant Hill cemetery. Elizabeth, Sarah, Thomas, Jonathan b. 2-17-1793, and Mathew.
- Thomas states that he came from North Carolina to Miami County, Ohio and that he was a son of Joseph Hill who died in 1798. This family of Hills shows some Quaker influence in that they mention the "Back Creek Meeting" in North Carolina.

Ruth Hill born c. 1750 daughter of Joseph

Ruth married Richard Ankrom, Jr. as mentioned in Joseph's will. This was before 1778 when the state of Maryland started issuing marriage licenses and records. I deduct that Ruth was the second child of Joseph, Sr. The Ankroms lived just south to west of Joseph Hill's property down toward the Potomac River. Ruth was probably the name of Joseph's wife as mentioned earlier. I find Richard Ankrom in later years in south west Pennsylvania. The land grants can be specifically pinpointed in the map volume of The Horn Papers of south-west Pennsylvania.

From this narrative one can see why Joseph, Sr. would sell his "Mountain Fields" farm and leave Maryland in 1798. His son, Henry was in South Carolina, Joseph, Jr. had died, Ruth and Richard Ankrom were in south-west Pennsylvania, and Thomas and Sarah were in Ellicot City, Maryland. Joseph decided to go to his farm in Mason County, Kentucky and live the remainder of his days with his son, Nathan.

Henry Truman Hill born c. 1725, died c. 1797 Son of Henry

Henry Truman Hill died in Newberry County, South Carolina circa 1797. For a long time I found very little on this person. The only Maryland records I could find are as follows:

A petition circa 1746 in which both he and brother, Joseph signed asking for a Justice of the Peace to be appointed in their section of Prince George County above the Monocacy. The second item I found was in Charles Carroll's account books in which Henry T. Hill leased land from Mr. Carroll. This lease ran from 1767-74 but was transferred from a previous account book dating before 1754. I mentioned this earlier in my narrative. I was stuck here until my daughter, Grayneth found a will of one William Cooper of Ninety-Six District, South Carolina dated June 1775. This will was witnessed by a Henry Clark, Henry Truman Hill, and Mary Pritchard. This will directed my search to South Carolina in search of Henry Truman Hill. I feel encouraged in my search because the Coopers and Clarks were Maryland families that participated in the early 1770 wave southward. Vol 13, 1914 p. 263 Maryland Historical Magazine shows John + Henry (T.) Hill collecting pay for efforts in the French + Indian War. Both serve in Capt. Elias Delashmuts Co. The pay is for service in 1758.

Phillip Hill, born c. 1726, died Sept. 1774 Son of Henry

This is my L.P. Hill, Jr. direct line to "Old" Henry Hill of Frederick County, Maryland. Testamentary Proceedings 1634-1777 Lib. 46:58 of Frederick County Returns Sept. 9, 1774 Administrative Bond of Phillip Hill's [estate] by Penelope Hill, administratrix, with William McCarthy and Joseph Hill securities in £300-0-0 sterling. June 3, 1774.

Frederick County Inventory Account Book 8:60

Phillip and Penelope Hill.

Phillip Hill's estate appraised by Joseph and Thomas Johnson at £65-18-8.

Creditors: Ruth Ferguson for James Glassford and Co., Robert Hill [kin?], Henry Truman Hill, 6th of October 1774. Sworn to by Penelope Hill, administratrix.

Mr. Charles Carroll's Account Book shows a lease for Phillip and Penelope Hill dating 1769-74 and when Phillip died, Carroll extended the lease for Penelope, his widow, until 1779. This lease was also transferred from the first account book which would cover the time prior to 1754.

I deduct that Phillip and Penelope had the following sons beginning with William - born c. 1748, James - born c. 1753, Thomas - born c. 1756, Zephaniah born c. 1758. Since Thomas Hill is my direct line, the last part of my narrative will be devoted entirely to Phillip & Penelope Hill and their descendants.

Thomas Hill - born c. 1728 Son of Henry Hill

The only Maryland item I have on Thomas is the one I mentioned earlier coming from the Maryland State Papers - The Black Book, p. 180 for 1762. This is a case wherein a negro, Coffee, on November 16, 1762 is sentenced to death for the theft of bacon from one Henry Crabb. (This case can be found in Item #1242 of the Black Books.) Ten days later Mrs. Nicols, William Nicols, William Elston, and Thomas Hill petition Governor Sharpe to reprieve Coffee. This is done. The names Nicols and Elston are interesting. In the 1733 list of taxables for various "hundreds" in Prince George's County there are various clusters of families moving into western Prince George's County; later to become Frederick County, Maryland. Such family names as Peach, Nicols, Clark, Cooper, Odell and others can be found - names that appear in Western South Carolina in the late 1760's and early 1770's. As with Henry Truman Hill, my "gut feeling" is that he and his brother, Thomas came to 96th District, South Carolina around 1769 - 1772.

Early Hill researchers have felt that "Old" Henry Hill married an Elizabeth Peach. Again, they have missed a generation. Elizabeth was the daughter of Joseph Peach who arrived in Maryland about 1720 as a young schoolmaster. He married Mary Isaac, one of the daughters of Richard and Sarah Isaac. The marriage was performed by Rev. Jacob Anderson of Queen Anne's Parish on February 17, 1726. Joseph Peach started acquiring land along the Patuxent River in 1726. He spent his remaining days in Patuxent hundreds, Prince George's County, Maryland.

* Counties in England were divided into "Hundreds". Each was expected to provide 100 soldiers for the king. This term "Hundreds" was a carry-over from England.

In Joseph Peach's will dated January 26, 1760 and probated on October 30, 1764 witnessed by Jacob Green, Daniel Clark, and William Nicols he styled himself "schoolmaster." This will lists five sons and four daughters. The third child and first daughter, Elizabeth Peach who was born on April 27, 1733 and "married — Hill" is left \$10-0-0. This birth date proves that Elizabeth Peach did not marry Henry Hill of Frederick, Maryland. "Old" Henry was born circa 1695 and died in 1773. Elizabeth Peach is younger than most of his children. Anyone wanting more details of the Peach family may check the following sources at the Hall of Records at Annapolis, Maryland.

John Hill born 1735. died 1803 Son of Henry

John was the youngest of "Old" Henry Hill's six sons being nine years old when his father rented from Charles Carroll on Carrollton in 1744. He probably spent his early life helping with the chores of the small farm. The earliest record I can find on John Hill is from the Committee of Observation of Frederick, Maryland. This was reprinted in the Maryland Historical Magazine, Vol. 13, 1914 (I mentioned this earlier in reference to Henry Truman Hill). This item shows that John Hill was serving in the Company of Captain Elias Delashment with his brother Henry (T) Hill. The record shows a muster roll call for 1758. John would have been 22 or 23 years of age during his service in the French and Indian War. His five older brothers were already married and having children of their own. John and his father, Henry were living on the leased farm near present day Buckeystown, Maryland with their lease expiring in 1761. It was in that year that "Old" Henry bought his first land in Frederick County — an 113 acre farm which was a part of a larger manor called "Park Hall." This "Park Hall Manor" was cut from a larger manor called "Merryland" in 1733. A plat of merryland shows it to be in southern Frederick County with a portion of it jutting across the South Mountain at the Compton Gap Area. This portion is what would be known as "Park Hall manor" of 1500 acres. It was in what is known now as "Pleasant Valley" in the Antietam area of Maryland. In 1777 Washington County was cut off Frederick County and the boundary was the backbone of South Mountain. This puts "Park Hall" in what is now Washington County, Maryland.

To travel to the "Park Hall" area today you would go west from Burkittsville, Maryland, over the mountain past Gathland State Park and down into "Pleasant Valley." As you drop down the western slope of the mountain you will come into the heart of old "Park Hall Manor". This is where our "old" Henry spent his last days. My wife and I searched for old cemetaries in this area but found nothing that went back to 1773.

John went with his father, Henry to this new farm but I think they renewed their lease with Mr. Carroll for their original 100 acres on Carrollton which was kept until Henry's death. I think some of Henry's grandsons were running this farm as John and his father were moving to "Park Hall". The "Park Hall" deed can be found in Liber G: folio 310 Frederick County, Maryland deeds. The sale price was £33-18-0. A year after moving with his father to "Park Hall" John married Elizabeth Buher in 1762. As a wedding gift and probably a "thank you" for sticking with him, Henry, on November 19, 1762 conveyed to John 63 acres of his 113 acre farm for £15-0-0. (Frederick County Deeds. Liber H. folio 240) This left Henry with 50 acres which he bequeaths to John in his 1773 will. John's mother must be deceased by now as no mention is made of her in the will of Henry Hill.

John and his wife, Elizabeth started their large family with the birth of John, Jr. in 1762. The family grew as follows for the next fifteen years or so:

John Hill, Jr. born 1792, July 27. Married Rachel Butner

Joseph Hill born 1764. Married Rosanna ____ (others later)

Jacob Henry Hill born 1766 Married Mary? Jemima ____

Phillip Hill born 1769 on Feb. 3. Married Elizabeth Spear

Thomas Hill born 1772 Married Elizabeth —
Elizabeth Hill b. 1774
Sarah Hill born 1776
William Hill born 1778 died in NC. as a youth.
Samuel "Judge" Hill born July 2, 1779. Married Jane Easton
Jan. 27, 1799

Benjamin Hill b. 1784. Married Nov. 1, 1804 Isabella
d. Sept 30, 1831 Ann Hewitt

All of the children were born at "Park Hall" with the exception of Benjamin who was born in Salisbury, North Carolina.

Before moving on it is interesting to note that when "Old" Henry Hill sold the 63 acres to John a notation on the margin of the deed indicated that it was delivered to "Henry Hill the grantees father." Also the 113 acre farm was carried on the rent rolls of Frederick County in the name of Henry Hill during the years 1763-1773. This makes me wonder if "Old" Henry is living at "Park Hall" or if he's still on his farm at Carrolton. When I checked the original will and deeds at the Hall of Records in Annapolis, Md. - "Old" Henry signed both with a mark indicating that he was illiterate.

John and Elizabeth Hill sold Harmon Clapper 113 acres of Park Hall on November of 1780. (Washington County Deeds (B) 2:408-410) The price was £ 400-0-0. The deed states that John's father is Henry Hill, deceased. This land sale was in preparation for the entire John Hill family to move to Rowan County, North Carolina.

The family spent the next seventeen years in North Carolina - the Salisbury area - where a number of the children marry, start families, and remain basically farmers. John, Jr. became the jailer in Salisbury in the late 1700's. The historical court square today lists some of his property on the north side of the square. His father, John, owned a farm outside the town. I don't know what prompted this move to North Carolina but if the family pattern is being followed relatives were already there. C. 1800 this entire family picked up again — grandchildren are involved now - and headed for the northwest territory. After a one year stay in Newport, Kentucky they settled in the Cincinnati area of Ohio. Further information on this family can be obtained from the histories of Clermont, Hamilton, and Warren Counties, Ohio.

A knowledgeable lady concerning this family is,

Mrs. Ruth Hill, 5483 Mt Zion Rd., Milford, OH 45150.

Mrs. Hill has in her possession a document written by Aaron C. Hill. His g.g.grandparents were John and Elizabeth Hill. After travelling around the country visiting many relatives he wrote this interesting account of the family. This deals only with John and Elizabeth Hill of "Park Hall". Ruth Hill also has family group sheets through the grandchildren of John & Elizabeth and further.

An interesting footnote from the Goshen Methodist Church records by Rev. Francis McCormick shows that Henry's grandson, Joseph Hill, his wife Rosamund, another grandson, Phillip Hill, and his wife Elizabeth, and Jane Easton - wife of grandson Samuel were members and leaders of the first Methodist Sunday School class in the Northwest Territory in 1798. (The wife of Francis McCormick was a sister of Jane Easton)

We now have recorded what we know of "old" Henry's six sons. I will stop here to make a few observations on the Maryland aspect of this Hill family before moving on to my direct line thru "old" Henry's son, Philip.

In my short study of provincial Maryland it seems to me that this Hill family was poor and struggling early on. This was true of most families in Maryland because of the state's westward expansion. In the 1600's and early 1700's a great portion of western Maryland was divided among a few people in the form of very large land grants called manors - 10,000 acres here, 6,000 acres there, 4,000 acres and 8,000 somewhere else, etc, etc — Instead of selling small parcels of these holdings to small farmers as happened in many other places, the owners tended to hold on to the acreage and lease parts of it as farms. In the case of our Hill family, this discouraged land ownership. As mentioned earlier Henry's son Joseph's land dealings and the three deeds involving "Park Hall" are the only land records that I can find for this family thru the 1700's. This very fact would encourage migration - not only for Henry's sons but for his grandsons also — migration in all directions for "new ground" and ground that could be owned.

As I survey... the 1790 census for Frederick County, Maryland, I can identify two Hill families in this area... The Richard Hill family is one. Richard Hill, born c. 1720 married Mary Wells and located in the north east section of the county in the Tawneys town - Harney area. Richard had sons, Abraham, James, Isaac, William and Richard. I cannot connect

this family with "old" Henry's which is located down along the Potomac River. My only guess is that Richard could be a nephew of Henry since he's about the same age as Henry's sons, Robert, Joseph and Henry Truman Hill.

The other Hill family on the 1790 census is "old" Henry Hill's, located in the southern part of the county close to the river and on the eastern side of the Catoctin mountain. Down here we find two households headed by Joseph Hill, two households headed by Thomas Hill and one household each for Henry Robey Hill, Penelope Hill, Benjamin Hill, and Robert Hill. Of the original sons of Henry only Joseph and Robert are still here and Robert is living with his son, Robert; probably on Carrollton as the manor was still being rented out at this time. Henry's son, Phillip died in 1774 and sons Henry Truman, Thomas, and John have moved out of the area long ago. In the 1790 census Robert is living next door to Benjamin who is living next door to Penelope, Phillips widow, who is living next door to Henry Robey Hill. The whole group is renting on Carrollton Manor.

By 1790 and certainly by 1800, as indicated by the Frederick County Court Docket, there are not many sons or grandsons of "old" Henry left in Frederick, Maryland. It is obvious that Henry and his family were "survivors"—times were extremely hard in this area during the mid 1700's. The area around Frederick County could have been considered a front line against the French and the Indians in the war by that name. It must have been extremely difficult scratching out an existence on a small plot of land with Indians shooting at you from behind every tree. As late as 1763 the State of Maryland was paying \$50.00 (pounds) for an Indian scalp.

There are several other items I want to mention about Maryland. A Robert Hill, born June 2, 1764 married first to Eleanor Hyfield in 1786 and second to Amelia Fitzgerald in 1790 was "Old" Henry's grandson and son of Robert. Frederick County Land Record WR # 13 383/384 dated June 1795 show him selling some livestock, and two beds to Joseph Hill and then moving with his family to Mason County, Kentucky. Robert died there in 1846. From his first marriage he had a son, Benjamin Hill who married Sophia Tarleton. He and his wife by the second marriage had children: Otha Hill, Lindsey Hill, John F. Hill, Dempsey Hill, William Hill, Jane Hill, Tabitha Hill, and Ellen Hill who married an Augustus Dillon in 1844. Augustus' first wife was the daughter of Benjamin Hill (Son of Robert and Eleanor Hyfield). Elizabeth Hill, born Feb. 8, 1793 is probably the oldest of the children of Robert and Sophia. On March 16, 1812, Elizabeth married Calip Tarleton.

In studying court records of Frederick, Maryland I find that by 1800 the remaining members of "Old" Henry's family in the area are Thomas of Phillip, a Zephaniah Hill, a Robey Hill, and Margaret Hill, widow of Joseph, Jr. The original 100 acres on Carrollton Manor that Henry rented was very close to the Monocacy Monthly Meeting - a very active Quaker church for ten or fifteen years of his residence. The Ballingers and the Whites who were leaders of this Monthly Meeting were part of the early wave of migrants in the 1750's and 1760's to South Carolina. This could have had some influence on the movement of our Hill family.

Finally I would like to say that "Old" Henry Hill of Frederick, Maryland would have had at least ten grandsons old enough to participate in the Revolutionary War. The bulk of these grandsons can be found in Maryland, Western Pennsylvania, and North and South Carolina.

My direct line to Henry Hill of Frederick County, Maryland (c.1695—1773) comes thru Phillip, his fourth son. As mentioned before we can place Phillip's birth at about 1726. He died in September of 1774. I believe that Phillip and Penelope were married before they leased their farm on Carrollton Manor in the late 1740's. First their son, William and then son James left the Frederick County area before 1790. I do find William being appointed Constable of the Upper Antietam Hundreds in 1773. This area would be in present day Washington County which was cut off from Frederick County in 1777. The only record I can find of James is in the Lutheran Church records of Frederick showing a James Hill and Rachel having a son, Daniel born on Nov. 5, 1779. Thomas, who is my gg.great grandfather married a Penelope Shaw about 1778. The earliest church records are of 1774.

I did find in the Lutheran Church records the birth of Thomas to Thomas and Penelope Hill. This Thomas was born on August 19, 1784 and baptized on Oct. 17, 1784. and is my g.great grandfather. (Evangelical Lutheran Church Records of Frederick, Maryland) According to these same records, Thomas and Penelope had a son, Phillip, born April 20, 1786 and baptized Aug 20, 1786. The first son of Thomas and Penelope Hill was *Benjamin. No birth record was found in this Church record however his death certificate in Marion County, West Virginia states that he was the son of Thomas and Penelope Hill. As far as I know these are the only children of Thomas and Penelope (Shaw) Hill. I will later follow this family in the 1790 and 1800 census.

* Later records show that Benjamin Shaw Hill was born on October 30, 1782.

The Frederick County Dockets distinguish my g.g.grandfather Thomas as "Thomas of Phillip". This is to distinguish him from Thomas of Joseph who is still in the area in the 1790's. More on this later. The fourth son of Phillip and *Penelope is Zephaniah. I think he is the youngest.

In trying to reconstruct his family from the 1790 census and the 1800 census of Frederick County I find the following:

Henry R. Hill, one household
Penelope Hill, another household
Benjamin Hill, another household
Robert Hill, another household

These are all living on Carrollton Manor, side by side. These are extinctions of the original Carrollton leases. Sons are living with grandsons and granddaughters are living with grandmothers.

South from this area towards the river on the east side of Catoctin Mountain Phillip's Thomas has his own household showing a husband, wife, and three sons. A Joseph Hill is nearby. (I would like to note at this time that of this large family only Joseph, Sr. and Joseph, Jr. own slaves while in Maryland. Maybe they are the only ones who can afford them).

* Phillip's Penelope could have been a Robey. Penelope is a popular name in the Robey family.

Family folklore has it that Benjamin Shaw Hill and his brother, Thomas ran away from home about 1795 and came to the Pricket's Creek area of Monongala County, West Virginia (this was Virginia before the Civil War). I think there is some truth to this but the date is more likely 1800. The boys ran away from home because of a "mean stepmother." I suggest this later date because in 1803 I find "dead letters" addressed to Benjamin Shaw Hill⁵¹ in both the Hagerstown and Frederick post offices. Someone is looking for the brothers. Also, I think that the marriage license in Frederick, Maryland of Thomas Hill and Elizabeth Wharton is Thomas' second marriage. If this is the case the "mean stepmother" is not much older than the sons. Benjamin Shaw^{Hill. 51} is 11 at this time, Thomas, nine, and Phillip is seven. One year later, Feb. 26, 1794 Frederick County Land Records WR #12 p.226 show Thomas Hill selling all his personal property to John Whitenec and moving. The 1800 census shows Thomas and family in the Libertytown District of Frederick County much to the northeast of Point of Rocks and certainly out of the neighborhood. This family shows 2 males 10-16 (Thomas and Phillip), 1 male 16-26 (Benjamin Shaw), 1 male over 45 (Thomas, the father), and one female 26-45 would be Elizabeth Wharton, the "mean stepmother."

The location of Thomas' home is on the main wagon road to the markets of Baltimore and Ellicot Mills. This, plus the nature of the court cases I have found involving Thomas of Phillip lead me to believe that he was a teamster hauling produce eastward. This would also

confirm a statement made by one of Benjamin Shaw Hill's sons, John Calvin Hill that his grandfather "was a teamster in and around Baltimore". As a matter of fact most of the court cases involving this family, notably Joseph, Jr., Robey Hill, (Henry) Roby Hill, Thomas of Joseph, and Thomas of Phillip show them as plaintiffs against slave owning farmers. This makes me think that all were teamsters or blacksmiths or some sort of service job which necessitated them attempting to collect debts from the owners of large farms. By 1805 according to Frederick County court records it seems that all of the sons and grandsons of "old" Henry have left the Frederick County area.

Not believing that our Thomas and Benjamin Shaw Hill, older sons of Thomas of Phillip just "dropped in" on Prickett's Creek around 1800 for no reason, I have thought of three possibilities that might have brought them to that area.

1. The family of George Wilson who was living in the Montgomery County, Maryland area in 1776 had a Benjamin Shaw living in the household. I believe Benjamin Shaw to be the brother of Penelope, the wife of Phillip's son, Thomas - therefore an uncle of our Benjamin and Thomas. This Wilson family was on Prickett's Creek before the boys ran away from home. Uncle Benjamin Shaw can be located in the northeast corner of Preston County, West Virginia. This whole area was in those days Monongalia County, West Virginia.

2. Sharff's History of Western Maryland makes mention of the first Baptist Church ever established in Frederick, Maryland. The earliest records of this church indicate that a Penelope Hill, wife of "Old" Phillip requests a letter of transfer in 1798. This Penelope is the grandmother of Thomas and

Benjamin - By this time she is the only one left on Carrollton Manor. She's ready to leave and head towards Fairmont (VA.WV area) to be with family. "Grandma" could have attracted the runaway brothers.

3. William Hill was living on the Tygart Valley River near Benton's Ferry as early as 1795. I think this William was an uncle of our boys. More about this later.

The first record we have of the "runaway brothers", Thomas and Benjamin Shaw Hill, is a road petition in the 1805 Monongalia Court Records, Envelope 141. This petition seeks to alter a road from White Day Creek "on the present Marion [Monongalia] line" to Prickett's Creek. This new road is to go thru the lands of a Dr. Nicklin, among others. Signers of this petition include the following people: Benjamin Hill, Richard Smith, Archibald Wilson, William Hill, Jr., John Carruthers. All of these men play a part in the unfolding story of Benjamin Shaw and Thomas. It is in this year, 1805, that Benjamin Shaw Hill married Elizabeth Pierce and their first child, Thomas was born in 1806. I believe that Benjamin moved in with the Pierce family at this time. I'm not sure where brother, Thomas was living.

The next record we have is that of Thomas Hill buying from Benone Freeman 50 acres of land on Prickett's Creek. (Monongalia County Deed O.S. 5:27 dated June 11, 1810) Deed O.S. 9:406 of the same county dated December 19, 1825 shows Thomas and Margaret Hill selling the 50 acres to Asa Harris. We know that Thomas married Margaret Cooper in 1818.

We now find the two brothers established in the Monongalia-Harrison County area, and I will attempt to trace their activities individually, starting with the older brother, Benjamin Shaw Hill who was born in 1782. I will finish with my great-great grandfather, Thomas.

Benjamin Shaw Hill
born October 30, 1782

In the History of Marlinton and Surrounding Communities by Harvey Fortney and Heisel Fox, chapter 10, page 143 Benjamin Shaw Hill and others are mentioned as the founders of the Yellow Rock and West Fork Baptist Church, founded October 15, 1803. Benjamin would have been 21 or 22 years old at that time. The titheable lists of Harrison County do not show Benjamin living in Harrison until 1812. I think he was commuting to Mononga from the home of Mr. Pierce, his father-in-law who was living in Monongalia County. The above mentioned church was in Mononga.

It was a few years later that Benjamin Hill and Joel Oxley bought 100 acres acres from James Currant in 1819. This land was along Booth's Creek just to the east of Monongah, West Virginia. In 1819 Benjamin S. Hill bought 50 acres of land from Richard W. Smith and his wife Elizabeth adjacent to the land that he and Oxley owned. (Deed Book Harrison County, Bk. 14, page 454) In 1838 Benjamin bought out the interest of Joel Oxley in the original 100 acres. (Deed Book 26, p. 124). This left Benjamin

with 150 acres on Booth's Creek which later became known as the "William Shaver Farm." The Shawers own this farm today. At the westernmost point of this property, jutting out as a bluff overlooking Booth's Creek, Benjamin Shaw Hill is buried. One must search to find the Hill-Anderson Cemetery. It looks to me as if four graves are there - Elizabeth Pierce Hill who died in 1850, Benjamin Shaw Hill who died in 1855, Benjamin and Elizabeth's youngest daughter, Julia Ann Anderson, and her husband, Robert Anderson, a civil war veteran. Knowing something about this old family - standing on this point conjures up all sorts of mental pictures of the times and life of Benjamin Hill for me.

As far as I could find this is the only land Benjamin Hill and his wife, Elizabeth Pierce owned. It was a farm that could support his large and growing family. I imagine that some of the older boys worked away from the farm in the early days. Benjamin Hill was a farmer and active in the Monongah Baptist Church. I found one item in which he was listed as "clergy" in signing letters of transfer for folks moving to Bootherville to start a new church.

From the tax list of Harrison County tax lists I surmise that Benjamin Shaw Hill spent the rest of his days on this farm. He died June 6, 1855 at the age of 72 years 8 months, 6 days. Other than the gravestones mentioned above there is evidence of the location of the original home on this old family farm.

Benjamin Shaw Hill's first wife, Elizabeth Pierce was born on January 1, 1780 and died on January 23, 1850. Family tradition has it that she was a relative of Franklin Pierce, a former President of the United States. Soon after his first wife's death, Benjamin married his second wife, Elizabeth Sparks who had been his housekeeper. She was much younger than Benjamin and from this union there were two children. After Benjamin's death, Elizabeth Sparks Hill married Jacob Shauer. Benjamin left lifetime rights to the farm to Elizabeth Sparks Hill. Court records reveal a nasty case involving a dispute between the children of Benjamin's first marriage and the second wife and her husband.

Benjamin and Elizabeth Pierce Hill had eight children. The boys were Thomas, Amaziah, and Isaac. The girls - Josina, Eliza, Julia, Roanna, and Quaria. By his second wife, Elizabeth Sparks he had two sons, John Calvin Hill, and Harvey Hill.

A basic structure of Benjamin Shaw Hill's family will be found following this narrative but I want to mention that in 1908, Dr. William H. Hill of Clarksburg, West Virginia compiled a detailed manuscript of this family. I have a copy and will gladly share it with interested persons. One of the interesting items in this manuscript concerns the family of Thomas Hill, Benjamin Shaw's first son. Thomas married Harriet Jaynes and raised

a large family at Wolf Summit, West Virginia. In 1853 they went to Ohio and bought a farm near Trial Run, not far from Sistersville, West Virginia (across the river). His whole family went with him except one daughter who married a James Hurst. They stayed in Wolf Summit.

Thomas and Harriet's first son was Joseph - born in the Clarksburg, West Virginia area in 1830. He moved to Ohio with his parents and married Hannah Whitney in 1856. Joseph and Hannah had 11 children - 6 were boys. It is incredible that all six sons were graduates of the Cincinnati Dental College! They had clinics from Cleveland, Ohio down to Wheeling and Fairmont, West Virginia as well as in other locations.

Benjamin's second son was Isaac who married Alma Leaper and moved to Missouri. Amaziah Hill married Nancy Nuzum and stayed in the Bridgeport, West Virginia area. Some present day researchers of this family indicate that Benjamin Shaw and his son, Amaziah were gifted wood craftsmen or cabinetmakers.

One record I will mention here can be found in Envelope 157 A County Court of Monongalia County, January 1808, Re : Penelope Hill. It is a letter recommending that Penelope be given to some family for "the work that she can do thus saving the taxpayers' expense." This is a letter by Calder Haymond, Overseer of the Poor, stating that he knows several people in the area that might take her in. Envelope 166-A County Court Monongalia County, 1810 states that Benjamin Hill was paid \$40⁰⁰.

for boarding and nursing Penelope Hill, "one of the poor," for a year. This would have been in 1809. Archibald Wilson was paid \$6²⁰ for furnishing Penelope Hill some clothes. Calder Haymond, Archibald Wilson, the son of George Wilson, and Benjamin Hill were originally from the Frederick County, Maryland area. There is no doubt in my mind that this Penelope Hill is the widow of Phillip Hill and the grandmother of Benjamin & Thomas Hill. As the church records in Frederick County, Maryland indicated, Penelope Hill wife of Phillip Hill left that area circa 1798. She came to the Monongalia area because she had at least one son, William Hill living there at the time. As we will see later, William died in 1805, and shortly after that, Penelope is considered "a pauper." As mentioned earlier it is possible that Grandmother Penelope was the reason that Benjamin S. and Thomas Hill went to the area now known as Marion County, West Virginia.

I will close this section by saying that there are other cases in the Court Dockets of Monongalia County which I did not look up. I feel that there may be allied family histories in and around Marion County West Virginia which may refer to Benjamin Shaw Hill and his descendants. Both of these items could prove helpful to future researchers. This family seems to fit the mold of many farmers during this period of our history who keep moving west in search of new land.

Thomas Hill Aug. 19, 1784 - 1846

Records of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick, Maryland show Thomas Hill, son of Thomas and Penelope Hill was born Aug. 19, 1784 and baptized on Oct 17, 1784.

The first adult record I could find on Thomas I mentioned earlier but will repeat here. He bought 50 acres of land on Prickett's Creek from Benonie Freeman June 11, 1810. (Deed os 5:27 Monongalia County) This deed was delivered to Archibald Wilson August 12, 1811. Deed os 9:406, December 19, 1825 shows that Thomas and Margaret Hill of Harrison County sold the above 50 acres to Asa Harris for \$150.⁰⁰ (Thomas Hill and Margaret Cooper were married in 1918)

I could find no other deeds naming Thomas as buyer or seller in Monongalia County. The only other evidence of Thomas in this area was an envelope 180 in 1816 of the Superior Court of Monongalia County. This showed Thomas as an assignee on an evidence of debt note made by one Amos Bunner. I found Thomas Hill on no road petitions or any court actions.

My next documentation of Thomas Hill is in Harrison County where he bought 43 acres of land along the Tygart Valley River, 4-4-1817 Deed Book 13, page 467. This land would be in the present day Benton's Ferry area of Marion County - four or five miles east of the Booth Creek, Mononga, West Virginia area. This is the same vicinity where his brother, Benjamin Shaw settled.

It is in this area of present day Marion County that Thomas is now close to the home farm of Margaret Cooper. She was the daughter of McClain Thomas
McClain Cooper and Rebecca Wilson Cooper who originally came from the area around Cumberland, Maryland. This information was found in the Tetrick Papers in Clarksburg, West Virginia and was sent in by Mrs. Julia Ann Kliseman of Shinnston, West Virginia on June 1, 1930. The Tetrick genealogical work - which is extensive - is on micro-film at the University of West Virginia library in Morgantown. The originals are in the office of Mr. Tetrick's son, W. G. Tetrick in Clarksburg. Thomas M. Cooper Thomas Hill's father-in-law is buried near Launder Chapel, between Clarksburg and Grafton. Rebecca Cooper, his mother-in-law is buried at Eldora, West Virginia in the Martin Cemetery. Margaret Cooper Hill had four sisters and five brothers. Some stayed in the Marion and Taylor County area of West Virginia. Some went west.

~~After Thomas and Margaret married they went to Monongalia County to live for they are found on the 1820 census there. Horace, the oldest son of this union would have been born there, and Eliza Hill, the second child would have been born on that same 50 acres on Prickett's Creek, Monongalia County. Even though the family owned 100 acres of land at this time, the two 50 acre tracts were eight to ten miles apart. A change was made. In the Harrison County Deed Book 17, Page 173 dated March 14, 1825 Thomas Hill bought 118 acres on Teverbrough Run from Jacob Barnes. This creek empties into the West River just south of what is now Worthington, WV.~~

Thomas and Margaret paid \$250⁰⁰ for this property. It wasn't until December 19, 1825 that Thomas and Margaret sold the 50 acre tract on Prickett's Creek to Asa Harris in an aforementioned deed. Harrison County Deed Book 20, page 403, 10-31-85 shows Thomas and Margaret selling their Tygart Valley land to Edward Vincent. I mention these to make a point. Margaret and Thomas still had \$250⁰⁰ cash to buy the Teoverbaugh farm as their other land had not yet been sold. \$250⁰⁰ was no small sum at that time and it is a mystery to me how this sum of cash could be raised from working a small farm. Thomas still must have been engaged in some other business that I have been unable to discover. Perhaps he was making liquid corn or barrels in which to ship it down the river - many others were at that time.

It was here on Teoverbaugh Creek that Thomas and Margaret raised the rest of their children with the exception of Israel Nicklin still. If one were to look at an older map of West Virginia and go west from Washington one would pass thru Festus, WV before coming to Four States, WV. Festus is the location of the Thomas and Margaret still farm and the present day Teoverbaugh Chapel was on this farm. Deed Book 19, page 346 of Harrison County shows Thomas still deeding "to the Methodist Episcopal Church 1 acre on Teoverbaugh" 4-20-1829. Thomas stipulates in the deed that when the Methodists or Clappers are not using the church it may be used as a schoolhouse. He was obviously interested in education.

One indication of his ability can be found in the Harrison County Court Minute Book 1829-1832:35 Entry for September 21, 1829: "Ordered that Thomas Hill be appointed surveyor of the road leading from the mouth of Teverbough to the Station Fork on said run." "Station Fork on said run" is Festus West Virginia.

Harrison County Deed Book 25, page 382 dated March 23, 1838 shows Thomas and Margaret Hill buying 65 acres on Teverbough from William A. Sandy. This property added to the 113 acres they already owned gave them a total of 178 acres of land less one acre for the Teverbough Chapel. There was a sawmill on the Sandy property which might be a clue as to the type of work in which Thomas was involved. It was just four months after this purchase that Lycurgus, the next to last son of Thomas and Margaret reached his second birthday.

It seems that land and timber were to play an important part in the lives of this Hill family. By 1839 or 1840 they had been on Teverbough for approximately fifteen years. It was time to move on and expand. As is usual in those times movement was to the west but not too far from the mountains and rivers. This trait was nourished by the fact that Benjamin and Thomas were born not a stone's throw away from the great Potomac River and a few paces from the Catoctin and Shenandoah Mountains.

As a crow flies, from the Teverbaugh farm to McKim Creek in Tyler County, West Virginia is not over forty miles. It is here on McKim that the family now settles — still in the woods and not far from a big river, the Ohio.

At this time I will mention two other hills of interest to me. A William Hill whom I feel could be a son of Phillip and Penelope Hill and therefore an uncle to Benjamin Shaw and Thomas was located, as mentioned, in the Benton's Ferry area of Harrison County as early as 1794. According to his will (1805 Harrison County Wills) he had five sons and one daughter. His first son was Phillip who along with the deceased's wife, Mary is executor of his father's will. The other sons mentioned are William Hill, Jr. who was on Prickett's Creek when Thomas and Benjamin were there, Abraham, Jacob, and James. One daughter, Katherine is also mentioned. Harrison and Monongalia County marriage bonds indicate that most of these sons marry locally, start families and then start moving away. James of William, born 6-17-1773 died 5-3-1842, married Mary Fitz Randolph. (Fitz Randolph later descendants dropped the "Fitz" part of their name and became simply Randolph). This marriage took place in 1795 when James was about 22 years old. About ten years later James Hill and family migrated to Warren County, Ohio and settled on a farm owned by Jonathon Fox. This farm is located one mile north of Pleasant Plains in Hamilton Township. James

Hill died on May 3, 1842 and was buried in the farm cemetery on lands then owned near Loveland, Ohio. In 1960 a Mr. Earl Wagner of Cincinnati owned this farm. I believe it is referred to today as the Ramsey Cemetery. Old "Henry" of Frederick, Maryland has a son buried in that cemetery, also. The son is Henry's youngest - John. Numerous uncles, cousins, nephews, etc of "Old" Henry were buried there. Be they coming from North Carolina, Maryland, Virginia or South Carolina it seems as tho the Cincinnati area of the northwest territory acted as a magnet for this family. Descendants of this Hill clan are scattered all along the Ohio River down to Cincinnati up the Miami River Valley past Troy, Ohio very early in our nation's history. It is this type of evidence plus the overlapping of friends and acquaintances, witnesses, court papers, etc. which convinces me that William Hill (d. 1805) was an older brother of Thomas who was the father of our Benjamin Shaw and Thomas Hill. Similarly I believe that "Old" William and "Old" Thomas are the sons of Phillip who died in 1774 - a year after his father - Old Henry of Frederick, Maryland died.

(A final note on this family; from my research it looks as if the sons of William Hill (d. 1805) are eight or ten years older than Thomas and Benjamin Shaw Hill, their cousins .

At this same period of time in present day Marion County there was a James Hill family living not more than a mile and a half north of Thomas's Teverbrough farm. Circumstantial evidence points to the probability that this James is a brother of the previously mentioned William. Another uncle of our boys I have a family group sheet of this family.

The Samuel Hill family who bought property from Jacob Prickett and has sons marrying into the Prickett family is probably from Pennsylvania. I have been unable to find any connection between this Samuel and Benjamin Shaw and Thomas. This Samuel died in 1854 at 81 years of age and is buried at the Prickett's Fort Cemetery with his wife, Rachel. Marion County records show that he was the son of a Jonathan Hill who came from Hunterdon County, New Jersey into Fayette County, Pennsylvania. I believe that our Benjamin Shaw Hill and Thomas Hill were in the area before Samuel bought his land from Jacob Prickett in 1816 (Monongala County Deed os 7: 127).

There was a Robert Hill family active in the Presbyterian Church in the Morgantown area with our Maryland group. I have been unable to connect this group with our Hells. There was some association between these hill groups. The population was so sparse at that time that everyone knew everyone else. It seems from the records that this Robert Hill family came down from Fayette County, Pennsylvania having originated in York County, Pennsylvania.

The only other Hill family I could find in this area of West Virginia was a William Hill and family who were Mulattos. He was in the Revolutionary War and migrated from Port Tobacco in southern Charles County, Maryland. I did not research this family and have no family group sheet on it.

Thomas Hill of McKim, West Virginia

Back to my great-great grandfather, Thomas Hill of McKim Creek, Meade District, Tyler County, West Virginia. McKim is located just a few miles north of Pennsboro across the Ritchie County line and two miles east of the Pleasants County line. As you drive north on the Mountain Road take a left turn on Haddox Road and drive up McKim Creek to the first branch. Take the right turn at the fork. Travel approximately two miles and you are in the middle of McKim, West Virginia. This spot could have easily been called Hillsboro, Hilltown, or a like name, for this is in the middle of "our" Hill family.

Tyler County Deed Book 7, page 17 shows Thomas Hill buying 400 acres on McKim Creek in 1838. The seller of this land was John Carruthers. Carruthers bought 800 acres from Moses and Joseph Chapline a few months before selling half of it to Thomas. The Chapline family speculated in land from the very early days of Maryland. On January 16, 1839 Thomas Hill bought 50 acres of land from John Booth which had previously been

deeded to one Caleb Hedley by a Treasury Warrant No. 10723. A Josiah Morgan had also owned this warrant before Thomas Hill settled the land. On January 18, 1839 Thomas Hill and Henry Collins bought a Treasury Warrant No. 10725 which deeded 250 acres on McKim Creek to them. January 26, 1839, by virtue of Treasury Warrant 14122 which had been issued to one David Hickman, Thomas Hill bought another 50 acres on McKim Creek. Thus, by the end of January 1839 Thomas owned 750 acres on McKim Creek, Tyler County, West Virginia; 250 acres of which was in partnership with Henry Collins, another Prickett's Creek acquaintance.

From early 1839 until his death in 1846 Thomas starts deeding parts of his holdings to his older children, Horace and Eliza. I haven't figured exactly how much Horace gets, but Eliza got 100 acres. In 1851, Deed Book 12, page 52, Eliza sells her land to her brother, Horace.

As the daughters of Thomas and Margaret marry and move out of the area, the sons remain on the homeplace and buy their sisters interests in the property. In January of 1857 a final division of Thomas Hill, deceased, estate is made. A plat and the conditions of the division are on record at the Tyler County Court House. It seems that the family was waiting for Lycurgus Hill to reach his 21st. birthday before the division is made. It is my feeling that the matter may have been pressed into court by son, Roland T. Hill because shortly after he got his share he sold it and left the area. In checking the census of 1850 on, and reading the division papers, I gather

that Thomas' widow, Margaret Cooper Hill lived with one son or another until her death in 1874. Most of the time she lived with son, Lycurgus and his family.

Thomas and Margaret Hill are buried close to each other at McKim Cemetery. For those descendants with more than a passing interest in their family heritage it is a "must" to see this cemetery. Under the guiding hand of Palmer Hill, a great, great, great grandson of Thomas and Margaret, the cemetery is protected and well kept - a fitting monument to the past, yet serving the present generations. It is located on a small knoll just behind the spot where the church, the schoolhouse and the store-post office used to stand. The only structure still standing at McKim is the home that Lycurgus and his family built after he sold his farm. We now have the Hill family launched in Meade District, Tyler County, West Virginia. The following material will show large families were reared and headed out in various directions.

The only child born at McKim was Israel Nicklin Hill, June 28, 1840. He was named after Dr. Israel Nicklin, M.D. of Middlebourne, West Virginia. As mentioned before Dr. Nicklin was associated earlier with the Hells on Pickett Creek. (Deed Book 13, page 85, 1889 shows the sale of Dr. Nicklin's property in Middlebourne by a special commission.) In the recently published history of Tyler County one can find some discrepancies relating to this Hill family but the basic family structure is correct and makes for interesting and informative reading.

"What goes 'round comes 'round" and each of Thomas and Margaret Hill's children start their own lives - each having a thousand tales to tell but never an ending do the story.

Following is a brief summary of each of the children with more elaboration of my direct line, Lycurgus and Louise Lantz Hill. I do this with hopes that other family members will do the same for their particular line.

Horace Hill and his wife Margaret Davis (1st wife) are buried in McKim Cemetery as are some of their children. When Margaret Davis died Horace married Margaret Ireland. This second marriage produced one son, Roland T. Hill not to be confused with Horace's brother of the same name. It seems that when Thomas died Horace, his son, became the father figure for this family.

Eliza Hill was about seventeen when the family moved to McKim. She later married John Maddox and moved first to the Jane Lou area of Lewis County where she was a faithful member of the Broad Run Baptist Church. From there the family moved to the Pleasant Valley area of Jackson County, just south of Ripley, and was active in establishing the Grass Lick Baptist Church. Eliza Hill Maddox is buried in the cemetery of Grass Lick Baptist Church. "Uncle" Willie Stalnaker of Glen, West Virginia, a descendant of Eliza's, has her bible.

Benjamin S. Hill married Sara Wells and they raised their family on McKim. Both are buried in the McKim Cemetery. It is interesting to note that Thomas and Margaret named this son after Thomas' brother, Benjamin Shaw Hill.

Flora Ann Hill married James Gaston Maddox, the brother of John Maddox, husband of her sister, Eliza. This family took the same route to Jane Lou and then to Jackson County as Eliza and John Maddox did. Flora Ann Hill Maddox is buried close to her sister, Eliza at the Grass Lick Baptist Cemetery in Jackson County, West Virginia.

Elizabeth Hill married Henry Howard. She died in 1860, a young woman.

Roland Taylor Hill married Harriet Davis. I feel that she may be the sister of Horace's first wife, Margaret Davis. (Horace and Margaret named one of their daughters, Harriet.) Roland T. remains a mystery to me. Family researchers state that he and his wife died on the same day in 1891. I have no idea of his whereabouts or activities after he sold his share of his father's inheritance.

Lycurgus Hill, the fourth son of Thomas and Margaret Cooper Hill is my great grandfather. He married Louise Lantz on May 20, 1860. She was the daughter of Jacob and Minerva Minor Lantz. They raised their family of two sons and three daughters on McKim. Two other daughters died young and are buried in McKim Cemetery.

Israel Nicklin "Doc" Hill, the fifth and youngest son, married Elizabeth McCullough. They raised a large family in the McKim area. Both are buried in the McKim Cemetery.

By the 20th century the descendants of "Old" Henry Hill of Frederick, Maryland have made and are making contributions in all walks of life. From poor tenant farmers to proud property owners; from illiteracy to scholarly achievements; from the Indian conflict through the American Revolution, the Civil War, and more recent conflicts; from the clearing of land to the creation of farms and businesses Henry's descendants have contributed to the building of our country.

My wife and I realize that this material is but a skeleton of the family of Henry Hill. Our hope is that future researchers and genealogists of this family will build on this narrative to form a more complete picture. I have additional information on each of Henry's sons which I will be glad to share with anyone who is interested; this includes family group sheets.

We met wonderful people during this year and a half. We travelled to parts of our country we had never seen before. We discovered relatives we had not known existed. We spoke to people from coast to coast via the telephone. Always the scenery was beautiful and the people friendly. Good luck to future "an-searchers" of "Old" Henry Hill of Frederick, Maryland.
