HILDRETH, Samuel b 1750 Townsend, Mass.; d 6 August 1823 Belpre, Ohio; m 21 May 1776 Abigail Bodwell. Served as a surgeon of a regiment of militia. In October 1777 the regiment was ordered out to assist in the capture of Burgoyne's army. He was present at the surrender. In 1778 he was surgeon of a 16 gun brigade that sailed from Marblehead, Mass. under the command of Capt. Conway. In 1780 he sailed from Salem, Mass. as a surgeon of a vessel under command of Capt. Putnam Cleves. The brigade was captured by a British five gun ship, and all on board were sent to Canada where they remained in captivity for 2 years and 6 months.
