ISAAC HILL 1/

This Isaac Hill has not yet been identified but I believe  
his family originated from Chowan County, N.C.

Isaac Hill 1/, of North Carolina, was a Revolutionary Soldier  
and first married Ann Harrison in Johnston County, N.C..  
While away during the war, his wife Anna Harrison died. Just  
who all of their children were is not presently known but is  
believed that both Hinton A. Hill 2/ and Amos Hill 2/  
were sons.

Isaac Hill 1/ remarried a second time to a woman named  
Elizabeth Sing. Isaac Hill 1/ moved his family to Georgia  
and settled in Habersham County, Georgia, where he died on  
the 20th October 1844. (Reference Voucher 54754).

On 20th October 1844, a son Amos Hill, age 84, filed  
Application (R-5001) to receive benefits due to his father's  
military service. The son Amos Hill 2/ was apparently raised  
by a Weatherington or Weatherford family up in North  
Carolina. His mother is suspected to have been Anna  
Harrison, or the first wife to Isaac Hill 1/.

Amos Hill 2/ was born ca. 1775 in Johnston County, N.C. and  
married ca. 1800 to a woman named Mary, who is suspected to  
have been Mary Jones. She is listed as having died in  
Habersham County, Georgia before 1843. It appears that they  
had five children (named later).

Amos Hill 2/ married a second time to Elizabeth Smith, a  
widow of James Smith of Rabun County, Georgia sometime  
around 1843. To date, there has been found no known children  
of this second marriage.

Amos Hill 2/ was a Baptist. His children by his first  
marriage to Mary (Jones?) were:

1. David Hill 3/, born 1804 in Moore County, N.C. He married on 7 December 1826 to Elizabeth Eaton in Habersham County, Georgia (ref: Book A, Page 98). He died between 18809-1891 in White County, Georgia.
2. Nancy R. Hill 3/, was born 8 March 1806 in Moore County, N.C. She married on 17 December 1835 in Habersham County, Georgia (Ref: Book A, Page 237) to Reverend John C. Harris. Nancy died on 28 December 1885 in Habersham County, Georgia and is buried in Batesville, Georgia in the Providence Baptist Churchyard.
3. Bryant Hill 3/, was born on 11 October 1809 in Moore County, N.C. He married Ruth Daniel on 17 July 1831 in Habersham County, Georgia. He died on 2 May 1889 in Habersham County and is buried in Batesville, Georgia in the Providence Baptist Churchyard.
4. Mary Hill 3/, was born on 12 January 1815 in Moore County, N.C. She married Archer J. Harris on 12 February 1837 in Habersham County, Georgia (Ref: Book A, Page 271). Mary died on 26 June 1881 and likewise is buried in the churchyard of the Providence Baptist Churchyard in Batesville, Georgia.
5. Dicy Hill 3/, little information on her is found but she married Jesse B. Harris on 8 July 1842 in Habersham County, Georgia (Ref: Book B, Page 14). Jesse Harris was killed in Civil War.

#### FAMILY OF BRYANT HILL AND WIFE RUTH DANIEL HILL

As stated above, Bryant Hill 3/ was born on 11 October 1809 in N.C., married on 17 July 1831, and died on 2nd May 1889. He is buried in Batesville, Georgia in the churchyard of the Providence Baptist Church.

His wife Ruth Daniel Hill was born on 26 June 1815 in N.C. and died on 10th October 1909.

children:

1. Wilson Lumpkin Hill 4/, was born on 27 April 1833, married Sara Cole on 26 August 1858 in Tennessee. He died on 11 September 1917 and is buried in Providence Baptist Church in Habersham County, Ga. Sarah Cole Hill (wife) was born on 20 June 1837 in N.C., and died on 9 October 1912. They has 10 children.
2. Elizabeth Hill 4/, born in December of 1834 and died after 1900. Had one child by James Moore. She married Jesse Morrison in 1885. He was granted guardianship of her daughter that year and he died in 1890, buried at Providence Baptist Church Cemetery. The grave for Elizabeth has not been

located.

3. Adoniram Hill 4/, was born on 23 February 1837. He married on 21 July 1859 to Nancy Elizabeth Hardy (b. 1839 in Henry Co., Va. and d. 1926). Adoniram Hill 4/ died on 7 January 1929. He is buried at Hill's Crossing Cemetery, Habersham County, Georgia. They had eight (8) children.
4. Sarah Hill 4/, born 1839, married James L. Hurt on 20 August 1857, and she died on 9 October 1912. She is buried at Hazel Creek Baptist Churchyard in Habersham County, Georgia. Had some children.
5. James Hinton Hill 4/, was born on 4 March 1841 and died in 1908 in Cherokee County, Georgia. He married 3 times, the 1st on April 1st, 1866 to Martha Matilda Wilson Allen, widow of Joseph Allen, who died at Vicksburg in 1862. His second wife was M.A. Young, who he married on 24 October 1877, and who died ca. 1898 in Hall County, Georgia. His 3rd wife was Sophia Daniel, whom he married on 5 May 1901 in Cherokee County, Georgia and who died in 1909.
6. William Daniel Hill 4/, was born on 15 January 1843. He died on 12 March 1926 and is buried in Bethlehem Baptist Cemetery in Habersham County, Georgia. He married on 23 May 1865 to Sallie A. Hardy (15 Jan. 1843 in Va.-d. 22 Oct. 1925. There were 11 children.
7. Isaac Newton Hill 4/, was born on 2nd December 1844. He married on 16 January 1866 to Elizabeth Margaret Tatum (1 Nov. 1842-30 Mar. 1926). There were 8 children.
8. Amos Jackson Hill 4/, was born on 18 November 1846. He died on 6 March 1917 in Stephens County, Georgia. He married 1st on 7 July 1868 to Rachel Rebecca Wood (b. 28 Nov. 1850-d. 20 Jan. 1894). His 2nd wife was Mary Ella Katherine Smith Johnson (b.14 Feb. 1877-d. ??) There were a total of 18 children by this man.
9. Ceclia C. Hill 4/, was born on 24 January 1849 and died on 6 January 1889. She married Montville Taylor Wood on 13 February 1868. Husband was born 16 May 1847 and died 7 December 1819. He is buried Middle River Baptist Cemetery, Franklin County, Georgia. Cecila is buried at ??
10. Nancy Malinda "Linn" Hill 4/, was born on 8 February 1852 and died on 28 April 1923. She married John Corn Wilson in 1867. John was born on 22 March 1845, died 17 October 1897. Burial at Providence Cemetery. There were 13 children.
11. Malissa Jane Hill 4/, born 20 January 1853 and died 26 June 1926 (unmarried). Burial at Bethlehem Baptist Cemetery in Habersham County, Georgia.
12. Georgia Marietta Hill 4/, born 9 July 1855. She died on 28 December 1941, burial at Blue Creek

Baptist Cemetery, White County, Georgia. She married in 1874 in White County, Georgia to Hugh A. Tatum (b. 4 March 1847-d. 21 Nov. 1915) There were 8 children.

13. Thomas Jefferson Hill 4/, born 7 March 1858 and died on 16 December 1920 in Anderson County, S.C. He married Amanda Elizabeth Watson on 21 May 1882. She was born in 1864 and died on 27 December 1927, and is buried at Rock Creek Baptist Churchyard in Stephens County, Georgia. There were 2 children.
