REUBEN BARRETT 1/.

Reuben Barrett 1/ of South Carolina was born ca. 1756. The actual location of his birth is unknown. He apparently married twice, the first to a woman known only as Hannah. His second marriage was to Thomisa (Thomison) Prince in June of 1818. Thomisa Prince was born in 1768 and she died on the 29th of August 1856 in Greenville County, South Carolina.

Reuben Barrett 1/ died on the 3rd of March in 1814 in Greenville County, South Carolina. He did not name a wife in his will but left a widow, Thomisa.

His will was dated 25th April 1812, and was probated on 17th March 1814 in Greenville County, South Carolina. The Estate settlement covers the time from 3rd March 1814 thru 15th February 1823. It contains records from both John and David Barrett 2/. The Equity records go from 3rd of February 1823 through February 1824. Many of the records were not dated.

Reuben Barrett 1/, was a veteran of the Revolutionary War and was awarded over 1,000 acres of land in Greenville County, South Carolina. He served under Captain Holloway's Company and Colonels Thomas and Roebuck's Regiments. He was enumerated in the 1790 Census in Greenville County, South Carolina.

The children (all born in S.C.) of Reuben Barrett 1/ were:

1. John Barrett 2/, born (one source says ca. 1776) another says 1784, married Milly Chastain in Greenville County, S.C. She died ca. 1820; 2nd marriage to Rebecca Stanton (born 1785). She died in 1857 in Hall County, Georgia. John Barrett 2/ died in 1853 in Hall County, Georgia. He moved from S.C. ca. 1818.
2. David Barrett 2/. (no other info).
3. Margaret Barrett 2/, born 25 September 1788, married Henry Prince (b. 18 August 1790). They married before

- 30th November 1821. Margaret Barrett 2/ died on the 11th of February 1859 and her husband died on the 22nd of August 1857, both in Greenville County, S.C.
4. Reuben Barrett 2/. He served 200 days in Revolutionary War. Had two horses shot from under him, was in Spartan Regiment.
  5. Joseph Barrett 2/, married Elizabeth Bennett. He was a Revolutionary Soldier in S.C., under Roebucks' Company. He was killed by Tories in 1781.
  6. Mary (Polly) Barrett 2/, married David Jackson. It is known that she married before 25th April 1812.
  7. Nancy (Sulur) Barrett 2/. (no other info although she is said to be listed in the 1850 Census of Greenville County, S.C. on page 370. (Why no birth date given??)
  8. Hannah Barrett 2/. (no other info).
  9. Prudence Plumley Barrett 2/, born 1804.
  10. Auther Barrett 2/. (no other info).
  11. William Barrett 2/, born 1809. (No other info).
  12. Elizabeth (Betsey) Wilson Barrett 2/, born 11 June 1806, married Pendleton I. Hutchins on 19th May 1836. He was born 29th May 1811 & died 31st March 1881 in Forsyth County, Ga. Elizabeth Barrett 2/ died 21st June 1883 in Forsyth County, Ga. She was the youngest child.

Notes:

It is known that Authur & William Barrett 2/ were the two youngest sons and Prudence & Elizabeth Barrett 2/ were the two youngest daughters. Elizabeth was the youngest child.

Apparently John Barrett 2/ lived on the plantation and cared for his two sisters Prudence and Elizabeth until 1818, when he left the state.

David Barrett 2/ paid John Barrett 2/  
\$ 15.25 between April 1st, 1821 and April 1st, 1822 for care of Prudence Barrett 2/.

Both Prudence & Elizabeth Barrett 2/ lived with brother David Barrett 2/ for about two years starting in 1818.

Arthur Barrett 2/ stated that John Barrett 2/, in 1817, sold a horse for \$ 75 then sold the note from that sale to his son for \$ 65. On the 1817 return of the estate, John listed \$ 65 from Casswell Barrett for a note by the hand of Young Griffin.

JOHN BARRETT 2/, SON OF REUBEN BARRETT 1/.

John Barrett 2/ moved to Hall County, Georgia ca. 1818, having come from Pendelton County, South Carolina, via way of Franklin and Habersham Counties, Georgia.

He settled two miles northwest of Mule Camp Springs, now Gainesville, Georgia. His farm adjoined both sides of Camp Creek, near where the creek empties into the Chatahoochee River. The town of Gainesville was laid off in 1820 and John helped to clear off the town square.

He bought a parcel of land in Hall County from a Jacob Owen of Green County, Georgia. It was land lot number 157 in the 9th district on waters of Camp Creek and contained 250 acres. The price of the land was \$325.00. This land today is covered by Lake Lanier and was once the old golf course.

John Barrett 2/ was married first to Milly Rebecca Chastain, of French Huguenot stock and the daughter of Abraham Chastain, born ca. 1743, a son of Pierre and Mildred Archer Chastain.

Abraham Chastain named the heirs of Milly Barrett, deceased, in his will, which was administered on 17th May 1823 in Greenville County, South Carolina.

John Barrett 2/ died in 1853 and was buried in a cemetery atop of a hill at the end of Holly Drive, which is said to be located about a half mile from the Barrett home place. This area overlooks Lake Lanier.

The widow (2nd wife) Rebecca Stanton Barrett died in 1857 and she left a will recorded in Hall County, Georgia, which was probated on 1st June 1857. Executor was her son Capel Asbury Barrett 3/, who also administered his father's estate.

The Will of John Barrett 2/ stated that the southern portion of the north part of his land was to be equally divided between E.C. and F. M. Barrett, James T. Barrett, Reuben Barrett, C.A. Barrett, John R. Barrett Sr., Sally Pittman and Martha Williams. They were also to have several Negroes, the wagon and two lots of land in Forsyth County. The Executor, C.A. Barrett, if need be, to sell lots in Forsyth County and make titles to them.

Abstracted Will of Rebecca Stanton Barrett:  
Hall County, Georgia April 8th, 1857.. Quoted

"After my death, my Negro woman, Polly, and her increase is to be sold and proceeds equally divided among my five living children:

C.A. Barrett; William M. Barrett; Lotty Pittman, wife of John Pittman; John R. Barrett (Jr.); Francis A. Barrett; and the lawful heirs of my deceased daughter Martha Williams, wife of Russell J. Williams. The heirs of daughter Martha to receive the sum of one dollar.

The farming tools and books and wagon to be equally divided

between two sons, Francis A. Barrett and William M. Barrett.

The one half of household and kitchen furniture, one half of cattle and hogs, one half of bees, and one half of meat and lard and corn to be equally divided among the five living children; also notes and money."

- iii. Emma Barrett 5/, b. 7 September 1860, d. 22 July 1933, Waco, TX. She m. John James Jones on 29 Dec. 1885, they had 4 children.

Cemetery, in Waco, TX. They had 2 children.

òÂ. James Tarrance Barrett 3/, born 1803 in South Carolina. He married Sarah Mabry (b. 7 Feb. 1809 Franklin Co., Ga.) on 9th October 1827 in Hall County, Georgia. Sarah was probably a sister to Nancy, wife of Elisha C. Barrett 3/. James T. Barrett 3/ died on 19th January 1867 at Barrettsville, Georgia, Dawson County, Georgia. James bought some land from the Indians in what is today Dawson County, Ga. and what was then Lumpkin County. He joined his half brother John R. (Jack) and started a trading post and founded a town called Barrettsville. Only the Salem Methodist Church remains part of Barrettsville since it was a part of the land bought by Lockheed several years ago and the town was bulldozed down. The church contains the graves of John R. Barrett and many others. This is located about 2 miles west of a small town called Silver City. on Route 9, between Dawsonville and Cumming. Children were:

Elisha Chastain Barrett 3/, born 13th June 1806 in South Carolina. He was about 12 years old when the family moved to Hall County, Georgia. He helped to lay out the public square in Gainesville, Georgia. He married Mary Mabry (sister to Sarah, wife of James T. Barrett 3/, on 15th January 1828 in Hall County, Ga. She was the daughter of Patrick Mabry & Margaret Baker Mabry. She died ca. 1849 and is buried in the Barrett lot along with Mrs. Lee Anna Barrett, born 1 June 1823, died 23 July 1910 (a daughter?). Elisha Barrett 3/ died on 13th May 1886 and was buried in Alta Vista Cemetery.

- a. Sarah Arminda Barrett 4/, b. 27th October 1828, d. 29th August 1859. Married William Pugh Smith (b. York Co., S.C. 11 Dec. 1816, d. on 7th Nov. 1892) on 9 Nov. 1845. He is buried at Alta Vista Cemetery. He and Sarah had 5 children.
- i. Martha Jane Barrett 5/, b. 8th November

- 1846, m. Calvin Shepard of Conn. She d. 2nd September 1889. Both buried Alta Vista Cemetery, Gainesville, Ga. They had 2 children.
- ii. George W. Barrett 5/, b. 19th May 1848, d. 10th October 1885, m. Amelia De Fronfriede, had 3 children.
  - iii. Ella Indiana Barrett 5/, b. 11th July 1850, d. 13th July 1917. She m. George W. Walker.

  - iii. Elisha Parks Parnell 5/, b. 28th May 1857, died some years ago, m. to Mary Hardy, they had 6 children.

Paris of Cade County, near Wildwood, GA, where he died. She had no children
- d. William Wesley Barrett 4/, b. 20th January 1835, d. 30th December 1911. Buried Alta Vista Cemetery in Gainesville, GA. Was in CSA as a volunteer, having joined in March 1862 and

#### LATER FINDINGS:

Green Robert Barrett 4/, probably a son of William M. Barrett 3/ and a grandson of John Barrett 2/, was born in Hall County, Georgia on 1st June 1839. He married Margaret Elizabeth Sexton on 2nd of June 1861 in Hall County. She was born in September of 1844. He died in Cedartown on 12th September 1935. Both are buried in Lime Branch Cemetery in Cedartown.

Green Robert Barrett 4/ enlisted in the Confederate Army on 4th March 1862 and served until the war ended. He was wounded once but returned to duty after 3 weeks. After the war, he returned to Gainesville, Ga. and stayed until ca. 1869 when the family moved to Alabama. They moved to Polk County, Georgia ca. 1885 where they live until they died.

The mother of Green Robert Barrett 4/ was named Salena Barrett, who was listed in the 1850 Census of Hall County, as Head of the Household, age 25 and born in South Carolina. Children named & living in the household in the 1850 Census were:
