KY.004 GENEALOGY DATA ON HILLS OF VIRGINIA, WHO'S MEMBERS MOVED INTO KENTUCKY.

The following information provided by Mrs. James J. Bushnell. 2919 Fairway Drive, Birmingham, Ala. 35213 in July 1986... Information in bold print from my files.

JOHN HILL SR. BORN ca. 1745 (where?) DIED 1808 in Clark Co., Ky. married 1st Lucy Luck (B.CA.1748-D.1771), daughter of Samuel and Mary Luck of Hanover County Virginia. 2nd marriage to Elizabeth Marshall (B. CA. 1750-D. 1825 in Clark Co., Ky). Note by R. Hill: These dates disagree with mine which says Elizabeth Marshall was born ca 1785, died 1814. She was daughter of Robert Marshall Jr. of Virginia.

CHILDREN OF JOHN HILL SR. BY 1ST MARRIAGE:

1. Garland Hill (b. 11 March 1771 in Virginia, (d. 19 Feb. 1852 Taylorsville, ILL. (Christian Co.) 2. Married 1st Phoebe Samuel on 14 December 1793, in Caroline Co., Va. (dau of James Samuel and wife Sarah, who later removed to Caswell Co., N.C: 2nd marriage to Elizabeth Wade on 4 Sept. 1801, in Caswell Co., N.C. (She d. by 1809): 3rd marriage to Eda Tooll (sic) in Clark Co., Ky. on 3rd June 1809.

CHILDREN OF JOHN HILL SR. BY 2ND MARRIAGE:

- 2. William Hill (b.ca. 1775 in Virginia, d. by 9 Jan. 1827 in Clark Co., Ky. He never married.
- 3. John P. (Phillip) Hill (b. ca. 1778-79 in Virginia, d. Dec. 1835 in Todd Co., Ky. He married 1st. Elizabeth Marshall on 4 Jan. 1801 in Clark Co., Ky. She died by Nov. 1814. 2nd marriage to Malinda Marshall in Fayette Co., Ky. on 23 Dec. 1814. She was dead by Sept of 1821 in Todd Co., Ky. His 3rd marriage was to Mrs. Elizabeth (Trabue) Ingram on 3rd Dec. 1821 in Logan Co., Ky. (widow of Wm. Ingram). His 4th marriage was to Winniford Browder in Logan Co., Ky. on 6th Oct. 1834.
- 4. Daughter Mary Hill (b. 15 June 1780 in Va., d. 12 Dec. 1859 in Monroe Co., Ind. She married Richard Empson (b. 25 Sept. 1777-d. 8 June 1845 in Monroe Co., Ind.) on 14 Jan. 1801 in Clark Co., Ky.
- 5. Daughter Nancy Hill (b. ca. 1782 in Virginia, married Nathan Martin in Clark Co., Ky. on 10 Nov. 1802. They removed to Todd Co., Ky in 1819.

- 6. Daughter Elizabeth Hill (b. ca. 1784 in Virginia, married 15 Aug. 1804 to Josiah Ashley in Clark Co., Ky. Date of her death unknown.
 - a. dau. Lucy Ashley b. 1808 in Clark Co., Ky., married 9 Aug. 1824 to General Thomas Hart in Clark Co., Ky, a brother of Joel Hart, the famous sculptor.
- 7. Daughter Lucy Hill (b. ca. 1787 in Virginia, married 30 March 1808 to Hudson Clark in Clark Co., Ky. They lived in Madison Co., Ky.

Note by Robert Hill: Reference to above Clark County Kentucky Info... In Volume 5, page 339 of "The Abridged Compendium of American Genealogy" located in Columbia S.C. at the South Carolinian Library it states:

A Horace Buckner Hill, a banker of Louisville, was the son of a Leonard Hill and Elizabeth Hill. Horace Hill married Susan Talbot Oldham.

Now there was a Leonard Hill with a wife Elizabeth in Fairfield District South Carolina, prior to 1788. He fought in the American Revolution in S.C. and later this Leonard Hill moved to Kentucky (Fayette County, later Clark County) and was in the Kentucky 1790 Census of Clark County. He sold his South Carolina land (82 acres) in 1788 to a Thomas Hill and wife Judith. Both Leonard Hill & his wife Elizabeth Hill signed the Bill of Sale, dated 26th May 1788. It is believed that Leonard was a brother of my ancestor, Moses Hill, also of Fairfield District S.C. and Thomas Hill, who bought his S.C. land. (This has not yet been proven).

The Thomas Hill, with wife Judith, later purchased land in Fairfield County S.C., that was originally granted to a Charles Hill 1/, who left the land to his son William Augusta Hill 2/, who then left it to his son Richard Hill 3/ (wife Agnes), who sold it to a Jane Rogers, a spinster. Jane Rogers then sold it to a Shadrick Knowland. Knowland in turn sold it to the above Thomas Hill (wife Judith).

I am of the opinion that Moses, Leonard and the above Thomas Hill were brothers, and that Charles Hill Sr. (wife Nancy) was their uncle. His son Charles C. Hill (wife Mary) is implied to be a cousin of Moses Hill in the remains of his bible. If this be true then the only way Charles C. Hill Jr. could be a cousin is for his father (Charles Hill Sr.) the uncle to Moses Hill.

Since we know that William Augustus (Augusta) Hill 2/ was a son of Charles Hill Sr. 1/, he would have to be the brother of Charles C. Hill Jr. 2/ thus he would also be a cousin to Moses, Leonard and Thomas Hill. There is evidence of a third

Charles Hill in S.C., probably a son of Charles C. Hill Jr. 2/.

Now since Richard Hill 3/ was a son of William Augustus Hill 2/ he would be a second cousin to Moses, Leonard and Thomas Hill.

Burwell Hill (A Revolutionary Soldier in S.C. tried for desertion and sentenced to serve for the duration of the war, later moved to Rutherford County, N.C. He and a George Augustus Hill are suspected to be sons of Charles C. Hill Jr. and wife Mary, thus would also be second cousins to Moses, Leonard & Thomas Hill.

CAPTAIN HARDY HILL (REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIER)

This Hardy Hill was born near or in the town of Suffolk, Nansemond County, Virginia in 1754.

The DAR Magazine (June-July 1984, Page 491 under "New Ancestors" shows

Hardy Hill, American Revolution, b. 1754, d. 17th December 1798, married Margaret ??? He was a Captain in the American Revolution from Virginia.

In a "Guide to Accumulated Data" by the Yates Publishing Co., P.O. Box 237, Ozark, MO. 65721 there are 3 pages of Hardy Hill data...

"HILL, Hardy, b. 1754 in Virginia, married in Kentucky Margaret Wallace, b. 1763 in ST (Scotland?)- Doc. Page 113.001 C!"

Another Hardy Hill in Bertie County, N.C. is listed in the Murray Genealogical Study. This is a different man, maybe a son???

HARDY HILL, married January 20th 1775 Jeaney BRYANT in Bertie Co., N.C.

Reference to Sussex Co., Va. DEed Book N, page 327

JESSE H. HILL pf Barren County, Ky appoints ISAAC HILL, friend & attorney to sell 100 acres of land in Sussex County, Virginia, the land was willed to my mother MILDRED HINES nu her father, JOhn Hines, which tract was sold by my father, ISAAC HILL to Henry Elis during my mother's lifetime, Recorded 28 February 1822.

Note: Isaac Hill married Mildred Hines on 132 September 1786
