Know ye, That for and in consideration of One Pound, eighteen shillings and three pence, Sterling Money paid by LEONARD HILL into the Treasury for the Use of this State, We have granted, and by these Presents do grant unto the said LEONARD HILL his Heirs and Assigns, a Plantation or Tract of Land, containing Eighty Two Acres situate in the District of Camden, on the Waters of Little River-

having such Shape, Form and Marks as are represented by a Plat hereunto annexed, together with all Woods, Trees, Waters, Water Courses, Profits, Commodities, Appurtenances, and Hereditaments whatsoever thereunto belonging, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of EIGHTY TWO

Acres of Land, and all and singular other the Premises hereby granted unto the said LEONARD HILL his

Heirs and Assigns, for ever, in free and common foccage.
