- 1. John Dumford, born ca. 1760.
- 2. Rebecca Dumford, born ca. 1762, married 1st Charles Hunter, 2nd Daniel Burch on 21 April 1795 in Ky. She died after 1803 in Ky.
- 3. Hannah Dumford, born ca. 1764 (possibly Rowan Co., N.C.??), married ca. 1784 (Va. later Ky) to George Haley. She died in Tazewell, Illinois between 1830-1850.
- 4. Daniel Dumford, born ca. 1766 in South Carolina, married 13th January 1787 to Sarah Horn in Madison Co., Virginia (Kentucky as of 1st June 1791). He died in 1819 in Clermont, Ohio.
- 5. Solomon Dumford, born ca. 1767/68 (probably North or South Carolina), married 1st Wife and dates unknown, 2nd marriage Susannah Knott on 12th January 1797 in Madison Co., Va. (Kentucky as of 1st June 1791).
- 6. Elizabeth Dumford, born estimated ca. 1769/70, married ca. 1787 to Leonard Hill?? in Fairfield Co., S.C., died after 1792 in Clark Co., Kemtucky.

- 7. Susannah Dumford, born about 1771/72, probably N.C. or S.C., may have married John Haineline in Ky.
- 8. Rachel Dumford, born 1775 in N.C. (1850 census data), married 27th April 1826 to Jesse Hodges in Clark Co., Ky. She died after 1850 census, probably in Ky.

Note: Both Susannah & Rachel Dumford had children by Leonard Hill, and they were so named in his will. Apparently they never were married.
