Hi,

My name is Dee Hill and WE MATCH! So I guess it is Hi, Cuz! I had my brother submit his DNA #11239 and am the sister of Nyle Hill, jr. and daughter of Nyle Hill, Sr. I am also a Hill by marriage thru DNA #11237, Darrell Hill.

I don't pretend to know anything about DNA, so I haven't figured out where our connection is. I have gone through your direct line and can't make a connection to Moses Hill. I evidently come from a different line prior to Moses. Do you have any information on who Moses' brothers were? I do not find a Moses Hill anywhere and so far have not made any connection to your line below him.

According to my records for the period of 1750-1760, I am descended from William Hill Jr. born 1737 Caroline Co. Va. thru his son Joab born 1775. William Jr. married Elizabeth Halbert in 1758. William's other children: Thomas 1759, James 1761, Mary 1764, Elizabeth 1768, William III 1773, Cynthia 1776, Frances 1778 John 1780, Green 1782 and Polly ? (no Moses).

William Hill, Sr & Susannah Smither had William Jr., Thomas Smither Hill 1739 who married Susannah Mosely and had Lewis, Jesse, Thomas, Tabitha, Sarah, Rhody, Rachael and Elizabeth; Robert 1752 who married Martha Halbert; Elizabeth 1747 who married William Halbert, Uell/Ewell 1755.

William Hill, Sr. had two brothers, Green Hill 1714 married Grace Bennett and Abner Hill 1718 and married Sarah, whom I have very little information on. Could Moses have been the son of either of these? I guess I'm really confused now. Are You? It appears, according to my records that my family came from North Carolina and Moses came from South Carolina. I suppose DNA doesn't lie, but if you could see the documentation I have: you would understand why I am confused.

If I haven't lost you completely, I hope I hear from you soon.
