HENDERSON, JAMES Account current Aug., 1774 with William Whitehead, admr. Guardianship of William Whitehead with Sally Henderson (orphan of the dec'd.) ordered settled, Feb., 1785.

HENDRIE, WILLIAM Administration grtd. John Maclellan, Nov., 1796. Record indicates the heirs of the dec'd. were John Hendrie, George Hendrie, Charles Hendrie, Robert Smith and Jane his wife, Margaret Maxwell (widow of John Maxwell) and William Watson Wright and Agnes his wife, all of Great Britain, May 5, 1804.

HENRY, MICHAEL William Perkins was apptd. gdn. of James Henry (orphan of the dec'd.) Feb., 1797. The said orphan (age 16) was bound to Willis Rhymes Nov., 1797 to learn to be a tailor. James chose Benjamin Williams as his gdn., Feb., 1801. Guardianship of William Perkins with the said orphan ordered settled, May, 1801.

HENRY, SARAH Estate ordered settled, Feb., 1824. Accounts of Thomas Burges (exr. of the dec'd.) ordered settled, Nov., 1824.

HEPTINSTALL/HIPPKINSTALL, REBECCA, JESSE, JOHN, ASA, DOLLY & MARY (orphans' account) Joel H. McLemore was apptd. gdn. of the said orphans, May, 1822. He filed gdn. accounts for John and Mary Heptinstall, May, 1830.

HEPTINSTALL/HIPPKINSTALL, WILLIAM Gdn. accounts for the orphans (unnamed) of the dec'd. were filed Feb., 1823 and Feb., 1824. Report of division of Negroes to Joshua Heptinstall et al (no names given), Aug., 1824. Account of sale of Negroes, Aug., 1824.

HERBERT, JOHN Account current Feb., 1824.

HIGGS, JACOB Division of Negroes among the legatees (no details), Aug., 1822. Account of hire of Negroes, Feb., 1829.

HIGGS, LEMUEL (SAMUEL ?) Account current Feb., 1799.

HIGGS, REUBEN, JOSEPH, JACOB & JUDIA H. (orphans' account) Gdn. accounts for the said orphans were filed Feb., 1823 and Feb., 1824. Willie Higgs filed gdn. accounts for Judah (sic), Reuben and Jacob, Feb., 1829, mentioning the estate of Jacob Higgs, dec'd. The said gdn. filed an account for Reuben Higgs, Feb., 1830.

HIGGS, THEOPHILUS Will proved Nov., 1824 with Cary Josey, witness. Samuel Bradley qualified as exr.

HILL, BENJAMIN Money was due the representatives of the dec'd. under the will of Thomas Hill, dec'd., Nov. 4, 1805. Said heirs were (1) Thomas Hill (a minor with John Huceaby, gdn.), (2) Robert Hill (a minor with John Huceaby, gdn.), (3) Polly Huceaby (a minor with John Huceaby, gdn.), (4) John Huceaby and Mary his wife, (5) Robert Adams and Sarah his wife and (6) Elizabeth Gant, dec'd., whose admr. was her husband William Gant.

HILL, BENJAMIN Estate ordered settled Feb., 1823 with Arthur Arrington, exr. Report by the commissioners (no details) on the estate, Nov., 1823.

HILL, COLLIER Will proved Aug., 1799 with William C. Hill, witness. H.C. Jones qualified as exr. Inventory Aug., 1799. Edmond Jones qualified as exr. Nov., 1799. Inventory and account of sales by the said exrs., May, 1800.

HILL, ELIZA B., WHITMILL J., WINIFRED B., THOMAS B. & MARIA ANTOINETTE (orphans' account) George E. Spruill was apptd. gdn., May, 1822 and filed a gdn. account for

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the said orphans, Feb., 1823. The said gdn. filed accounts for Winifred and Thomas B. Hill, Feb., 1829 and Feb., 1830.

HILL, JAMES The dec'd. left a widow Barbara Hill and a son John Hill. The said widow sued for her dower right of land in Edgemcombe County, Apr. 20, 1789.

HILL, JOHN Record indicates the dec'd. was the son of James and Barbara Hill, and left daughters Elizabeth, Margaret and Martha Hill, all minors, Oct. 25, 1789.

HILL, RICHARD Administration grtd. James Judge, May, 1800. The dec'd. had received a share of the estate of Thomas Hill, dec'd., Apr. 23, 1804.

HILL, ROBERT The exr. of the dec'd. was his son Henry Hill, Apr. 23, 1804 and Nov. 4, 1805.

HILL, THOMAS B. A gdn. account was filed for the orphans (unnamed) of the dec'd., Feb., 1824.

HILL, WHITMILL The admr. (unnamed) of the dec'd. brought suit against Samuel T. Barnes, May, 1824.

HILL, WILLIAM Will proved Feb., 1798 with Benjamin Joyner, witness. Henry Motley qualified as exr. The widow Viley Hill entered her dissent to the will, Feb., 1798. Inventory by the said exr., May, 1798; account of sales May, 1798 and Feb., 1801. Account current Nov., 1801. Elizabeth Hill (orphan of the dec'd.) chose Thomas H. Scott as her gdn., Aug., 1800.

HILLIARD, MARGRETT Will proved Feb., 1787 with Jesse Thrower, witness. Mason Thrower qualified as exr. Inventory by the said exr., Feb., 1787.

HINES, ELINOR Will proved May, 1823 with J. Nicholson, witness.

HYNES, JAMES & ROBERT (orphans' account) Jesse Bradley filed a gdn. account for the said orphans, Feb., 1830.

HOBGOOD, MICAJAH Account current Feb. 12, 1829 with Henry Hobgood, admr.

HODGERS/HODGES, THOMAS James Brantley was ordered to appear in court and give an account of his administration of the estate of the dec'd., Nov., 1784 and Nov., 1796.

HOGG, JAMES Petition by Robert Hogg (an heir of the dec'd.) for division, May, 1796. Willis Alston, Jr. was apptd. gdn. of Starkey Hogg (orphan of the dec'd.), May, 1796. Estate divided (no details), Aug., 1796.

HOGG, THOMAS Administration grtd. Rebecca Hogg, May, 1785. Inventory by the said admr., Aug., 1785.

HOGG, THOMAS Samuel Hogg was gdn. of James Hogg (orphan of the dec'd.), Feb., 1797. Negroes ordered sold, Feb., 1797. The exrs. of the dec'd. were William Killingsworth and Elizabeth his wife, May 6, 1805.

HOLDEROFT (?), JAMES, JR. Administration grtd. John Jones, Nov., 1784. Inventory by the said admr., Feb., 1785.
