I was browsing through a box full of my notes and came across some data copied back in late 1988 from the LDS Church Files. I had obtained a listing of all the Hills listed and why I did not remember this I will never know. Maybe these are your family members, I hope so. Let me know.

A Martin Hill was born 1st February 1875 in Lenoir County, N.C. (Deep River) I assume Deep River was a village or location in that county. His father was John Hill and his mother was Sallie Stroud.

A Robert Hill, son of John Hill and Sallie Stroud was born on 29 October 1879 in Lenoir County, N.C.

A Herbert Hill was born 15 November 1874 in Lenoir County, N.C., son of John Hill and Sallie Stroud.

A Hubbert Hill was born on 15 November 1872 in Lenoir County, son of John Hill and Sarah Stroud. (This may be the same as above).

A Martin Hill married Eleanor Evans on 4 August 1868 in Franklin Co., N.C. (doesn't seem to be the same one listed above to me).

A Martin DeVault Hill married Mary Jane Keeler on 2nd of September 1869 in Rutherford County, N.C.

Martin Pinkey Hill was born on 1st of June 1864 in Henderson County, N.C. (Blue Ridge). His father was a John Hill and his mother was named Dorcas Gilbert.

Alexander Hill and Finette Rouse were the parents to a Richard C. Hill, who was born in Lenoir County, N.C. on 29th July 1847.

Now in my own Hill research, some of Moses Hill's children had moved to Alabama and I made notes on some Hills of Alabama, not knowing at that time if they were connections to my Hills or not. Anway, I think this guy is part of your family...check it out. Again my source was not wrote down, sorry about that.

A james and Martin Hill of N.C. came to Lauderdale County, Alabama ca. 1831 from Moore County, N.C. It is possible that there were brothers or cousins?

James Hill married Elizabeth Strutts or Stutts. Martin Hill married a Smith. They are said to have lived near Deep River near the county line to Randolph County.
