Perhaps you feel that I have ignored you by not writing but I lost my printer back in April, and it is still in the shop (under warranty). They just don't seem able to fix it so I finally raised so much hell with them that they have loaned me a printer. That was just one problem.

The other problem is that on the 14th of May 1990, I had a heart attack (they told me minor) yet on the 21st of May I had a heart bypass operation (Quadruple bypass). I went through the operation ok, by coming home 6 days later. Then my problems started. First my lung partially collapsed and it still is not right yet. p

I am still short winded..and get tired real easy and have not yet gone back to work. MY main problem was with the incision on my leg (where they take the veins to use in the bypass). The incision started draining and has just now stopped.

This has put me about 4 weeks behind in my rehabilitation. During all this time, I just did not feel like doing any genealogy work, writing etc...believe me the recovery has been very slow (due to my being a diabetic) and agonizing, but I think I am on the way to recover now, once I get my strength back.

I have nothing else to add but wanted you to know why you have not heard from me. I'll certainly continue to keep looking for data to help you.
