Dear Mrs. Sharum,

Yesterday, I was going through some data that I had, reviewing some Hill information and happened to notice the name of William Head, a name that you appeared interested in...however instead of being in South Carolina he was in North Carolina.

I am sure that you know a lot of the old settlers move to South Carolina from Virginia, North Carolina and even Pennsylvania so this could be the same William Head PRIOR to settling in S.C.

The data is found in a book entitled "Surry Co., N.C. Abstracts-Deed Books A, B, and C," (1770-1788) by Mrs. W.O. Absgeh, G.R.S. (1981). I do not have the text of the book, but have just the index and a few pages. One page that I have has the following entry:

Page 34:

B: 89 (being Book B, Page 89 of the original book)
3 April 1780 N.C. Grant, William Head 200 acres crossing
Dill Creek adjacent Poindexter.

Now in the index there is listed the following under the name of Head:

Isaac, Page 94
George, Page 68
William, 31, 34 (above), 76 and 98.

It might be that your William Head and family were in Surry County, N.C. prior to going to S.C. and you may want to look this information up.

I do hope this will be of some help and should you find any connection of the Head family to the Hill, Roden families, please let me know.
