

M.013 DEED OF GIFT FROM MOSES HILL TO STEPHEN TERRY
DATED 29 AUGUST 1814

THIS IS FILED AMONG CHESTER COUNTY S.C. DEED BOOK Q, PAGE 323, 29TH AUGUST 1814. (GIVEN ORIGINALLY BY PEGGY THOMAS, 1118 HORIZON TRAIL, RICHARDSON, TEXAS, 75081 TO ROBERT M. TERRY, WHO PASSED ON TO ME ON 10TH MAY 1986.

TO ALL PEOPLE TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, I MOSES HILL SEND GREETINGS,

Know ye that I Moses Hill of the State of South Carolina and District of Fairfield, for and in consideration of the good will and affection which I have and do bear towards my son-in-law STEPHEN TERRY, of the State and District aforesaid, have given and granted unto the said Stephen Terry, his heirs, executors or administrators, a certain Negro girl Sarah, about 15 year of age, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, said Negro girl above mentioned, to his heirs, executors or administrators from henceforth as his proper right absolutely without any manner of condition.

In witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st day of September in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirteen. (1813).
