Note by Robert Hill: Moses Berry Hill was one of two administrators appointed by the courts, George W. Hill, his brother was the other one. Moses B. Hill died on 14th October 1824 and his brother George W. Hill had to finish administering the estate of thier father, Moses Hill, who died on 1st July 1821.
