WIFE MARY BOWLES GLENN, OF CHESTER COUNTY, SC.

MOSES BERRY HILL 2/.

Moses Berry Hill 2/ was a son of Moses Hill Sr 1/ & his wife, Savilla N. Roden. Moses Berry Hill 2/ was born in Fairfield County, SC in 1795 and he died on 14th of October 1824 in Chester County. At the time of his death, his brother James Hill 3/ took him across the Broad River (county line) into Union County and buried him in the Fish Dam Cemetery (today's Carlisle, SC), where the members of James Hill's family was also buried.

Moses Berry Hill married Mary Bowles Glenn, daughter of Spilsby Glenn about 1814. She was a cousin to Susannah Glenn, wife of his older brother, James Hill 2/. Their children were:

1. James Leslie Stewart Hill 3/, son of Moses Berry Hill 2/, was b. 1815 in Chester County, SC, he m. twice, First to Mary A. R. Sartor; 2nd to Margaret H. Beaty He died in 1902. He had one daughter by 1st marriage, who died as an infant. There was a unnamed son (some say by the 2nd marriage??), who died at the age of 12. Goodspeed's Abstracts shows birth of this son as 1812 but family records say 1815. Believe James L.S. Hill 3/ moved to Okolona, Mississippi in 1852. He was a Major in the CSA & became Sheriff of Chickasaw County, Mississippi..
2. Sarah Savilla Hill 3/, dau. of Moses Berry Hill 2/, was b. ca. 1818-1820 in Chester County, SC. She married twice, 1st to a Mr. Fleming and 2nd to a Mr. Gregory. No death date listed. Children by 1st marriage:
 - a. Casper Fleming 4/ (Hill generation)
 - b. Mollie Fleming 4/.

After her 2nd marriage to Mr. Gregory, they moved to Okkolona County, Mississippi.

3. Moses Hill 3/, son of Moses Berry Hill 2/, was b. 25 December 1821 in Chester County, SC, married Mary Elizabeth Wesson om 15th December 1843. Mary E, Wesson was born on 3rd December 1828 in Laurens Co., SC and she died on the 25th of December 1877 at Locast Bayou,

Arkansas. They first lived in Laurens County, SC but moved to Howard County, Arkansas in 1853, then to Calhoun County, Arkansas in 1867. He operated a saw mill and a cotton gin. He was elected to the state legislature (no election date listed) but he served until his death in 1878. Moses Hill 3/ died on 12th April 1878 in Arkansas. They had 10 children:

- a. James Glenn Hill 4/, b. 12 Aug. 1844, d. 8 Jan. 1902, never married.
 - b. Mary Elizabeth Hill 4/, b. 18 Oct. 1846, d. 28 Sept. never married.
 - c. Ludella Hill 4/, b. 7 Jan. 1849, d. 13 Nov. 1901, m. Green Richard Blake, no children.
 - d. George W, Hill 4/, b. 26 Dec. 1850, d. 19 March 1904, m. to Julia Alice Teague. She was b. 29 Feb. 1860. d. 1937. (See info below).
 - e. Susan Enoree Hill 4/, b. 3 Jan. 1853, d. 1 Feb. 1899, m. T.N. Goodwin and had several children (not listed). They lived in Locast Bayou, Ark.
 - f. Melvina Katherine Hill 4/, b. 3 June 1855, d. 14 Oct. 1862.
 - g. Sarah Agnes Hill 4/, b. 1857, d. 1860..
 - h. Moses Blakley Hill 4/, b. 24 Nov. 1859, d. 1901, he was a Methodist minister.
 - i. Lena Hill 4/, b. 1863, d. 1872.
 - j. Anna Vergilia Hill 4/, b. 1867, d. 1880.
4. Mary Glenn Hill 3/, dau. of Moses Berry Hill 2/, she was b. in 1822 in Chester County, SC, married a cousin who is thought to have been William Woodward Hill 3/, a son of uncle Thomas Hill 2/ & Jemima Woodward. Another source says her husband was Thomas Hill 3/, son of Thomas Hill 2/. My research indicates husband was Wm. Woodward Hill 3/. She died in 1891, probably in Mobile, Ala. They had no children.

Information relating to George W. Hill 4/ & wife Julia Alice Teague:

George W, Hill 4/ was a Methodist Minister and Vice President of Hendrix College at Conway, Arkansas. All of his children died in Conway except J. Martin Hill 5/, a lawyer in Houston, Texas.

Their children were 5th generation Hills:

1. Hinda Tegue Hill 5/, b. 2 Dec. 1883, d. 5 Oct. 1953, unmarried.
2. Victor Dumas Hill 5/, b. 9 April 1886, d. 17 Feb. 1954, m. in 1816 to Mary Elouse Simmons, she d. 1947, they had 4 unlisted children.
3. Allie Estelle Hill 5/, b. 20th March 1889, unmarried.
4. Vivian Elizabeth Hill 5/, b. 2 July 1891, d. 1856, unmarried.

5. Janice Beryl Hill 5/, b. 9 Aug. 1893, d. 13 Jan. 1897.
6. George W, Hill Jr. 5/, b. 3 Dec. 1895, d. 9 Jan. 1912, no other info given.
7. James Martin Hill 5/, b. 18 Aug. 1898, d. 1967. He m. Nellie Johnson. Two children (not named) lived in Houston, TX. (He provided a lot of this information).
