

MD.002 GENEALOGICAL INFORMATION OF VARIOUS SORTS, COMMENTS ETC ON HILLS LOCATED IN MARYLAND, OR DATA RELATING TO HILLS IN MARYLAND. IT INCLUDES GENEALOGY OF THE SIR JOHN HILL FAMILY, WHO'S MEMBERS MOVED SOUTHWARD FROM NEW ENGLAND, INTO MARYLAND AND INTO SOUTHERN STATES.

Gathered, Entered and parts compiled by Robert R. Hill Sr. in January 1987.

Sources: Many different sources over the years, and before I had the good sense to copy down the sources:

Hill Family.

This family, while not solely of Maryland, originated in England, with various members immigrating into U.S., migrating into Pennsylvania and Maryland, then into Virginia, where from Virginia various branches split, some going into Kentucky and Tennessee and others into the Carolinas and Georgia and Alabama. Thus a picture emerges of the migration of the SIR JOHN HILL FAMILY ANCESTORS IN THE U.S.A.

THIS IS A GENEALOGY OF THE FAMOUS SIR JOHN HILL FAMILY OF ENGLAND AND SOME OF ITS MEMBERS, SHOWING A PARTIAL IMMIGRATION INTO THE U.S.

NOTE: This Genealogy was corrected in May of 1988 as a result of the "Visitation Records of 1531" given to me by Ralph H. Willis...Since my original copy had some mistakes and I had lost the source for my copy, I have changed it to agree with the Visitation Records.

1. SIR JOHN HILL 1/, (1389-1407) on King's Bench, married 1st Mathilda, 2nd Virginia Derborough on 13 October 1387. Issue: John 2/, Robert 2/, Ralph 2/ and Isabella Hill 2/. (Ref. American Biography XL. 14-24)

2. ROBERT HILL 2/, son of Sir John Hill 1/. Robert Hill died in 1423 and his wife is listed as Isabel Fichett. They married ca. 24 March 1383. Children: JOHN HILL 3/. He is only child listed on 1531 visitation.

3. JOHN HILL 3/, was the son of Robert Hill 2/, born 26 September 1401-02, married Cecily Sturton, daughter of John Struton of Preston Plucknett on April 19th, 1422. He died on 14th October 1434. (His death listed as simply 1434 on visitation record of 1531 and JOHN HILL \$/ (b. 1424) only child.

4. JOHN HILL 4/, son of John Hill 3/ was born in 1424. He and his 1st wife Margaret (Rodney?) are listed as having an un-named son, an un-named daughter m. Walgrave; daughter

Jenossekke Hill 5/, m. Sir W. Say of Herts (Hertz?). John Hill 4/ and his 2nd wife MAUDE, daughter of Sir G. Daubney, Kt. of Barrington, Somerset, are listed as having a son RAULFE 5/ (RALPH) m. daughter of Gols. (Glouchester?).

5. RALPH HILL (SR.) 5/, was the son of John Hill 4/ and his 2nd wife Maude Daubney. Ralph was born 1431-32. His children were ROBERT HILL 6/, Elinor (Eleanor) 6/, & Elizabeth 6/. (NOTE: Birth date 1431-32 is not listed in 1531 visitation. Visitation record states he married ? daughter of Glos. (Glouchester?) and agrees with the above children.

6. ROBERT HILL 6/, the son of Ralph Hill 5/. Visitation Record in 1531 shows Robert married Alice Sturton, daughter of Jo. Struton, of Preston, Somerset. Children of Robert Hill 6/ were: GILES HILL 7/ m. Alice (or Agnes) daughter of R. Brent of Cossington; Margaret Hill 7/ m. Sir Hugh Luttrell of Dunster; & Jane Hill 7/ m. Sir N. Wadham of Meryfield.

7. GILES HILL 7/, the son of Robert Hill 6/. Giles married Agnes, daughter of R. Brent of Cossington. Visitation Records of 1531 list children as: ROBERT HILL 8/, Maude Hill 8/ m. John Trevelyian, son of Jo. (John?) Trevelyian of Nettlecomb; Hugh Hill 8/, John Hill 8/, Baldwine Hill 8/, Bryse (Brex) Hill 8/, Andrew Hill 8/, Anne Hill 8/ m. 1st Chrus Hadley and 2nd Lewis Stulely, Jane Hill 8/ & Dorothy Hill 8/.

8. ROBERT HILL 8/, son of Giles Hill 7/, married Margaret Fauntlerly. Children were: Giles 9/, Peter 9/, JOHN HILL 9/, Agnes 9/, Dorothy 9/. Visitation records gives wife only as Margaret, sole heir of her mother JANE, daughter and heir of Thomas Flamock (of Heligan), Cornwall. Her name may well be Fauntlerly by virtue of a 1st marriage of her mother and who's 1st husband died and she remarried Thomas Flamock.

9. JOHN HILL 9/, the son of Robert Hill 8/. John Hill 9/ married Margaret Rodney. (See Rodney Genealogy at end of article). JOHN HILL 9/ died in 1611. Children were: John Hill 10/, Thomas Hill 10/ (who immigrated to Plymouth, Mass. in 1637), MOSES HILL 10/, RAlph Hill 10/, Jane Hill 10/, Mary Hill 10/.

10. MOSES HILL 10/, son of John Hill 9/. Moses was born in 1551-52, died ca. 1605. He went to Ulster, Ireland ca. 1573 as a Representative of the Crown. Children of Moses Hill 10/ were: Peter Hill 11/ Arthor Hill 11/, SAMUEL HILL 11/.

11. SAMUEL HILL 11/, was son of Moses Hill 10/. Samuel Hill 11/ was born in 1590 and died after 1608. His only known child was RALPH HILL 12/.

12. RALPH HILL 12/, son of Samuel Hill 11/. Ralph Hill 12/ was born in Sumerset, England in 1608. He apparently

immigrated to Charlestown, Mass., because he is said to have died on 29th April in 1663 and is buried there. His wife was Margaret Toothaker. Children were: RALPH HILL JR. 13/, Jane Hill 13/.,

13. RALPH HILL JR. 13/, was son of Ralph Hill Sr. 12/. Ralph Hill Jr. 13/, was born at Charlestown, Mass. in 1635. He died in 1692 and was married to a cousin Martha Toothaker. His Children were: Elizabeth Hill 14/, Timothy Hill 14/, Deborah Hill 14/, & SAMUEL HILL 14/.

14. SAMUEL HILL 14/, was son of Ralph Hill Jr. 13/, Samuel Hill 14/ was born on 18th February 1672 and died on August 4, 1735. His wife was named Sarah Aitler. Children were: Deborah Hill 15/, Ralph Hill 15/, Martha Hill 15/, ABRAHAM HILL 15/, Sarah Hill 15/, Samuel Hill Jr. 15/, Uraale Hill 15/, Elizabeth Hill 15/, & Hannah Hill 15/.

15. ABRAHAM HILL 15/. was son of Samuel Hill 14/. Abraham was born 1698 and died 1760. Only known child was ISAAC HILL 16/.

16. ISSAC HILL SR., 16/, was born 1748 and was a drummer in the American Revolutionary War. He moved to N.C. then Tennessee and d. in 1825 in Warren County Tennessee. He married Lucinda Wallace in Martin County, N.C. His father was Abraham Hill 15/, who was born 1698, d. 1760.

REFERENCE TO NUMBER 9 The Visitation of 1573 shows the following: William Croftes & unknown wife had a son SIR RICHARD CROFTES 2/, who married twice, 1st to a daughter of Sir John Barre and 2nd to a daughter of Fox. By the 2nd wife a son SIR JOHN RODNEY (CROFTES) was born. SIR JOHN RODNEY married Ann ??? Their children were SIR WALTER RODNEY (of Stoke); Frances & Agnes. SIR WALTER (of Stokes) had a daughter Margaret, who married JOIHN HILL 4/, of Hounston.

The following remarks were made by Mr. Gordon H. Meadors in a letter to me dated 30th May 1985....

QUOTE..."The name Moses, suggested to me that he might be a Quaker so I checked the N.C. Quaker records and found in the records of PERQUIMANS (COUNTY) MONTHLY MEETING a reference dated June 5th 1723 of the meeting to be held between MOSES HILL, James Griffin and WILLIAM HILL, regarding the building of a new meeting house at the "UPPER M.H." (What does this mean???) No other record of Moses, who I think moved into S.C.." (No proof though).

In 1719 there is mention of a Jacob Hill, "late of Virginia" who married Elizabeth Bogue and finally an AARON HILL who's wife was Margaret. They had two children, Huldah (b. 18th September 1737) and William Hill (b. 31 January 1740).

Margaret Hill (wife of Aaron) died and Aaron Hill then married Miriam Hill (must have been a cousin?). They had Mary, b. 1746, MOSES, b. 16 September 1748, d. 22 November 1760, Aaron, b. 1752, Miriam, b. 1754, Jacob, b. 1756, Jesse, b. 1758 and Thomas, b., 1760.

Now the interesting part is that HENRICO (COUNTY) VIRGINIA MONTHLY meeting records show that Aaron Hill of PERQUIMANS N.C. married MARGARET CHEPELL of PRINCE GEORGE COUNTY MARYLAND. The question is if this family did not come from MARYLAND, why would Aaron go back to PRINCE GEORGE'S (MARYLAND) to take a wife?" End of quote...

By this it seems that Aaron Hill married Margaret Chepell in Prince George County Maryland (his 1st wife). Obviously she was from Maryland and Aaron was a resident of N.C. He went back to Maryland, where he probably was from originally, married and bought his wife (Margaret Chepell) to PERQUIMANS, N.C., proving almost for sure his origins in Maryland.

Later, the following remarks were made in another letter to me from Mr. Gordon H. Meadors, 1056 Monroe Street, Jackson Miss. 39202, dated 28th April 1986.

"A Jonathan Hill 2/ was son of Ralph Hill 1/. Jonathan Hill 2/ also had a son named Jonathan Hill 3/, and a grandson named Jonathan Hill 4/. I thought that the names Jonathan, Truman, and Phillip were New England names, but still, I must confess, I was surprised to find 3 Jonathan Hill's in 1790 Census in Rhode Island and 5 in Conn." (GHM)

Mr. Meadors also stated that Isaac Hill of Martin County N.C., and supposed son of Abraham Hill, is said to have been born in St. Mary's County Maryland. This should be remembered in trying to establish a connection to the John Hill Family.

Mr. Meadors also stated that a Jonathan Hill was a witness to a will of Edward Talbot in Anne Arundel County Maryland, dated 11th September 1689, MARYLAND WILLS, VOLUME, 2, PAGE 58.

Further proof of this HILL Family (of Maryland) spreading southward is found below...Now while we have no proof that these two families are connected, we do have strong circumstantial evidence they were, especially since the names of Jonathan, Moses Isaac, Abraham, Henry were popular with the New England and Maryland Families as well as the Virginia and N.C. Hills. There is definite proof that Isaac Hill (of Maryland) moved into N.C. then Tennessee. He definitely was a member of the Sir John Hill Family.

Mrs. Rita Hill Pullum of 12530 LaManana, San Antonio, Texas 78233 sent following information in letter dated 24

WILLIAM HILL age 36 (b. ca. 1740).

Ann Hill age 22 (b. ca.1754).

MOSES HILL age 3 (b. ca. 1773).

Note by Robert Hill: Could this William Hill be related to the William Hill, who married Martha Green in September of 1724. He had a son William, born 3rd January 1736 and a son Moses, b. 4th December 1748.

Now the importance of the above census is to show a connection between the given name of William Hill and Moses Hill, and suggest (at least to me) that since men of these names lived in the area of S.C., in Fairfield County, and since the name Moses is quite popular with the New England Family of JOHN HILL (as is William) they could be connected to the famous JOHN HILL immigrant into New England and of the family line of Sir John Hill (England), who's descendents immigrated into Mass., later moving southward into the Carolinas and Georgia. We also know that members of this NEW ENGLAND HILL LINE, referred to as the John Hill Family, moved from New England, to Pennsylvania, through Maryland, then perhaps southward into Southeastern Virginia (Nansemond County) and then into Northeastern North Carolina in area of Pasquotank County and Chowan County. Later their descendents were in Wilkes County Georgia. For this reason the following data (at least to me) suggest a connection to the Northern Hill line.

COMMENTS BY Robert R. Hill Sr.... It should be remembered that a Jonathan Hill married Margaret Hall in Berkley County S.C. ca. 1756-57 and was the father of the Thomas Hill (Revolutionary Soldier) that fought in S.C., later moving to Kentucky. Thomas's wife was Patience Harrison. (Was this Jonathan Hill a member of the Hills of New England & Maryland) ??

This Jonathan Hill is listed among the LDS Church files, as also having sons MOSES HILL & Joseph Hill and should be checked out closely. Jonathan Hill moved into area of Fairfield Co (Camden District) and died there in early 1770s. (NOTE: This has since been disproved).

WILL IN FREDERICK COUNTY MARYLAND IN 1773, AND NAMED HIS SONS AS: HENRY TRUMAN HILL, JOSEPH HILL, PHILLIP HILL, ROBERT HILL, THOMAS HILL, AND JOHN HILL. HIS DAUGHTERS NAMED WERE : ELIZABETH HILL, REBECCA HILL, AND ANN HILL.

1. CLEMENT HILL, died 1708. He came from England with the 3rd Lord Baltimore (1662-63). He settled in Maryland, was High sheriff of Maryland. Served in the Assembly 1677-1685, member of Council, privy councillor, vice regent, probate judge. He married Elizabeth (Hatton) Gardiner, widow of Luke Gardiner, of St Mary's County Maryland.
