Note by Robert Hill: It is believed that the Henry Truman Hill, who married Alice Ridgely, has been confused with the Henry Truman Hill (son of Henry Hill of Md), and who moved from Frederick Co., Md to S.C. Mr. L.P. Hill (descendent of this family) of Harrisonburg, Virginia, states that the Henry Truman Hill who married Alice Ridgely, was the son of Joseph Hill and was a grandson to the Henry Truman Hill who came to S.C. from Maryland.

Henry Hill Jr. served in American Revolutionary War. He was a Captain in Col. Luke Marbury's Line and was also attached to General Smallwood's Flying Camp. He fitted out a Company at his own Expense. Received his commission on 1 September 1777.
