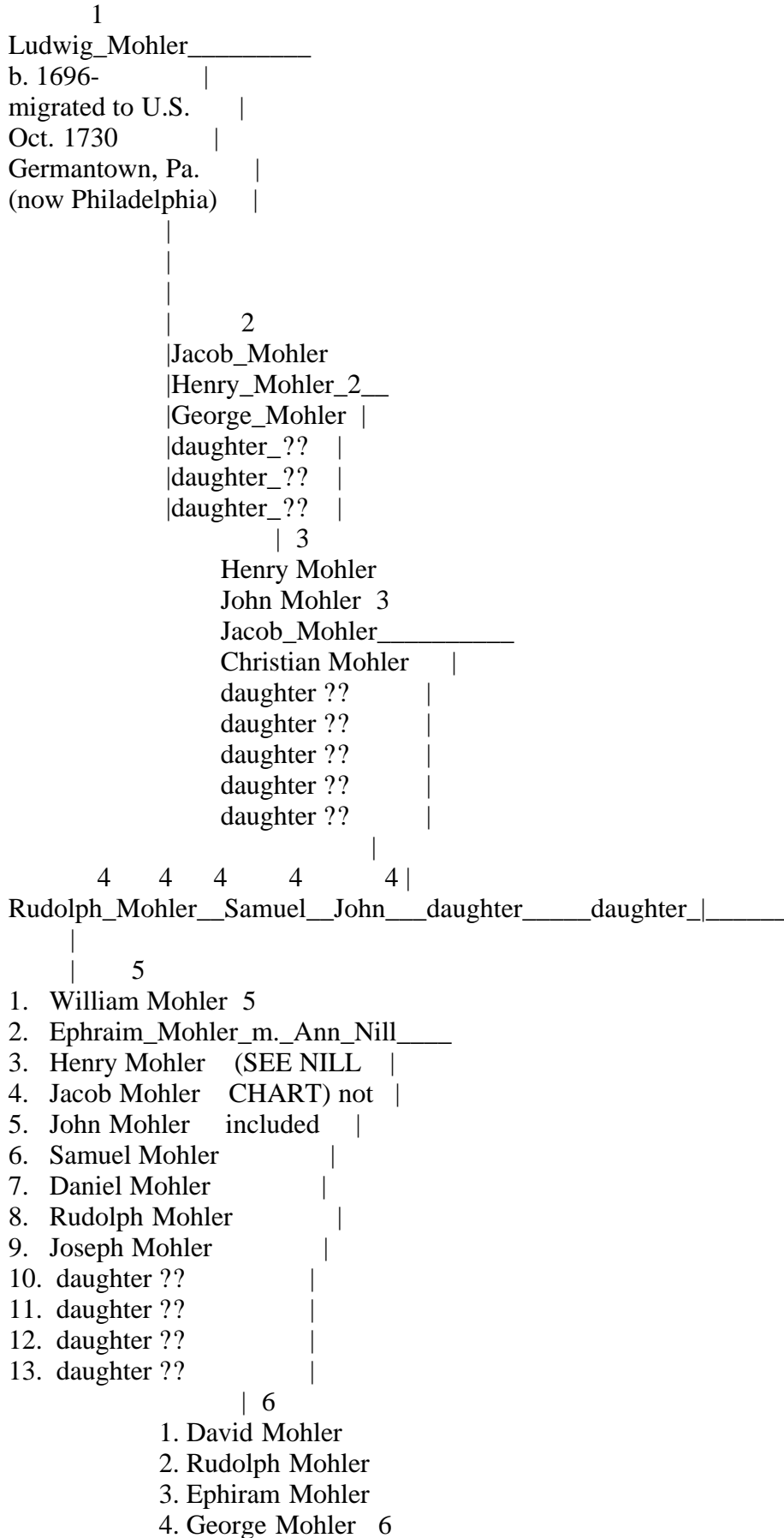
#### THE WEAVER-HILL CHART SHOWING CONNECTIONS OF THE TWO FAMILIES

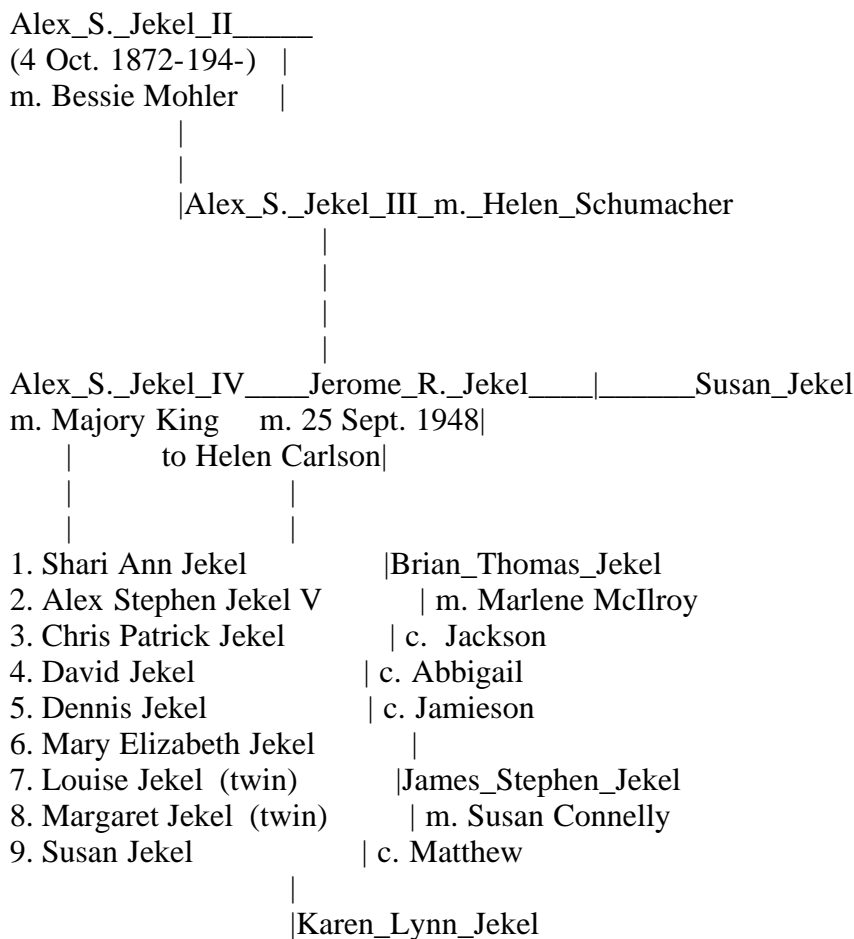
1696 MOHLER FAMILY CHART (LUDWIG TO BESSIE-1878)

(OF UNION COUNTY, S.C.)

THOMAS HILL (I suspect a son of a William Hill, who obtained a land grant just southeast of where Thomas Hill Sr. of Md. obtained his on the Enoree River, in today's Union Co., S.C.e (This Thomas b., I estimate ca. 1750-1752 in South Carolina-Maryland), and d. 1825 in Union County, South Carolina. He is said to have fought in the American Revolution in S.C. in Brandon's Regiment, but I am not convinced that this is the same Thomas Hill.

WIFE: MIRIAM MURPHY (daughter of Simon Murphy & Sarah (Duke), who came to S.C. from Va. b. Between 1750-1760

- c. Sarah Hill (b. before 1790) m. Littlebury Brooks (she was dead by 23rd February 1829).
