

NC.33 A HENRY HILL FAMILY OF ROCKINGHAM COUNTY, N.C.

Updated remarks by Robert Hill of Brandon, FL. in February of 1999:

I have no absolute proof but I think this Henry Hill is somehow part of the Reverend William Hill 3/ family found in Roickingham County, NC in the 1780's and 90's. The wife of Reverend Hill was Elizabeth Halbert. My reasons for this thinking is this:

Rev. Hill & wife had a daughter Frances Hill 4/, that married Mark Hardin. The name of Hardin, frequently used in this Hill family, certainly implies some type of connection to this Frances Hill 4/ - Mark Hardin family.

Frances Hill 4/ had brothers, John Hill 4/, William Hill 4/, James Hill 4/ & Green Hill 4/. I suspect this Henry Hill was one of their sons, and this should be investigated by those interested in this subiect.

If found to be true, the the generation figures below will change accordingly.

HENRY HILL 1/.

His origins have as yet been undetermined but it is obvious that he lived in and around Rockingham County, N.C. His marriage to Lucy Jane Buress is supported by their marriage

bond, dated 23 January 1845 in Rockingham County, N.C.

He was listed in the 1850 Census for that county, western sections.

Henry Hill, age 27, laborer, born in N.C.

Lucy Hill, age 25, wife, born in N.C.

Hardin, age 3, son, born in N.C.

Later census records shows that the family of Henry Hill and wife Lucy Jane Hill were:

Hardin H. Hill, born 1847.

Alexander Hill, born 1855.

Martha J. Hill, born 1856.

William H. Hill, born 1857.

Robert H. Hill, born 1860.

Martin Hill, born ca. 1865.

On 6th July 1885, Lucy Jane Bures Hill was a resident of Matrimony Post Office, Rockingham County, N.C. and she appeared before the Clerk of Superior Court, John T. Pannill) for that county and initiated a Widow's Claim for Pension under the provisions of an act entitled "An Act for the relief of Certain Soldiers in the Late War Between the States." (The Act was ratified on 11th march 1885).

She states that she was age fifty (50), and attested that her husband, Henry Hill, had enlisted in Company A, of the 45th North Carolina Regiment on 12 February 1862. That Henry Hill, while in the performance of his duties, died about the 18th of January 1864 in Virginia. The claim was denied due to the fact that Henry's name was not on the rolls of Company A of the 45th Regiment.

Records on file at the National Archives clearly shows that Henry Hill did indeed serve as a Private in Company A of the 45th Regiment, N.C. Troops. He enlisted at Grogansville, county and state not listed) on 10th November (year not shown) for 3 years. According to the book "North Carolina Troops 1861-1865, A Roster, Vol XI, Infantry, 45th-48th Regiments," Page 15, Henry Hill enlisted in Rockingham County, North Carolina on 10th November 1863 for the duration of the war. Military records show that he died on 18th January 1864 at Orange Court House, Virginia.

HARDIN H. HILL 2/, son of Henry Hill 1/.

Hardin Hill 2/ was born ca. 1847 probably in Rockingham County, N.C. He married Mary Jane Morgan on 21st May 1867 (bond dated 17th May 1867) in Rockingham County, N.C. He is listed as being a miller by trade.

The 1850 Census of (Western) Rockingham County, N.C. shows Hardin H. Hill as age 3 years (b. 1847) but the obituary for

Mary Morgan Hill in Greensboro Dailey News, dated in April 1954, states that Hardin H. Hill died in 1938 at age of 98, (b. ca. 1840). This is suspected to be a miss print and his birth was in 1847. Hardin Hill was buried in Section #C, Plot # 17 of the Lebanon Baptist Church Cemetery in Greensboro, N.C.

Mary Jane Morgan (wife of Hardin H. Hill) was born in Rockingham County, N.C. in 1851 and was an only child. She died in Greensboro, N.C. on 27th April 1954 at the age of 103 years old. She was buried on 29th April 1954 in the Lebanon Baptist Church Cemetery (Section #C, Plot #17), which is located on Hicone Road, Greensboro, N.C.

As of July 1982, there was no markers for either her or her husband Hardin H. Hill 2/. Hanes Funeral Home of Greensboro officiated at her funeral. Church records list E. (Edgar) Hardin Hill (a son) as the owner of the plots.

The 1880 Census for Leaksville, Rockingham County, N.C. list Hardin Hill as a farmer and carpenter. The 1900 census shows him as a farmer and was living in a rented house.

They had 16 children. They were:

1. William Hardin Hill 3/, born ca. 1871 (1880 Census), married Annie Elizabeth Southern.
2. Frank Hill 3/ , born ca. 1873 (1880 Census) died young.

4. Laneh Hill 3/, (FEMALE TWIN), born ca. 1879, died as a child.
5. Lamont Hill 3/, (MALE TWIN), born ca. 1879, died as a child.
6. Lucy Jane Hill 3/, born 31 August 1880, married Cornell Talton Sams.
7. James Allen Hill 3/, married Ada Anderson.
8. Annie Hill 3/, born ca. 1881, married twice, 1st to John Francis Garrett, 2nd Forest Black.
9. Henry Martin (Pete) Hill 3/, born 14 January 1884, married Mary Jane Alcon.
10. Edgar Hardin Hill 3/, born 22 December 1887, married Margaret Mae King.
11. Jesse Harrington Hill 3/, born 25 January 1889, married Annie Juanita Gillispie.
12. Katie Hill 3/, born 17 May 1890, died as a child.
13. Etta Bell Hill 3/ , born 17th May 1890...(QUESTIONABLE) married Edward Lloyd.

Note: James Martin Hill 4/, son of Henry Martin Hill 3/, recalls that his father said that Frank Hill 3/ died as a young boy and all that his father would say about the matter was that "Frank was never well." The 1880 Census indicates he was classed as idiotic and maimed/crippled or otherwise disabled. He is not listed on the 1900 census.

Descendents state that Laneh 3/ and Lamont 3/ were twins and died as young children.

On the 18th of October 1983, in the home of James Martin Hill 4/ in Gibsonville, North Carolina, the following reminiscences by James Martin Hill 4/, Gracie Mae Hill Watkins 4/, Mildred Gertrude Hill Way 4/ and Mary Jane Alcon Hill, wife of Henry Martin Hill 3/ (the first three being grandchildren of Hardin H. Hill 2/ and Mary Jane Morgan Hill) were taken down and recorded in shorthand by Juanita Dermontt Hill, wife of James Irvin Hill, who was a son of James Martin Hill.

Our whole family used to go to Spray, North Carolina to visit our grandparents. It was a small town and grandfather worked as a miller for the Spray Corn Mill Company. The house they lived in was small and neat, and was near the mill where grandfather worked. It was a frame house with an open porch on the front and grandmother had all kinds of flowers on the porch in hand made flower boxes, as well as flowers in the front yard. She crocheted many fine things such as bedspreads and quilts. The things she crocheted were crocheted from spools of heavy twine which they obtained from a nearby small store. (The store obtained the twine from some of the mills). Beautiful yards such as we have today were not to be found in Spray at that time.

Note: Spray N.C. is now, along with other former small communities, incorporated into what is today called Eden.

On one trip to visit our grandparents, it was winter time, but we did not think we would have snow so early (rather papa did not think so) and on our return trip in the covered wagon, a snow storm came up and we were caught in it. The mules had ice on their hoofs and we had to break it off, and the wagon wheels were so covered with ice and snow that we had to keep stopping and break off the ice too. One of the mules got so tired we had to stop at a farm house on the way and leave it with them in return for the use of their mules.

Another time when we visited, Grandma Hill had beautiful roses in the flower bed in front of the house. My Uncle (Robert) Howard Hill 4/ (who was younger than the others and still got into mischief) buried some small firecrackers in the ground around her roses and when he lit them, a chain

reaction went off and they all exploded, destroying a choice rose bush. Grandma really gave him a spanking and made him stay in the house the rest of the afternoon.

Those trips were so great, because Grandmother would cook for days ahead and have so many good things to eat when we arrived. Such a kind and loving person was she. So tiny, we boys could lift her up like she was a little girl. We all respected and loved her, and we never forgot those trips to Spray.

Henry Martin (Pete) Hill told us children that his mother (Mary Jane Morgan Hill) never knew her dad as she was born out of wedlock and was an only child. Her mother (Nancy Morgan) did not marry the man and evidently he moved away as she (Mary Jane Morgan Hill) never knew her dad.

Hardin Hill loved Mary Jane Morgan and saw her good qualities and he left the farm at an early age. After marrying Mary Jane Morgan, they lived in Spray, North Carolina where he was a miller.

When they grew older and couldn't work as hard as they formerly did, they moved near Dick's Mill in McLeansville, North Carolina. The people at Dick's Mill found out that Hardin had been a miller and asked him to operate the mill for them. He operated the mill for a long time and it was his last job. Later, they moved to Revolution Mills and rented a small house on their son Jim's place, which was near the mill. Later, when Jim left his parents could no longer care for themselves properly, he had them to move in with him. One night (1938), while eating ice cream, Grandpa had a heart attack and died. Then a few years later, Grannie moved in with her young son, (Robert) Howard Hill 3/ and his wife Sloane, in Greensboro, N.C.

In later years, Grannie's eyesight came back strong and she started quilting and crocheting again. (Robert) Howard Hill 3/ & his wife Sloane prepared a nice, large room for her in their house and it gave her a feeling of having her own place again.

(REMINISCENCES CONCLUDED)

James Martin Hill said that Hardin H. Hill ceased farming and began work in the mill, with carpentry work as an additional means of earning money, because he could not earn adequate living on the farm.

A time sheet from the Leaksville Woolen Mills, dated January 1909 shows Hardin Hill was employed there and paid eighty-five cents per day. It shows he was living in a mill owned house and paid three dollars rent for the two weeks ending 15 January 1909. The same sheet shows that Hardin's 2/ son,

Jesse 3/ and daughters Annie 3/, Etta 3/, and Lillie 3/ also worked at the same mill. Jesse was paid a rate of seventy-five cents per day, Annie eighty-five cents per day, and both Etta and Lillie at sixty five cents per day.

ALEXANDER HILL 2/, SON OF HENRY HILL 1/.

Alexander Hill 2/ appears to have been the second born child of Henry Hill 1/ and Lucy Jane Bures Hill. He married a woman named Lucinda, her last name remains unknown. Up till this time his record (legal bond) of marriages has not been found but they are listed as man and wife in a Power of Attorney for the sale of some land and that is recorded in the Record of Deeds Book 4A, Pages 142 and 143 in the Register of Deeds Office, Wentowrth, Rockingham County, N.C.

The 1880 census for Mayo Township (Rockingham County) shows an Alex Hill and his wife is listed a "L" Hill standing for Lucinda. That same census shows the family listed as follows:

Alex Hill, age 25, occupation, farm laborer, could not read nor write, was born in North Carolina.
L. Hill, wife, age 28, occupation, keeping house; could not read nor write, was born in North Carolina.
M. J. Hill, daughter, age 5, born Virginia.
R. H. Hill, son, age 2, born North Carolina.
A. L. Hill, daughter, age 1 year, born North Carolina.
J. R. Hill, son age one month, born North Carolina.

MARTHA J. HILL 2/, Daughter of Henry Hill 1/.

Martha Hill 2/, appears to have been the 3rd born child to Henry Hill 1/ and wife Lucy Jane Bures Hill. Based on information from the Marriage Register Book, Register of Deeds Office, Wentworth, Rockingham County, N.C., she married S. D. Curry on the 12th of December 1878 and gave her age as being twenty two years old, indicating a birth of 1856, while the 1860 census shows a birth in 1856. The marriage record is believed to be more accurate of the two.

In the 1880 Census this family is listed as follows:

S. D. Curry, age 21, farmer.
M. J. Curry (wife, age 25.
E. A. Curry, daughter, born October 1879.

Now it is obvious that a mistake has been made here on her age since Martha gave her age as 22 when she married in December of 1878, only 10 months ago. Her husband could possibly still be twenty one year of age, not having a complete year to celebrate his next birth date, but Martha must still have been 22 or possible 23 years old. This is a

good example why census records can give misleading information on the ages of certain individuals.

Martha Hill Curry is listed on the 1910 Census of Price Township as head of the Household and widowed. Her age is given as seventy two (72) which appears to be wrong, because this would show a birth of 1838, while her birth was in 1856, showing us that her true age would have been about 54 years old in the 1910 census. The reason for this large and obvious mistake is unclear.

M. J. Curry Head of Household, (female) age 72, unable to read or write.

John Curry (son), age 54, unmarried, occupation rural mail carrier, can read & write.

Mannie Curry, a daughter in law, widowed, age 24, could read & write.

Fitzhugh L. Curry, age 8, grandson.

James M. Curry, age 4, grandson.

From this information it appears that Martha had a son that had died and his widow, Mannie, and her two sons were living with their paternal grandmother and their uncle John Curry.

According to the records in the National Personnel Records Center, John P. Curry was born on 25th March 1856, and was employed as a substitute rural mail carrier on the then Route 2 for the period 1st March 1906 until his retirement date of 24 March 1921. If this M.J. Curry in the 1910 Census is indeed the daughter of Henry Hill, then the census birth date records are incorrect and John P. Curry was not her natural son.

The age of John P. Curry of fifty four (54) given in the 1910 census agrees with the date of his birth and thus is believed to be correct. It also appears to this writer that both he and Martha Hill Curry were both born in the same year and that he could not possibly be her son, thus the next conclusion is that he was a brother-in-law to Martha Hill Curry. The reasons for her older age given and his being listed as a son is open for thoughts and discussions other than this writer.

WILLIAM HARDIN HILL 2/, SON OF HENRY HILL 1/.

Information obtained from the Marriage Records of Rockingham County, N.C. shows that William H. Hill 2/ married Arena Oakley on 20th December 1877, in Mayo Township, Rockingham County. The records show that her father was Thomas Oakley and the mother was Elizabeth Oakley.

William H. Hill gave his age as being twenty (20) years of age, indicating a birth in 1857, which also agrees with the

information in the 1860 census, but the 1870 Census shows his age as ten (10) years of age, which is obviously wrong. Arena Oakley listed her age as nineteen (19) at the time of their marriage.

In the 1880 Census for Leaksville Township, Rockingham County, N.C., Page 27, dwelling 206, Family Number 227, Supervisor's District and listed under the Household for Eliza Oakley, there is listed a son-in-law, William H. Hill, age 21 and married to Martha Hill, seventeen years of age. According to the census, William was a farmer and Martha was employed in a factory.

Now the name of Martha is in conflict with the information cited previously herein (Arena Oakley) married William H. Hill).

Now according to the Cemetery Records of Rockingham County & Stokes County, N.C. is listed the following:

This seems to show that the wife of William H. Hill was actually named Irene E. (Eliza after mother?) Oakley and the name of Areana was a nickname for Irene. I also am of the opinion that her death date is wrong and the date should be 20 August 1898, NOT 1888.

Now the reason for this assumption is the fact that Marriage Records for Rockingham County shows that their youngest daughter Ida Hill married on 30th August 1911 to Harvey James, age twenty three (23 yrs). Ida Hill gave her age as 20 years old, showing a birth in 1891, proving that the mother (The above Irene E. Hill, had to have been alive on that date. This marriage was witnessed by Ida's married sister, Lottie Hill, who on 20th November 1901 at age 19 (b. 1882) had married Joe Edwards, age 22.

The above tombstone inscription confirms the birth of William H. Hill as being in 1857.

In the 1900 Census for Leaksville Township, East End, Rockingham County, (Sheet 11, Dwelling 154, Family Number 168, Supervisor's District 6 is listed the following:

Eliza Oakley, age 72
Thomas H. Hill, date of birth April 1879, cotton mill weaver
Lottie M. Hill, date of birth May 1882, cotton mill weaver
Rossie Hill, date of birth August 1887, cotton mill weaver
Ida Hill, date of birth August 1890.

These are probably the children of the deceased father William H. Hill 2/ and his wife Irene (Arena) E. Oakley Hill, and were living with the grandmother (maternal side of family) Eliza Oakley.

ROBERT HILL 2/, SON OF HENRY HILL 1/ & LUCY JANE BURESS HILL.

Robert Hill 2/ married Roxanna Trent on the 19th of February 1883 in Leaksville Township, Rockingham County, North Carolina. The marriage records shows that her father was James Trent and the mother was listed as D. Trent. Robert Hill 2/ gave his age as twenty three years (23) and Roxanna gave hers as twenty (20). This shows that Robert Hill 2/ was born in 1860 and Roxanna was born in 1863. Little else is known of him.

MARTIN HILL 2/, A SON OF HENRY HILL 1/ & LUCY JANE BURESS HILL.

There is no information given for him, only his being listed in the 1870 Census. Whether he died and just has not been researched remains to be seen.

JAMES ALLEN HILL 3/, SON OF HARDIN H. HILL 2/ & MARY JANE MORGAN HILL.

James Allen Hill 3/, was born on 31st August 1880 in Rockingham County, N.C. He married Ada Anderson on 22nd of July 1905 in Reidsville, Rockingham County, N.C. and he died in 1940.

His wife Ada, was born in 1880 in Rockingham County, N.C. and she died in 1969. Both are buried in Greensboro, Guilford County, N.C. There was one child:

James Robert Hill 4/, born 25 July 1912 in Reidsville, Rockingham County, N.C. James Robert Hill 4/ stated his parents were married on 2nd July 1905, not 22nd of July 1905???. James Robert Hill 4/ married Josephine Womack of McDowell County, N.C. and had no children. James Robert Hill 4/ was a graduate of N.C. State University and the Columbia School of Business in New York City. He served in the U.S. Navy in World War II and then returned to Atlanta. He was a Mason & a member of the Methodist Church. He died on 24th March 1990.

ANNIE HILL 3/, DAUGHTER OF HARDIN H. HILL 2/.

Annie Hill 3/, married J.L. (Ed) Garrett on 23rd of October 1913 in Leaksville, Rockingham County, N.C. She was listed on the records as being age 35, indicating a birth of ca. 1878. She was described by family members as being "tall blonde,

and beautiful." She had no children of her own but was aid to have loved all children.

Annie married a second time to Forest Black but they too had no children.

Based on cemetery records, Annie Hill 3/ was buried on 24 October 1955 in Highland Burial Park in Danville, Virginia in lot 27, section 3, plot number A1092. Her age was listed as 74 years of age (b. ca. 1881??) and her husband was listed as being John FRANCIS GARRETT, not J.L. Garrett.

HENRY MARTIN HILL 3/, SON OF HARDIN H. HILL 2/.

Henry Martin (Pete) Hill 3/, was born on 14th January 1884 and died on 17th January 1957. He married Mary Jane Alcon, born 12th January 1879 and died on the 20th January 1960, but this date is conflicting with other dates given by different sources and is not a certain fact.
