Statement by Win Jacob: This 5 generation Hill record stems  
from an early-day William & Mary Hill of Surry County, N.C.  
(even perhaps from old Rowan County), as it was the parent of  
37 counties.

MATTHEW HILL 1/ GENEALOGY.

MATTHEW HILL SR. 1/, born ca. 1745/52, based upon age 21-25  
years old when his son Matthews Hill Jr. 2/ was born ca. 1773  
in Stokes County, N.C. Matthew Hill Sr. 1/ died in Stokes  
County, N.C. in 1804. Matthew Hill Sr. 1/ had three known  
sons, daughters??

1. Samuel Hill 2/.
2. John Hill 2/.
3. Matthew Hill Jr. 2/.

Note: The combination of the above names suggests looking at  
the Kentucky records for Hills.

MATTHEW HILL JR. 2/.

Matthew Hill Jr. 2/ was born ca. 1773 in Stokes County, N.C.  
and d. ca. 1833 in Campbell County, Tennessee (now Union Co.,  
Tenn.). Matthew Hill Jr. 2/ married---- Sharp\*\*? They had  
seven children & they came to Tennessee ca. 1812. (\*\*NOTE:  
by Win Jacob: She was not related to Elizabeth Hill/John  
Moore).

Note by Win Jacob: This suggest examining the records of Joab  
Hill (II) TN(1801-1871)TN who m. Elizabeth Jane Sharp (b.  
1804 in Lee Co., Va.). Their youngest daughter, Elizabeth  
Jane Hill m. in Scott Co., Tenn to Nicholas Michael Sharp.  
Both Joab Hill II & Elizabeth Jane (Sharp) Hill died in  
Campbell County, Tenn.).

Children of Matthew Hill Jr. 2/.

1. Elijah Hill 3/, b. 1802, married Mary Sharp, d/o Conrad  
Sharp & Sarah Gibbs. (Note by Win Jacob: Be aware that  
there is another Elijah Hill (related?) who was s/o  
Thomas Hill & Catherine Shropshire of Guilford/

Rockingham Counties of N.C.;/Wilkes/Greene Counties of Georgia; and Claiborne/White Counties of Tenn. The records of these two Elijah Hills have at times become intermingled. DAR has now got them straight.

2. Terry Hill 3/, b. 1802, d. 1850, m. Jane Sharp (see below).
3. Green Hill 3/, b. ca. 1804, m. Elizabeth Wilson, sister of Mary Polly Wilson!
4. Matthew Hill III 3/, m. Mary Polly Wilson, sister of Elizabeth Wilson.
5. David Hill 3/, m. Lucinda Henderson.
6. Oliver Hill 3/ (twin) m. in Campbell Co., Tenn. on the 20th of February 1839 to Frances (Fanny) Ann Oakes.
7. Mahalah Hill 3/ (twin) m. Nicholas Snodderly, they went to Page County, Iowa.

#### TERRY HILL 3/.

Terry Hill 3/, listed as Number 2 above, (1820-1850 married Jane Sharp 1823-27 (based upon his age being 21-23 years at the time of his marriage) to Jane Sharp. (Question: Was Jane Sharp any relationship to Mary Sharp, who m. Elijah Hill 3/ a brother to Terry Hill 3/)? They had 10 children.

#### Children of Terry Hill 3/.

1. Sanford (Samp) Hill 4/, m. 21st of November 1850 to Rebecca Davis in Campbell Co., Tenn.
2. Parley Hill 4/ (daughter) m. John Brantley.
3. Tinney Hill 4/, m. 10th August 1849 to Joseph Brantley in Campbell Co., Tenn.
4. Oliver Hill 4/, m. Mary Jane Williamson.
5. Malinda Hill 4/, died unmarried.
6. Elizabeth Hill 4/, m. John B. Weaver.
7. Ferrin Hill 4/, m. Elizabeth Snodderly (see below).
8. Henry Hill 4/, m. Elizabeth Hardin.
9. Manon (Mason??) Hill 4/, m. (twice) 1st to Lucy Witt; 2nd to Melicina Oakes. (Question: Is she any relation to Fanny Ann Oakes, wife of Oliver Hill 4/?)
10. Union Hill 4/, m. Sarah Martin.

Ferrin Hill 4/, (1841-1921) m. Elizabeth Snodderly, d/o Henry Rice Snodderly. They had nine children. They were:

1. Sam J. Hill 5/, died unmarried.
2. Harriett (Hattie) Hill 5/, m. Sam A. Hill, a great grandson of Elijah Hill & Mary Sharp Hill.
3. Maud Hill 5/, m. William H. Thomas (1882-19-- ) parents

- to Mrs. Eula Thomas Perkinson.
4. Lucy Coker Hill 5/, m. O.W. Walker.
  5. Ollie Hill 5/, (daughter) m. Murphy Hamilton.
  6. Elbert Milton Hill 5/, m. Emma Bridges.
  7. Thomas Hill 5/ m. Catherine Shropshire. (questionable son).
  8. James Hill 5/, m. Nancy Royalty.
  9. Joab Hill 5/, m. Elizabeth Lane (Mrs. Jacob's line)??

Note & question from Win Jacob: What relationship was Emma Bridges to Hannah (Bridges) Hill, who married William T. Hill, supposed/reported parents of "authentic" brothers.

NOTE BY ROBERT HILL:...I do not understand what connection William T. Hill is to the above family, nor do I have any information of this Hannah Bridges. I simply do not understand what Mrs. Jacob is trying to get across???
