Reuben Hill 5/, was born in Pennsylvania in 1761. When he was four years old (1765) he moved with his parents to Fauquier County, Virginia. About 1787-88, he married Joiasy Hanks near Richmond, Virginia. She was the daughter of Moses Hanks and wife Aggatha Dodson. Reuben Hill 5/ and wife Joiasy lived in Pittsylvania County, Virginia where he followed his trade as a "Hatter." Reuben Hill 5/ was an ordained minister. In the first census (1790) they were enumerated in Pittsylvania County, Virginia with a son, Thomas Hill 6/.

In 1797 they migrated to East Tennessee and settled on the French Broad River where they lived for four years. They the moved to Berea Station, Kentucky, where they lived for two years; then to Somerset, Pulaski County, Ky. where they lived another two years. They were listed here in the 1800 tax list for Pulaski County on July 28th, 1800. Later they loved to Creelsboro, Cumberland County, Kentucky.

In 1818 they moved to Maury County, Tennessee and lived there eight miles from Columbia, on the Duck River, on one of the experimental farms of James K. Polk. IN 1833, Reuben Hill died. His sons went to court for an order to care for his estate.

"Whereas it appears to the court that Reuben Hill, late of

this county, is dead and having made no will and application being made by Andrew W. Hill (son-in-law) and Hanks N. Hill (son) to have letters in the administration in the estate of the said Reuben Hill, deceased, having first given bond and security and qualified according to law, the same is granted."
