COUNTY, S.C., THEIR MARRIAGES INTO THE MOBLEY FAMILY
& EVIDENCE OF CONNECTIONS TO THE CHAPMANS OF GEORGIA.

Following taken from book entitled "Fairfield, South Carolina
Minutes of the County Court, 1785-1799," by Brent H. Holcomb

(Page 14) 25th January 1786, Phillip Shaver vs. WILLIAM
CHAPMAN. Wm. Rabb, garnishee SWORN says he had L3 (pounds) 11
(shillings) 7 (pence) Lawful money in his hand at the time of
the service of the writ. (DO no understand this?)

(Page 28) Charles D. Bradford and Thomas Parrot appeared in
open court and being duly sworn, say the saw WILLIAM CHAPMAN
sign, seal and deliver a Set of Titles to William Rabb for
three hundred acres of land, situate on Little River near the
mouth of Chapman Creek.

(Page 8) On Monday, January 4th, 1786, Joseph Chapman was
selected as a Petit Juror to serve for the next court term.

(page 17 & 18) Joseph Chapman was impaneled & sworn to try
(as a Petit Juror) on the trial between the State vs James
Tate on Tuesday, May 9th, 1786 for Suspicion of Theft.
Defendant pleaded "Not Guilt." The jury rendered a "NOT
GUILTY finding.

(page 20) Wednesday, 10th May 1786, Joseph Chapman was on a
jury that tried the case of James Johnston vs. John Richmond,
Jury found for the Plaintiff (Johnston) for Four Pounds
Sterling.

He also served on another jury, same day

(page 20) On Wednesday, 10th May 1786, Joseph Chapman was
again impaneled on a jury to try the case of John Miller vs.
Moses Hollis Trover. Verdict was for the Plaintiff (Miller)
with damages for Six Pounds, five shillings.

(page 21) Thursday, 11th May 1786, Joseph Chapman was on jury
to try Thomas Meredith vs. High Minar. Jury found for
plaintiff (Meredith). Damages for 1 pound sterling.
Defendant's Attorney moved for an arrest of Judgement, which
was granted and ordered to be argued by both the Council on

both side on the Morrow.

(Page 24) Friday, 12th May 1786, Joseph Chapman was on jury to try the above case. Both sides argued their case, court ordered for reasons show?, that judgement be arrested and the Defendant to recover his Costs.

(Page 24) Friday, 12th May 1786, Joseph Chapman was on jury to try case of State vs. William Bryant, evidence examined and the jury, without leaving the court, found him GUILTY.

(Page 26) Saturday, May 13th, 1786, Joseph Chapman was on jury that tried case James Norton vs Charles Pickett (sic) Trover. The jury withdrew and returned with a verdict for the Plaintiff and awarded damages of Nineteen Pounds Sterling.

(Page 118) Joseph Chapman and Edward Mobley were appointed overseers of the road leading from Gladney's old place by Burr Harrison's to the Chester County line, which they are to put and keep in good repair.

(Page 123) William Chapman apparently was executor for Robert Coleman. On Wednesday, 20th January 1796, this will was produced in court, proved and letters testamentary ordered to William Chapman and Isiah (Isiah) Moberly. Executors of the within named and William Chapman was sworn in.

(Page 147) Saturday, 22nd July 1797, William Chapman was among those selected to serve for the next court term on the Grand Jury.

(Page 149) Robert Mooreman overseer on the road from the Chester County line to Chapman's, William Chapman to Rocky Creek etc...

Listed below are some marriages between the Mobley-Chapman Families. This information was taken from the Mobley Family Collection, provided to me by Mr. Carl Mobley of Orlando, Fla.

As I understand it, the reader should note very closely the figures to the left of a name. They should be used in order to help determine just what generation that particular person belongs to in this Mobley family line.

Example:

013122 Thomas Mobley.

The zero represents the progenitor of the Mobley family (John Mobley of Md.).

The second figure (1) states that the first child of the progenitor (0) & was the father of the next figure (3), who was the 3rd child. The next figure is a (1), showing that the first child of Number 3, was the next in line (or) was the father to the next in line (or his 2nd child, represented by the figure 2). This man (or figure 2) shows that the next in line of this family was his 2nd child, represented by the last & 2nd figure 2 (in this case, Thomas Mobley). I personally do not like this method.

Another (and I think an easier way to determine what Mobley generation that person belongs to), is to simply count the numbers (starting at the extreme left, or with the 0) and count until the last figure has been counted. In the example above, (Thomas Mobley) the last figure 2, is the 6th figure, which represents Thomas Mobley, showing him to belonging to the 6th generation of the Mobley line.

Notation for Chapman researchers:

I have made only a brief attempt to identify who William
Chapman (b. ca. 1750) was. I have had no success. It would
seem to me that the first thing necessary for the Chapman
researchers to do is to identify who William Chapman was (b.
ca. 1750) & who fought in Revolutionary War & had a wife
named Anne. He apparently lived in Fairfield County, S.C.,
which prior to ca. 1785, was part of Camden District, S.C.

Fairfield County S.C. is not too far south of the border
between North & South Carolina, which was a disputed border
for a time. These S.C. Chapmans are thought to be related to
the Chapman family of Virginia, later moving into Halifax, &
Chatham Counties of N.C. and apparently to those in GA.

To be buried in father's family burying ground and my grave and those of decd, sons Berry and William be marked with plain marble slabs-

Pay all just debts out of my estate as soon as practicable-

I give.. to my beloved wife Harriett one fourth interest in my estate both real and personal remaining after payment of debts, expenses of administration etc to be hers in fee simple and absolutely to be paid to her by my said Executor when realized out of my estate as she may demand and which shall be expressly in lieu of dower and twelve months support but I leave to her to elect after my death within three months whether she will accept the legacy herein contained in lieu of dower and twelve months support as now provided by law...-

I will and direct that my said Executor at a reasonable time within twelve months after my death sell at public sale as now provided by law all my property real and personal unless my said wife should elect to take dower and twelve months support in lieu of the legacy.. and in that event the remainder of my property be sold and divide the proceeds after paying all necessary and legal expenses of same among my children living at the time of my death (or the children of such per stipes (sic) dead at the time), except as to my son David Mobley whose share I dispose of hereafter-

An equal share with each of my other children which would in the absence of any will by me made, go to my said son David I give and bequeath to any children of the said David living at the time of my death or born to him thereafter, and I appoint to receive and control said share my said son David H.
