AND GEORGIA.

Note by Robert Hill:

The bold print information originated from the "Fuqua Family Foundation," P. O. Box 260068, Littleton, Colorado, 80126-0068. The other printed data (normal print) originated from my own Research Document entitled R.58 and sent previously to selected Chapman researchers.

I am unable to substantiate if the information from the Fuqua Foundation is correct or not, but some of it is questionable.

This appears to be an entirely different Chapman family that those of a William Chapman Sr. from Fairfield County, S.C. that had close ties with the Mobley family, and who's members moved into Walton County and Jones County of Georgia.

CHAPMAN DATA

1. John Chapman 7/ (b. ca. 1758-1760 in NC, died 1798 in Warren Co., Ga. He m. 1767 Millie Fuqua, dau, of William Fuqua & wife Prudence.-?, of Halifax Co., N.C. Wm. Fuqua's will proved in Halifax Co., N.C., David Chapman was executor. John Chapman 7/ & wife lived in Orange & Chatham Co., N.C. (Chatham formed from Orange 1770) then moved to Baldwin Co., Ga. They had a son Deberra Chapman 8/ who d. 1814 in Baldwin Co., Ga.; daughter Molly Chapman 8/; son Abner 8/.

[Note: Ron Head states John's children were Laban Chapman; Nancy Chapman; Tabitha Chapman, Ambrose Chapman; Benjamin Chapman; Asa Chapman & Mildred Chapman] Comment by Robert Hill: I do not agree with this list of children, see those named in will.

After the death of John Chapman 7/, his widow, Mary Fuqua Chapman married his brother David Chapman 7/.

John's will named daughter Molly; son Abner, and children (not of age) of Deberra Chapman.

1805, Tabitha Chapman m. Neill Ferguson in Warren Co., Ga.

1806, Ambrose Chapman m Elizabeth Stone in Warren Co., Ga.

1807, Benjamin Chapman m. Martha "Patsy" Slaid in Warren  
Co., Ga.

7 April 1807 Asa Chapman m. Cynthia Lockett in Warren Co.,  
Ga.

1809 Mildred Chapman m. Willis Coleman in Warren Co., Ga.

1815, Ambrose Chapman was appointed guardian for a minor  
of Laban Chapman in Warren Co., Ga.

Asa Chapman's will in Warren Co., Ga. named wife Cynthia  
(dau. of Solomon Lockett), sons Henry H.; James; Solomon;  
Bradford; and Asa, plus daughters Emily and Martha. It  
also states that son Henry will receive property left to  
him by his grandfather Alford (??)

1819, Nicholas Pool died in Baldwin Co., Ga.

16 July 1820, Benjamin Chapman (John's brother) died at  
age 68 in Warren Co., Ga., leaving wife and six children.

19 July 1824 Mathilda (sic) Chapman, wife of Benjamin  
Chapman, died in Baldwin Co., GA. leaving a 13 day old  
infant.

Millie Fuqua Pool m. Thomas Vining Miller and had at least  
one child, Tabitha Ann Miller, who married Hugh Ross  
Rodgers.

1830, Millie Fuqua Chapman died in Baldwin Co., Ga. b

Dec. 1858, Deberah S. Chapman died in Carroll Co., GA.  
(He had a brother Isaiah Chapman. The brothers are  
believed to be sons of Deberah Chapman, who was the son of  
John Chapman 7/ & Millie Fuqua.

8 July 1870, Millie Fuqua Pool died in Pike Co., Al.  
Deberra Chapman 8/, wife Mary, had two sons: Debenna  
Chapman 9/ b. 1794, m. widow Sarah Slaughter Candler in  
1819 Baldwin Co., Ga., he d. 1858 in Carroll Co., Ga.  
Deberra 8/ had another son named Isaiah Chapman 9/ who m.

Prudence Slaughter, sister to wife of brother Debenna Chapman 9/.

2. David Chapman 7/, b. ca. 1760-62.
3. Charity Chapman 7/, a daughter, b. ca. 1764.
4. Robert Chapman 7/, b. ca. 1767, apparently died before 1779 as he was not named in father's will.
5. Deberra Chapman 7/, b. ca. 1770 & listed correctly in query as Deberah Chapman Number 1. He married Polly Cross in Chatham Co., N.C. on 12th August 1813. They were still there in 1820.
6. Benjamin Chapman 7/, b. ca. 1772.
7. Solomon Chapman 7/, b. ca. 1774.
8. Abner Chapman 7/, b. ca. 1776.
9. Eluranah Chapman 7/, a daughter, b. ca. 1778.

The above is based on a courageous assumption that all of the bits and pieces assembled above are correct.

William Fuqua and David Chapman lived with their families in Halifax Co, N.C. They were well enough acquainted that David was executor of William's will.

The children of the two families knew each other. William's daughter Millie, and David 's son John were married and lived in NC until they migrated to Warren Co., Ga.

No first names of the Chapmans were listed nor were dates.
