GREEN HILL IV.

There was no information provided on this Green Hill IV except to say he came Greene County, Alabama into Mississippi. The following is factual information but the connections to this Green Hill IV are somewhat speculative.

There was a Green Hill III 6/ (6th generation) of Greene County, Alabama, the son of Major Green Hill Jr. 5/ (5th generation) and his 2nd wife, Mary Seawell. This Major Green Hill Jr. 5/ was the son of Green Hill 4/ (4th generation) and wife, Grace Bennett. Green Hill 4/ was the son of Richard Hill 3/ (3rd generation) and wife Hannah Briggs.

Richard Hill 3/ was the son of Sion Hill Sr. 2/ (2nd generation) and wife Elizabeth (Smith) Spiltimber, of Surry County, Virginia. Sion Hill Sr. 2/ was a son of the immigrants Robert Hill 1/ & wife Mary Webb.

Green Hill (III) 6/, married Mary Long, who had a sister Rebecca Wesley Long, who married a cousin, Charles Applewhite Hill 6/, son of William Hill 5/ and Mary Jones. Green Hill (III) 6/ moved to Williamson County, Tennessee and then Greene Co., Ala., and died there.

Is it likely that Green Hill IV 7/ was a son of this Green Hill (III) 6/ and wife, Mary Long and therefore a 7th generation Hill?

James Joseph Hill Sr. 8/ is said to have been the son of Green Hill IV 7/ and his wife Martha Goode Huggins. Green Hill 7/ is said to have moved into Chickasaw County, Mississippi from Greene County, Alabama and lived in a leanto until he could cut trees and build a log house.

Children born to Green Hill IV 7/ and wife Martha were:

- 1. Annie Hill 8/, who died in infancy. No dates listed
- 2. Ida Hill 8/, died at age 18. (No dates given).
- 3. Lula Hill 8/ died at age 17 (both she and Ida had fever). (No dates given).
- 4. Maud B. Hill 8/, born 1866, died 1936, married J.B.

- Peterson, who died in 1888.
- 5. William Richard Hill 8/, born 1869, died 23rd March 1935.
- 6. James Joseph Hill 8/, born 19 May 1870, died 15th June 1950, married Effie Mae Luvenia Harper. (see below)
- 7. Mattie Hill 8/, born 1872, died 1956, married Thomas Kennedy Lyons, born 17 March 1874, died 1959, married Bessie Jarmon, born 17th July 1889, died 1973. They had three children:
 - a. Robert Jarmon 9/, born 21 June 1908, died 28th April 1910.
 - b. Thomas William Jarmon 9/, born 28th November 1910.
 - c. Frances Jarmon 9/, born 2nd September 1915, married Roy B. Evans, lived Okolona, Miss., had one dau., Elizabeth Jean, born 20th January 1947, lives Tupelo, Miss.
- 8. John L. Hill 8/, born 9th July 1876, died in Parism Tenn. (no date listed).
- 9. Ira Overton Hill 8/, born 1st Sept. 1878, died in Ashville, N.C.
- 10. Mary Frank Hill 8/, born 25th November 1884.

All of the above children were born in the log house built by Green Hill IV 7/. Both Green Hill IV 7/ and his wife Martha, died in this house.

The son, James J. Hill Sr. 8/, continued to live in the home his father built until 1948 when they moved 3 miles south of Okolona on Highway 45, to be close to their sons, J.T. Hill 9/ and DeVan 9/. The house was destroyed by fire in the early 1950,s.

James J. Hill Sr. 8/ was born on the 10th of May 1870 in Chickasaw County, Mississippi, seven miles southwest of Okolona, near Mt. Olive Baptist Church. He married Effie Mae Luvenia Harper on the 3rd of February 1903. Effie Mae Luvenia was born on the 18th of June 1878 in Chickasaw County, Mississippi. Effie was the daughter of Samuel R. Harper and Dolly Rucker Harper.

Samuel R. Harper was born on the 18th of November 1859 and died on the 16th of February 1927. He served in Company "A", 43rd Mississippi Infantry.

Effie Mae Harper had one brother, James Edward Harper, born 16th of September 1883 and died on the 3rd of January 1961. His wife was Bessie Jolly, born 30th January 1888. Children were:

- 1. Mamie Frances Harper, born 3rd December 1880, died 3rd April 1969.
- 2. Dolly Beatrice Harper, born 27th February 1894, died

25th October 1972, married Lewis H. Howell, born, 4th February 1894, died 5th July 1946.

All of Effie Mae's family are buried in Boone Chapel Cemetery.

James Joseph Hill Sr. 8/ was known as "Jim." He and his wife Effie, were very active in the Mt. Olive Baptist Church, where Jim served as deacon, church clerk, Superintendent of Sunday School, Sunday School teacher and song leader for many years.

Effie taught Sunday School and always opened her home to the visiting preachers.

James Joseph Hill Sr. 8/ died on the 15th of June 1950 and his wife Effie, died on the 14th of September 1954. Both were buried in Boone's Chapel Cemetery.

They had the following seven children:

James Joseph Hill Jr. 9/ was born on 26th of February 1906. He attended Egypt High School, was a Charter member of Okolona Chamber of Commerce, organized in 1935.

J. T. HILL 10/ (Son of James Joseph Hill Jr. 9/)

J.T. Hill 10/ was the son of James Joseph Hill Sr. 9/ and his wife, Effie Mae Luvenia Harper. J. T. Hill 10/ was born on the 6th of April 1916 in the Chalk Bluff Community, seven miles southwest oh Okolona, Mississippi. He was a veteran of World War II, member of the V.F.W. and the American Legion. He was also a member of the Mount Olive Baptist Church and operated a Grocery business with his brother DeVan Hill 10/. J.T. Hill 10/ was also a farmer and was the owner of the old Hill farm.

- J.T. Hill 10/ married Gertrude Marion of Vardaman on the 28th of March 1948. They had three children: (11th generation)
- 1. Shelia Hill 11/, born 24 March 1949 at Okolona, Miss., married Vincent Francis Salemi Jr. on 27 March 1977 at Okolona, Miss. Two children: (12th generation)

- 2. Coy Allen Hill 11/, born 9th June 1951 at Okolona, Miss. He works for U.S. Postal Service in Jackson, Miss.

- J.T. Hill 10/ died on the 27th of July 1977 at the age of 61.
