- 1837 Henry Felkner left the family home in Fairfield County, Ohio, (born April 18, 1810), and came west to the "Blackhawk purchase now known as Iowa -- known by Indian name of Quisonsin . He came by "foot" from Melford, Indiana. Upon arrival he spent some time at the Trading Post with Mr. Gilbert. He began to run a sawmill and made the first lumber in the vicinity. Old Capitol was constructed with his lumber. Later he began to farm and to take prominent part in local affairs:
 - (1) Member of First Board of County Commissioners
 - (2) Helped lay foundation of State Government

- (3) Member of third, fourth and fifth Legislature
- (4) Till territory became a state.

He was a Democrat - Believed in strict honesty. Died 1885 in West Liberty, Iowa.

In 1843 he married Elizabeth Enoch Lewis, daughter of Enoch and Mourning Lewis, who was born near Columbus, Ohio, in 1820 and died in West Liberty, Iowa, in 1880 at age 60 years.
