14. Hanks Neville Hill, born 10th March 1813 in Cumberland County, Kentucky, died 9th September 1898 in Lane County, Oregon. Buried in Oak Hill Cemetery. He married Elizabeth Ann Merrill on 18th Febryary 1844 in Maury County, Tennessee.

NOTE: Reuben Hill was born in Pennsylvania in 1761. When four years old he moved with his parents (1765) to Fauguier County, Virginia. Near Richmond, Virginia he married Joiasy Hanks, daughter of Moses & Aggatha (Dodson) Hanks. Reuben and Joiasy lived in Pittsylvania County, Virginia where fe followered his trade as a Hatter. Reuben was an ordained minister. They had one son Thomas, were enumerated in Pittsylvania County, Virginia in the first Federal Census of 1790. In 1797 they migrated to Eastern Tennessee and settled on the French Broad River, where they lived four years. They then moved to Berea Station, Kentucky where they lived two years; then two years at Somerset, ***Pulaski County, Kentucky. Then to near Creelsboro, Cumberland County, Kentucky. In 1818 they moved to Maury County, Tennessee and lived there eight miles from Columbia on Duck River, on one of the experimental farms of James K. Polk. IN 1833 Reuben died. His sosn went to court for an order to care for his estate.

State of Tennessee, Maury County, County Court, March Sessions..."Whereas it appears to the court that Reuben Hill late of this county is dead and having made no will and application being made by Andrew W. Hill (son in law) and Hanks N. Hill (son) to have letters in the administration in the estate of the said Reuben Hill deceased having first given bond and security and qualified according to law, the same is granted." and so forth..
