

ROANE COUNTY NOTES:

PAGE 456, The Millican Family of Roane County, came from Spartanburg County, South Carolina and settled in Post oak valley. Nancy Millican, daughter of Samuel Millican, married Barney Hill in Roane County.

RHAE COUNTY NOTES:

PAGE 465, The Cozbys were from the Valley of Virginia and Hanover (County) and Mary Cozby, daughter of Col. James Cozby & wife Isabella, married John Hill.

HAMILTON COUNTY NOTES:

PAGE 473, One of the sons of Rev. Cyrus Kingsbury, noted Moravian missionary, married a Miss Hill, who died in Texas, where her sons and grandsons lived.

BRADLEY COUNTY NOTES:

PAGE 482, Ezekiel Bates (b. 1794 Va.) married Hannah Hill (b. ? in Ga. d. 1837 Bradley Co.). They had eight children. The Bates came to Bradley Co., from Alabama, where they had moved from Georgia. Their son Thomas L. Bates married Cynthia McCarty, dau. of B.V. & Sally G. McCraty (McCarty) of Anderson Co., and Campbell Co. Thomas L. Bates was at one time the Sheriff of Bradley Co.

WHITE COUNTY NOTES:

PAGE 521, Early County marriages by Rev. Ozias Denton and others: shows Albert Townsend married Elizabeth Hill on 31st January 1839.

WARREN COUNTY NOTES:

PAGE 524-528, Among the first settlers was Henry J. A. Hill & Isaac Hill. Isaac Hill was a native of either N.C. or Va., (wrong! he was born in Maryland) born on 22nd July 1745, probably in Edgecombe Co., N.C.; removed to Georgia and remained there for a time, probably around Columbus, Georgia, then moved to Warren County, Tennessee, where he died on 28th July 1825. He is said to have been buried near the old Hill's Tavern, on what was called "Hill's Trace," in the Cumberland Mountains of Warren Co.

The family claims he is the ancestor of the famous Benjamin Harvey Hill, who was born in Jasper Co., Ga. on 14th September 1823, and who served in the Confederate Congress.

Isaac Hill was twice married, first to Lucinda Wallace of N.C. & 2nd to Lydia Hill, widow of a William Hill, who may have been a brother to Isaac. By the first marriage he had the following children:

The certain parentage of Isaac Hill has not been ascertain, but he is certainly of the same family as that mentioned in "Lost Tribes" on pages 64 and 65.

Henry John Alexander Hill (son of Isaac) married Mrs. Sterling Savage and among their children were:

1. Ervin Hill (1796-1836) who m. his cousin, Eleanor Morgan.
2. Martha Hill, m. Dave Woodley (Woodlee).
3. Susannah Hill, (1834-1879) m. Isaac Barnes, son of Charles Barnes, and grandson of William Barnes from N.C., and his wife Charity Phillips, who came to Warren Co., Tenn. at an early age.

Isaac Hill Sr. (d. 1825) married as his 2nd wife, LYDIA HILL, a widow of William Hill, of Jasper Co., Georgia. She and Isaac had no children, but she and her first husband, William Hill, had two children, Eliza & Louvisa Hill.

Isaac Hill Jr. (Son of the first Henry John Alexander Hill) married Eliza, his grandfather's step-daughter on 25th August 1816. She was born in Jasper Co., Ga. in 1800. They were the parents of Louisa hill (1819-1856) who married 1st Abner Woodley, (2nd) Jacob Woodley.

Louisa, the other step-daughter, married Asa Hill, brother of Isaac Hill Jr., who married the sister Eliza. After Eliza died, Isaac Hill Jr. married 2nd time to Mildred Harrison, widow of George Harrison.

PAGE 529, Whitmell Hill of Warren County, and son of the old

pioneer, Isaac Hill and his wife Lucinda Wallace, married 1st Elizabeth Pace and 2nd, Biddie Christian. By this first marriage he had:

He made his will in 1828, and his sale was in September 1829, Buyers were: Benjamin Hill, Allen Hill, John A. Hill, Charles Barnes, John Barnes & Isaac Smith.

Whitmell Hill Ray, b. 1803 Warren Co., Tenn., was a Baptist Minister who settled in Smith County, Texas, lived and died there. On 12th May 1834 in Troupe County, Georgia, John Hill of that county, deeded certain lands to Asa Hill Jr. On the same date, Asa Hill Sr. (son of Isaac Hill Sr. (who went to Texas) deeded Asa Hill Jr. an interest in certain lands.
