DEED

Whereas I PERRY HILL of the county of Franklin & state of
Tennessee did have purchases of ARCHIBALD WOODNALL one MOSE
one slave of his color of the age of ten years old for the
consideration of SIXTY FIVE DOLLARS for which I have this day
executed my promissory note, due the 1ST DAY of NOVEMBER 1838
to the said WOODNALL and now therefore to secure the said
WOODNALL in the payment thereof. It is agreed by me that he
shall have a claim on the said MOSE until the note is paid
and if I refuse or fail to pay off said note, when it falls
due, then it may be the privilege of said WOODNALL and heirs
(are) hereby empowered to take into his possession and make
such sale and whereas ?? may be agreed?? by him against
me and pay off and satisfy said note of SIXTY DOLLARS (sic)
and the overplus, if any, pay to me. IN WITNESS whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal the 13TH DAY OF MARCH
1838.
