Note of Explanation: The figure after a name is the assigned generation that individual belongs to in the Woodward family. Since that individual is descended partly from the Woodward family, they are therefore treated as if they were a Woodward, despite the fact that their name maybe different, such as Lyles.

INFORMATION REGARDING LUCY WOODWARD 3/, WHO MARRIED AUGUSTINE J. WILLIAMS.

Lucy Woodward 3/ was the daughter of Thomas (Regulator) Woodward 2/ and his second wife, (widow) Elizabeth Stokes May (Mays). Lucy 3/ was one of six children that Thomas 2/ & his 2nd wife, Elizabeth Woodward had.

Her exact birth date is unknown but it is estimated to have been ca. 1766, in which case she was among the eldest of the six children by this second marriage.

Lucy Woodward 3/ married Augustine J. Williams after 1802 in South Carolina. In a petition dated in the year of 1810, her husband had his name legally changed to "William J. Augustine," being the reverse of what his name actually was.

As a result of this petition, the names of their children was also listed, due to the fact that they petitioned to keep their same surname of Williams. Since their ages were listed, it gives us the approximate year of birth for each of them, listed below.

MARY WOODWARD 4/, DAUGHTER OF REVEREND WILLIAM WOODWARD 3/ & NANCY ELIZABETH BARRETT MARRIED ARROMANUS LYLES, THE OLDEST SON OF COLONEL EPHRAIM LYLES. MARY WAS BORN CA. 1795, DIED

1885.

Note: Both John Woodward 3/ & his brother William Woodward 3/ had daughters named Mary Woodward 4/. Mary Ann Collins Woodward 4/, (actually spelled Marian) daughter of John Woodward 3/, married Thomas Lyles (a cousin), who's mother was Mary Woodward 4/, the daughter of Reverend William Woodward 3/ & Nancy Elizabeth Barrett. This Mary Woodward 4/ was the wife to Arromanus Lyles and they were the parents to Thomas Lyles 5/.

LYLES INFO: The Lyles Family progenitor in South Carolina was Colonel Ephraim Lyles, born in England but came from Brunswick (County) Virginia to South Carolina in 1734. He lived until 1745 when he was murdered by Cherokee Indians on the Broad River, leaving a wife and several small children. His oldest son was Arromanus Lyles, said to be the first white child born in what was later to become Fairfield County, S.C. (questionable fact?)

HIS MOTHER, MARY ANN COLLINS 4/ & JOHN MCDONALD WOODWARD 4/ WERE BROTHER & SISTER AND SON OF JOHN WOODWARD SR. 3/ & ESTHER MCDONALD.

THOMAS BARRETT WOODWARD 4/, SON OF REV. WILLIAM WOODWARD 3/ & NANCY ELIZABETH BARRETT, WAS BORN ON 2ND AUGUST 1801 IN SOUTH CAROLINA, MARRIED JULIA A. RICE ON 25TH NOVEMBER 1828, A DAUGHTER OF JOHN S. RICE & NANCY COKE HERNDON. THOMAS 4/ DIED ON 29TH OCTOBER 1871 IN TEXAS.

Note: The wife Julia Rice was a sister of Minerva Rice, who was married to Joseph Addison Woodward 4/, a brother to husband Thomas Barrett Woodward 4/. Thomas Barrett Woodward 4/ & wife, went to Mississippi in ca. 1834-35, then to Alabama ca. 1841-45 and finally back to Mississippi in 1859. Later the family moved to Texas where Thomas Barrett Woodward 4/ died on 29th October 1871.

11. Nannie H. Woodward 5/, born 27th September 1854 in Talladego County, Alabama, married ??? on 23rd February 1873 at Sulphur Springs, Hopkins County, Texas. Nannie died on 24th December 1874.

JOHN BARRETT WOODWARD 4/.

JOHN BARRETT WOODWARD 4/ SON OF REV. WILLIAM WOODWARD 3/ & NANCY ELIZABETH BARRETT WAS BORN CA. 1796 IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY, S.C., MARRIED MARY MOBLEY, (1796-1879) A DAUGHTER OF SAMUEL MOBLEY SR. & ELIZABETH PICKETT WHITEHEAD. JOHN 4/ DIED ON 14TH MAY 1829 IN GEORGIA. THE WIDOW MARY REMARRIED TO JOHN ROBINSON (ROBERTSON).

John Barrett Woodward 4/ was born in 1796 in Fairfield County, S.C., married on 14th May 1817 to Mary Mobley. It is known that they moved to Georgia, where John died in 1827. Mary Mobley married 2nd time to John A. Robinson (Robertson?)

1. Samuel Mobley Woodward 5/, died in California as the result of being kicked by a mule, no dates listed.

2. Captain William B. (Barrett?) Woodward 5/, born 24th December 1818, married Eliza Boulware Pickett on 14th May 1829. He died on 4th October 1897.
3. Mary Woodward 5/, married Thomas DeGraffenreid Satterwhite. They went to Texas where Thomas was killed by a school teacher in a quarrel. They had two sons; **John & Thomas Satterwhite, who went to California to join their uncle Samuel.
4. Nancy Mobley Woodward 5/, born 19 August 1823, married (cousin) John Woodward Rabb.
5. Joseph Woodward 5/ married Nancy Pickett, had a daughter Nannie, who married Reuben Lumpkin.
6. Dr. Thomas Mobley Woodward 5/, graduated from College of Physicians in Paris, practiced medicine in Atlanta, died early in life, is known to have married and had a daughter that married a Dr. White.

**Note: John & Thomas Satterwhite worked in the California gold mines for a spell. John accumulated some means, married a Mormon woman of Utah. He was a state Senator in California. Thomas attracted the attention of a Pennsylvania Senator named Don Cameron, who educated him and was admitted to the bar, became Attorney General for the Territory of Arizona and a probate judge at Tucson..

3/ & NANCY ELIZABETH BARRETT. HE WAS BORN ON THE 11TH OF

APRIL 1806 AT WINNSBORO, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA. HE DIED ON 3RD AUGUST 1885 AT TALLADEGA COUNTY, ALABAMA AND IS BURIED IN THE OAK HILL CEMETERY OF THAT COUNTY. HE WAS MARRIED TWICE, FIRST TO MALINDA REBECCA BONES (1807-1839); SECOND TIME TO MINERVA S. RICE, DAUGHTER OF JOHN S. RICE OF TALLADEGA, ALABAMA. SHE WAS BORN CA. 1828 IN S.C. AND DIED IN 1839 IN SOUTH CAROLINA (PROBABLY FAIRFIELD COUNTY).

Malinda Rebecca Bones was born in 1807 and died in 1839.

JEMIMA WOODWARD 4/ WAS THE DAUGHTER OF REV. WILLIAM WOODWARD 3/ AND NANCY ELIZABETH BARRETT. SHE WAS BORN CA. 1785-88 IN EITHER FAIRFIELD COUNTY OR CHESTER COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA. SHE IS SAID TO HAVE DIED IN MISSISSIPPI CA. 1851 BUT THIS HAS NOT BEEN PROVED. SHE MARRIED THOMAS HILL 2/ (Hill line) OF FAIRFIELD COUNTY, S.C. CA. 1805. JEMIMA WOODWARD WAS 3rd GREAT GRANDMOTHER TO WRITER, ROBERT R. HILL.

Children:

1. Nancy Barrett Hill 5/, born 4th June 1806 in Fairfield County, S.C., married three times, 1st to Edward Mabry Mobley and they first to DeKalb County, Ga., then they

moved to Alabama. Second marriage was to William Price Sr. on 27th July 1848 in Alabama, had a daughter Jemima born in Alabama; 3rd marriage to James H. Sims on 4th November 1853 in Alabama, no children, he died first. Nancy died after 1860 census.

2. Jemima Hill 5/, no information available.
3. Charlotte Louise Hill 5/, born 8th August 1809 in Fairfield County, S.C., married Moses Cockrell ca. 1824 in S.C. and moved to Noxubee County, Mississippi where she died on 28th October 1864, buried Soule Methodist Churchyard in Noxubee county, Mississippi.
4. Nathaniel Barrett Hill 5/, born 1811 in Fairfield County, S.C., married Judith Eliza Stewart ca. 1835-36,

he died in New York City on 13th December 1854, was returned to S.C. for burial but location unknown. He was known as "Barrett Hill." They were 2nd great grandparents to writer, Robert R. Hill.

5. William Woodward Hill 5/, born ca. 1812-1813, married cousin Mary Glenn Hill, daughter of uncle Moses Berry Hill, wife died very young, no known children. He known to have been in Mobile, Alabama, ca. 1848-1850.
6. Savilla Hill 5/, born ca. 1813-1814 in S.C., married Green Berry Mobley ca. 1830 and they moved 1ST to Green County, Alabama, she died ca. 1839-40 in Sumter County, Alabama.
7. Moses Hill 5/, born ca. 1815-1816, said to have moved to Pickens County, Alabama, no other data.
8. Thomas Hill 5/, born ca. 1817-1818, is believed to be the Thomas Hill listed in 1830 Census of Fairfield County, no other information.

WILLIAM BARRETT WOODWARD 5/ WAS BORN ON THE 24TH DECEMBER 1818 AND DIED ON THE 4TH OF OCTOBER 1897. HE WAS BURIED IN THE OLD FELLOWSHIP CHURCH CEMETERY AT BEAVER CREEK BAPTIST CHURCH IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY, S.C. IN 1839 HE MARRIED ELIZA BOULWARE PICKETT (1823-29 NOV. 1889).
