and by the sd John Tollison sd tract was conveyed to sd Reuben Harrison 19 Jul 1790 /s/ Reuben Harrison, Sarah (X) Harrison. Wit: John Mickle, Zack Nettles, Mosley Collins. Proven by oath of John Mickle before John McKinney JP, 23 Sept 1794. Recorded 22 Oct 1794.

[893] I, 221-223, 18 Jan 1794, David Brown planter of the state of Georgia to William Yarborough planter of Fairfield County for £50, 200a on the NE side of Broad R, adj. William Wat, Roberson, William Richardson, Burrel Cook, David Long, James Long and McMicking[?]. /s/ David Brown. Wit: Ab'r Yarborough, Henry Long, James Long. Proven by oath of James Long before John Cook, 16 Aug 1794. Recorded 23 Oct 1794.

[894] I, 223-224, 20 Jun 1776, John Splawn and Sibera his wife of Craven County to Babel Hutton of same for £250, 200a on a branch of Wateree Cr, originally granted to sd John Splawn 20 Mar 1765. /s/ John (his mark) Splawn. Wit: Mubrey (X) Hellems, Joseph (his mark) Hellems. Proven by oath of Mubrey Hellems before D. Evans CFC, 16 Oct 1794. Recorded 24 Oct 1794.

[895] I, 224-225, 8 Apr 1794, John Cameron and Sarah his wife of Fairfield County to Robert Gibson of same for £20, 100a on Brushy fork and Hoffmans Cr of Little R of Broad R, adj. Ellison and Jno Cammeron, part of 703a granted to sd Jno Cameron 7 Jan 1788 and recorded in grant book WWW page 193. /s/ Jno Cammeron, Sarah Cammeron. Wit: Staff'd Curry, Alex'r Dickey, Margaret (her mark) Ross. Proven by oath of Stafford Curry before John Turner JP, 11 Oct 1794. Recorded 24 Oct 1794.

[896] I, 226, 21 Jan 1794, James Hindman planter of Fairfield County to Morris Weaver planter of same for £10, 11a, adj. lands commonly known by the name of James Frurris[?] and Christopher Huffman, part of a tract of 650a originally granted to John McMorris and conveyed by sd McMorris to Christopher Huffman. /s/ James Hindman. Wit: H. Milling JP, David Milling. Recorded 25 Oct 1794. Note: This deed includes a plat.

[897] I, 227, 7 Sept 1793, Michael Riley planter of Fairfield County to Morris Weaver planter of same for £15, 133a on the branches of Jacksons Cr, adj. Thomas Woodard and Robert Hainning, being the third part of a survey of 400a granted to John McBride 31 Aug 1774. /s/ Michael Riley. Wit: H. Milling JP, Robt Milling. Recorded 25 Oct 1794.

[898] I, 228-230, 13 Sept 1794, William Powell planter and Mary his wife of Fairfield County to John Finley planter of same for £100, 150a on the N side of Broad R on Buckhorn branch, adj. Phillip Pearson and Richard Strother, part of 300a granted to Thomas Williams, sd 300a conveyed by sd Williams to William Mitchusson on 13/14 Jan 1758 then sd Mitchusson conveyed 150a of sd plantation to Thomas Sing and then sd 150a conveyed by sd Thomas Sing and Joanna his wife 14/15 Jan 1761 to William Powell & John Powell and whereas sd William Powell died intestate & without issue the right of inheritance to sd 150a devolved on John Powell eldest brother of sd William Powell dec'd and whereas the sd John Powell died intestate the right of inheritance to sd 150a devolved on William Powell party hereto being eldest son of

sd John Powell dec'd. /s/ William (X) Powell, Jacob (F) Free, Phil. Pearson. Recorded 26 Oct 1794.

[899] I, 230-231, 22 Mar 1779, Babel Hooten planter of same for £1, 200a on the middle branch of Wateree Cr, adj. John Splawn 12 Mar 1765 and by the sd Splawn conveyed to Babel Hooten. Wit: Thos Johnston, Hugh S before D. Evans CFC, 14 Oct 1794. Recorded 23 Oct 1794.

[900] I, 232-234, 24 Jun 1769, Jacob Gibson planter of same for £30, 100a on the branch of Wateree Cr, adj. Solomon McGraw, part of 250a granted to sd Jacob Gibson, Judith (m) Gibson. Wit: John Long S before D. Evans CFC, 28 Oct 1794. Recorded 23 Oct 1794.

[901] I, 234-235, 12 Aug 1793, John Bagwell planter of same for £30, 135a on a branch of Wateree Cr, adj. Leonard Miles, John Woodard, James Rutland, originally granted to Jesse Sibley 4 Apr 1791 a book C page 356. /s/ John Bagwell. Wit: Leonard Miles, John Woodard, James Rutland. Certified by Zackariah Kirkland Esq.

[902] I, 235-237, 16 Sept 1783, Jacob Gibson planter of same for £20, 400a on the water branch of Wateree Cr, adj. Laurence Free, John & William M originally granted to Judith Gibson dec'd and lawful heirship. /s/ Jacob Gibson. Wit: St Gibson. Proven by oath of David Gibson and 30 Oct 1793. Recorded 30 Oct 1794. Note: T

[903] I, 238-240, 1 Nov 1793, Thomas Presswood of Camden District to Henry Rugeley of Fairfield County a branch of Wateree Cr, adj. Micajah Pickett and Henry Rugeley (but now by Micajah Pickett and Henry Rugeley) granted to Augustine Presswood 21 Apr 1777 Presswood to the sd Thomas Presswood the el son Adamson, Bryan Spradley. Proven by Alexander JP of Kershaw County, 13 Mar 1794.

[904] I, 241-242, 27 Sept 1794, Thomas Griggs planter of Fairfield County to Henry Rugeley of same for containing 37 1/2a on Taylors Cr on the water branch of Wateree Cr, adj. Francis Layton and re FFF page 485 which sd tract was conveyed to Thomas Griggs Yarborough, also a tract of 75a granted to sd Francis Layton and conveyed to Thomas Griggs Yarborough, also a tract of 100a granted to sd George Peay 6 Aug 1787 as rec
