Mills and therefore prays the said Grant might not be recorded but that a new Warrant for 600 acres of Vacant Land might be issued to him.

Ordered that a new Warrant do issue as prayd for and that the Grant be canceled.

[Meeting of Friday 6 May 1774]

Read the Petition of Frederick Gregg setting forth that a Grant had been signd to him by the Governor of North Carolina for 302 acres of Land then supposed to be in North Carolina but which since running the Line appeared to be in this Province and praying that the Surveyor General might be directed to Certify a platt of the said Land to the said Frederick Gregg and that he might have a Grant for the same. Ordered accordingly.
